- Twenty-four writers has received the Sahitya Akademi Award for 2023.
- The award ceremony coincided with the 70th anniversary celebrations of the National Academy of Letters at the Sahityotsav.
- The awards were given for literary works including nine books of poetry, six novels, five of short stories, three essays, and one literary study.
- Sanjeev for his novel "Mujhe Pehchaano" and Gaur for her book "Requiem in Raga Janki" received the prestigious award.
- Sadiqua Nawab Saher received the award for her book "Rajdev Ki Amrai" in Urdu, while Swarnjit Savi was awarded for his book of poetry "Mann Di Chip" inPunjabi.
- Other recipients of the awards in poetry include Vijay Verma (Dogri), Vinod Joshi (Gujarati), Manshoor Banihali (Kashmiri), Sorokkhaibam Gambhini (Manipuri), Ashutosh Parida (Odia), Gaje Singh Rajpurohit (Rajasthani), Arun Ranjan Mishra (Sanskrit) and Vinod Asudani (Sindhi).

Chapter 11: GDP Forecasting

1. India's GDP growth at 8.4% in Q3 2023-24

- India's gross domestic product (GDP) for the third quarter of the ongoing financial year accelerated to 8.4 per cent year-on-year, showed data shared by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation.
- In the same period last year, the GDP growth was 4.3 per cent.
- GDP at constant (2011-12) prices in Q3 of 2023-24 is estimated at Rs 43.72 lakhcrore, against Rs 40.35 lakh crore in Q3 of 2022-23, showing a growth rate of 8.4percent.
- While analysts had estimated the GDP growth in the third quarter at below 7 percent.
- The double-digit growth rate of the construction sector (10.7 per cent), followedby a good growth rate of the manufacturing sector (8.5 per cent) has boosted theGDP growth in FY24, according to the government.

2. Moody's raises India's 2024 GDP forecast to 6.8%

- Global rating agency Moody's has raised India's GDP growth projection for 2024to 6.8 per cent from the 6.1 per cent.
- The increase in estimate was attributed to India's robust economic performancein 2023 and diminishing global economic challenges.
- Surpassing the analysts' expectations of 6.6 per cent, India's economy grew 8.4per cent during the October-December quarter.
- Moody's attributed this strong growth to the government's capital spending and vigorous manufacturing activity.
- For 2025, the GDP growth is estimated at 6.4 per cent.

3. CRISIL raises India's GDP growth forecast to 6.8% for FY25

- Rating agency CRISIL raised its economic growth forecast for India in the nextfinancial year (FY25) to 6.8 per cent from 6.4 per cent estimated earlier, citinghigher growth momentum.
- In its India Outlook report, growth will moderate in FY25 from 7.6 per cent in thecurrent financial year as higher interest rates and lower fiscal impulse will temper demand.
- The report also expects the Indian economy to grow at an average rate of 6.7 percent till the end of this decade.
- On the inflation front, the rating agency expects the softening to continue in thenext financial year on the back of healthier agriculture output that tames food inflation, and benign oil and commodity prices.

4. Moody's ups growth forecast to 8% for FY24

- Moody's Ratings has raised India's GDP growth forecast for FY24 to around 8 percent from 6.6 per cent on the back of strong domestic consumption and capital expenditure.
- The latest estimate of Moody's is about 140 basis points higher than the earlierprojection of 6.6 per cent made in November 2023.
- The National Statistical Office (NSO) has projected 8.4 per cent growth inDecember quarter of the current financial year.

1. Leopard numbers show 8% rise from 2018 to 2022

- India's leopard numbers rose by 8% from 12,852 in 2018 to 13,874 in 2022, according to a report made public by the Environment Ministry.
- While the highest number of leopards were reported in Madhya Pradesh (3,907), only three other States reported over 1,000 animals each — Maharashtra (1,985), Karnataka (1,879) and Tamil Nadu (1,070).
- While Uttarakhand reported a 22% decline in the big cat numbers reportedlydue to poaching and man-animal conflict, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam and West Bengal saw a collective 150% rise to 349 animals.

2. FSSAI gives 'Eat Right Station' certificate to 150 Railway Stations

- Food regulator FSSAI has awarded 'Eat Right Station' certification to 150 railwaystations so far for ensuring safe, hygienic and nutritious food options for passengers.
- The 'Eat Right Station' certification process involves rigorous audits of food vendors, training of food handlers, adherence to strict hygiene and sanitation protocols and efforts to raise awareness among individuals to make informedfood choices.
- Some of the prominent stations that have been certified as Eat Right stations arein New Delhi, Varanasi, Kolkata, Ujjain, Ayodhya Cantt, Hyderabad, Chandigarh, Kozhikode, Guwahati, Visakhapatnam, Bhubaneswar, Vadodara, Mysuru City, Bhopal, Igatpuri, and Chennai, among others from various states.

3. 4 days long 'Tawi Festival' begins in Jammu

- Once commissioned, India will only be the second country after Russia to havecommercial operating Fast Breeder Reactor.
- The PFBR reactor core consists of control sub-assemblies, blanket subassembliesand fuel subassemblies. With minimised nuclear waste generated from the reactor and advanced safety features, FBRs will provide a safe, efficient and cleansource of energy and contribute to the goal of net zero.
- In India's three stages of the nuclear power programme, BHAVINI paves the wayas a forerunner in the second stage by building a 500 MWe PFBR.

14. Cuttack Rupa Tarakasi, Banglar muslin get GI tag

- Silver Filigree, or Tarakasi, is a testament to the unparalleled skill and precision fartisans in Cuttack.
- The craft's history traces back to over 500 years ago, with influences spanningfrom Persia to Indonesia, and finally making its home in Cuttack, Odisha.
- This intricate form of metalwork involves twisting thin silver wires to create delicateand complex designs, often used in jewelry and decorative items.

15. Mandaviya inaugurates Three CIPET Centers Across India

- Union Minister of Chemicals and Fertilisers and Health and Family Welfare Dr.Mansukh Mandaviya virtually inaugurated 3 centers of Central Institute of Petrochemicals Engineering & Technology (CIPET) established across India.
- These three new CIPET centres dedicated to the nation by the Minister are CSTSBaddi (Himachal Pradesh), CSTS, Ranchi (Jharkhand), and CSTS Gwalior (MP).

- CIPET was started in 1968 in Chennai as Central Plastic Engineering and ToolInstitution.



16. India's unemployment rate in 2023 dropped to 3.1%: NSO

- India's unemployment rate dropped to 3.1 per cent in 2023 from 3.6 per cent in the preceding year, reflecting continued improvement in the labour markets, revealed the latest employmentunemployment indicators report released by the National Statistical Office.
- During the calendar year 2023, the unemployment rate in both rural and urbanareas declined to 2.4 per cent and 5.2 per cent, respectively, from 2.8 per cent and 5.9 per cent in 2022.
- The unemployment rate for rural women (1.9 per cent) was lower than for ruralmen (2.7 per cent) in 2023, whereas in urban areas, the rate was higher for women (7.5%) compared to men (4.4%).

17. BHEL bags order worth Rs 9,500 cr to set up 1,600 MW thermal project

- Power equipment major Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd (BHEL) has secured a power plant engineering, procurement, and construction (EPC) order of over Rs9,500 crore from NTPC Ltd.
- The order is for the Singrauli Super Thermal Power Project Stage-III (2x800MW), in Uttar Pradesh.
- According to BHEL, the order won in international competitive bidding is for the supply of equipment like boilers, turbines, generators, and associated auxiliaries, along with electrical and control and instrumentation, balance of plant packages, and others.

- The 'NITI For States', is a cross-sectoral knowledge platform designed to become Digital Public Infrastructure (DPI) for Policy and Good Governance.
- The significant features of the platform include a multi-sectoral live repository of 7,500 Best Practices, 5,000 Policy documents, 900+ datasets, 1,400 data profiles, and 350 NITI publications.

- Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan has inaugurated the state's own Over-The-Top (OTT) platform at Kairali Theatre.
- The platform, called CSpace, is India's first government-backed OTT platform.
- The OTT platform is managed by Kerala State Film Development Corporation(KSFDC), a stateowned entity entrusted with the promotion of Malayalam cinema.
- A special curator panel is set by KSFDC to select content for the platform.

23. IOC to make fuel fo<mark>r Formula 1 - first by an Indian firm</mark>

- India's largest oil company, Indian Oil Corporation Ltd (IOC) will start manufacturing fuel used in adrenaline-pumping Formula One or F1, motorracing as it looks to expand its basket of niche fuels.
- F1 fuel is essentially high-octane petrol and the standards are heavily regulated by global motor sport governing body Federation Internationale de l'Automobile(FIA) on various counts, including permissible additives and blending agents.
- IOC will supply fuel for all the motorcyclists from 15 countries that willparticipate in the FIM Asia Road Racing Championship.

24. First Bharat Steam Boiler Expo 2024 held in Guwahati

- The first Bharat Steam Boiler Expo 2024 was held at Veterinary College Field inGuwahati, Assam.
- The expo is organized by the Assam's Inspectorate of Boilers (CIB) and supported by the Assam government's Labour Welfare Department.
- The expo aims to improve the efficiency and growth of various sectors that usesteam boilers.

25. Govt extends subsidy for Ujjwala beneficiaries by another one year

- The Union Cabinet has decided to extend the subsidy of ₹300 per LPG cylinderfor up to 12 refills per year till the end of next financial year (March 2025).
- About 10.27 crore beneficiaries under the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) will get the benefit of the scheme with its continuation set to incur ₹12,000 crore.
- The Centre had started a targeted subsidy of ₹200 per cylinder for up to 12 refillsper annum to the PMUY consumers in May 2022.
- In October 2023, the Centre increased the subsidy to ₹300 per cylinder for up to 12 refills per year.
- As on February 1, 2024, the effective price of domestic LPG for PMUY consumersis ₹603 per LPG cylinder of 14.2 kg.

26. World's largest literary festival-'Sahityotsav' to be held from March 11-16

• World's largest literary festival-'Sahityotsav' by Sahitya Akademi will be heldfrom the 11th to 16th of March.



- The festival commemorating 70 years of Sahitya Akademi will witness theparticipation of more than a hundred renowned writers and scholars.
- Over 190 sessions and more than 175 languages of the country will also berepresented during the festival.
- The Chief Guest of the Awards Presentation Ceremony will be Pratibha Rai, the distinguished Odia writer.

27. Cabinet approves 4% hike in DA for government employees

- The Union Cabinet has approved hike in dearness allowance (DA) for central government employees and dearness relief (DR) for pensioners by 4 per centwith effect from January 1.
- With this revision, the DA will reach 50 per cent. This means various other allowances such as Housing Rent Allowances (HRA), Children's Education and Transport Allowances, and gratuities, will also go up based on the formula suggested by the 7th Pay Commission.
- All of them will get arrears for January and February and the revised rate for thecurrent month, along with salary and pension for March.

28. PM launches 52 tourism sector projects worth more than Rs 1400 crores

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched 52 tourism sector projects worthover Rs 1400 crore under the Swadesh Darshan and Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD) schemes.
- Nine tourism infrastructure projects, spread across the country, developed under Swadesh Darshan and PRASHAD schemes worth Rs 469 crore were launched, besides 43 other projects worth Rs 963 crore were also launchedunder the two schemes of tourism ministry.
- The project launch events were also carried out at all the 52 destinations, simultaneously by the ministry, state government, UT administrations and localauthorities.
- The projects launched included three projects under PRASHAD Scheme (Hazratbal- Srinagar, Jogulamba- Telangana, Amarkantak-Madhya Pradesh)worth Rs 129.35 crore.

29. Cabinet approves MSP for Raw Jute for 2024-25 Season

- The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs has increased the Minimum SupportPrice (MSP) for raw jute for the 2024-25 season by ₹285 to ₹5,335 per quintal.
- The decision would ensure a return of 64.8% over the all-India weighted averagecost of production.
- In the last 10 years, the government has increased MSP for raw jute from ₹2,400per quintal in 2014-15 to ₹5,335 a quintal in 2024-25, registering a growth of 122%".
- The decision is expected to help jute farmers in West Bengal, Bihar and Assam.

30. PM Modi dedicated Sela tunnel to nation

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has dedicated the Sela tunnel in ArunachalPradesh to the country, with the new route allowing faster deployment of weapons, soldiers and equipment to forward areas near the Line of ActualControl (LAC) in the Tawang sector.
- the tunnel is built by the Border Roads Organisation (BRO) at a cost of Rs 825crore. It is the world's longest twin-lane tunnel above 13,000 feet.



 The tunnel will cut down the travel time to Tawang by at least one hour as wellas provide allweather connectivity.

31. Bichom becomes 27th district of Arunachal Pradesh

- Bichom, carved out of West and East Kameng, became the 27th district of Arunachal Pradesh.
- In February this year, the state assembly passed the Arunachal Pradesh (Re- Organization of Districts) (Amendment) Bill, 2024 for the creation of Bichom andKeyi Panyor districts.
- A total of 27 villages from West Kameng and 28 from East Kameng were madepart of Bichom district.

32. DST, T-Hub launch Al-ML hub in Hyderabad

- The Department of Science and Technology (DST), which works under the UnionMinistry of Science and Technology, and start-up ecosystem enabler T-Hub have joined hands to to set up a Machine Learning and Artificial Intelligence Technology Hub (MATH) in Hyderabad.
- The hub will work to foster AI innovation, create job opportunities, and provide a conducive ecosystem for AI and ML start-ups.

33. India to construct a 10,000-GPU Supercomputer for self-sufficient AI advancement

- The Indian government, led by PM Narendra Modi, has approved a new \$1.24billion investment for the IndiaAI mission, a "national-level" plan designed tocreate an all-Indian AI ecosystem from scratch.
- This initiative aims to create an all-Indian AI ecosystem from scratch, bolsteringIndia's technological prowess and fostering innovation in AI.
- The HPC system, expected to include 10,000 "or more" GPUs as AI accelerators, will be developed through a public-private partnership to support startups and research organizations.

- China is the largest producer of mobile phones; Indonesia stands at 3rd.

- Mask making or 'Mukha Shilpa' of Majuli is an age-old art form in the island, dating back to the 16th century. It is one of the most famous traditional craftsstill practiced in Majuli, the world's largest inhabited river island.

41. North India's First Government Homeopathic College to be Established in Kathua

- Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology, Dr JitendraSingh, announced the establishment of North India's first Government Homeopathic College in the Jasrota area of Kathua district, Jammu and Kashmir.

50. SC ordered Election Commission to Published Data on Electoral Bond

- The Election Commission of India on its official website on March 14 published the electoral bonds data as ordered by the Supreme Court of India (SC).
- The publication of the electoral bond data came almost a month after the Supreme Court struck down the 2018 scheme calling it "unconstitutional."
- In the data on electoral bonds, the only information available about donors is thename of their company or individual.
- The SBI confirmed in an affidavit that 22,217 electoral bonds were purchased and 22,030 redeemed by political parties between April 1, 2019, and February15, 2024.
- The SBI shared two sets of data with the Election Commission.
- The first setincludes the name of the purchaser of the electoral bond, date, and denomination. The second list lays out details of the political party and dates and denomination of bonds encashed.
- The data reveals key details like the name of the electoral bond purchaser and the amount they donated through the bond.
- It pertains to the purchase of electoral bonds in the denomination of ₹1 lakh, ₹10 lakh and ₹1 crore.
- The donors include a range of companies like Megha Engineering and Infrastructure, Future Gaming and Hotel Services (Lottery Martin), Sun Pharma, Lakshmi Mittal, Sula Wine, DLF Commercial Developers, etc. Who are the biggest donors?
- In the data released, there are 1,260 companies and individuals that purchasedelectoral bonds worth ₹12,769 crore. The top 20, all companies, accounted for ₹5,945 crore —or nearly half of the total amount donated through electoralbonds.

51. Shipping Ministry approves projects worth ₹645-crore in Assam to boost tourism

- India's Shipping Ministry has approved waterways projects worth ₹645 crore onBrahmaputra in Assam.
- Projects, aimed at boosting river tourism, will be implemented with financialassistance from the Centre.
- Projects will involve the creation of slipways at strategic locations in Dhubri and Majuli, new passenger terminals at Ghagor in North Lakhimpur and Bahari in Barpeta district of Assam.
- There will be additional passenger terminals in Goalpara, Guijan, Kurua, Dhubri, Disangmukh & Matmora.

52. NHPC bags 200 MW capacity solar power project in Gujarat

- State-run hydro power major NHPC has bagged a 200-megawatt (MW) capacitysolar power project to be set up at the Gujarat State Electricity Corporation's (GSECL) 1,125 MW RE Park in Khavda.
- NHPC will develop the project on a build-own-and-operate basis at a tentatived evelopment cost of about ₹847 crore.
- The project was secured at a tariff of ₹2.66 per unit and will be completed in aperiod of 18 months.



 The project will generate about 473 million units (MU) in the first year of commissioning and the cumulative generation from the project over a period of 25 years would be about 10,850 million units.

53. Government launches alternate Auto Fuel Ethanol100

- Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas, Hardeep Singh Puri has launchedEthanol100, an alternate auto fuel in New Delhi.
- Ethanol100, a cleaner and greener alternative to gasoline, is a blend of 92 to 94percent ethanol, 4 to 5 percent motor spirit to provide colour to flame and 1.5 percent Co-solvent higher saturated alcohol.
- The fuel produces lower emissions of greenhouse gases, a reduction by around 63% on well to wheel basis.
- Ethanol100 will help to mitigate the impacts of climate change and improve air quality. Prominent two-wheeler manufacturers are already undertaking trials forEthanol100 compliant vehicles.

54. Kashmir hosts first Formula-4 Car Racing Event along Dal Lake

- Srinagar hosted the first-ever Formula 4 car racing demonstration event on thebanks of the worldfamous Dal Lake.
- The event enthralled locals and motorsport fans as they witnessed stuntsperformed by professional Formula 4 drivers.
- Sleek racing cars roared along a 1.7 km track from Lalit Ghat on the banks of DalLake to Nehru Park in the city.

55. India's first integrated Oil Palm Processing Unit by 3F Oil Palm starts

commercial operations

- India's first integrated oil palm processing unit in Arunachal Pradesh started operation by one of India's largest oil palm development companies, 3F Oil Palm.
- A new factory has been established in the Lower Dibang Valley district of India'snortheast state. This factory is part of Mission Palm Oil and is India's first oil palm factory under NMEO-OP.
- This integrated Oil Palm project will include a cutting-edge oil palm factory(Palm Oil Processing and Refinery), a zero-discharge effluent plant, a palm waste-based power plant, and additional structures and go-downs for supportpurposes.
- This factory marks the first Oil Palm factory in Arunachal Pradesh and India'sfirst Oil Palm Factory under NMEO-OP.

- According to the December-end filing, Tata Sons holds a 72.38 per cent stake inTCS.
- Holding companies and promoter entities usually sell stakes in group firms togenerate cash to pay down debt and stabilise balance sheets.

58. ICRA forecasts Indian IT service industry growth at 3-5% in FY25

- Indian IT sector's revenue growth is expected to come at a tepid 3-5% in FY25, adomestic rating agency ICRA.
- This is the second consecutive year when the credit rating agency has forecasted agrowth rate in the range of 3-5 per cent for sector.
- The sector's hiring will "remain muted" in the near-term until the growthmomentum picks up, ICRA Ratings said.

59. India's 1st Battery Energy storage GigaFactory to be launched in J&K

- GoodEnough Energy will start operations at India's first battery energy storagegigafactory in the northern region of Jammu and Kashmir by October.
- The facility will help industry in cutting more than 5 million tons of carbone missions in a year.
- GoodEnough has already spent 1.5 billion rupees (\$18.07 million) on the 7 gigawatts per hour (GWH) facility and will spend 3 billion rupees by 2027 toraise capacity to 20 GWH.
- Battery energy storage projects are critical to India's ambitious plan to expandits renewable energy capacity to 500 gigawatts (GW) by 2030, from 178 GW atpresent.
- India has set a 2070 goal for becoming net zero.

60. IIT Madras develops customisable 'Electric Standing Wheelchair'

- IIT Madras has developed an indigenous electric standing wheelchair called 'NeoStand,' claimed to be India's most customizable wheelchair for the benefit of wheelchair users.
- The wheelchair was launched at the campus in the presence of Professor V Kamakoti, Director of IIT Madras, faculty, researchers, dignitaries, supporters of this project, and users of these rehabilitative devices.
- The NeoStand is a compact standing wheelchair equipped with navigation for itsmotorized standing mechanism. Users can easily switch from sitting to standing at the touch of a button.

- Grid Controller of India Limited (GRID-INDIA) achieved a significant milestone by being conferred with the status of Miniratna Category-I Central Public SectorEnterprise (CPSE).
- This recognition, bestowed upon by the Ministry of Power, Government of India, underscores GRID-INDIA's pivotal role in the nation's power landscape.
- Established in 2009, GRID-INDIA holds the crucial mandate of overseeing the seamless and



uninterrupted operation of the Indian Power System, ensuring the efficient transfer of electric power within and across regions, facilitating trans- national power exchanges with a focus on reliability, economy, and sustainability.

62. 'Operation Indravati' to evacuate stranded Indians in Haiti launched

- India has launched 'Operation Indravati' to evacuate its citizens stranded in war-torn Haiti amid the intense fighting between the armed groups and the government.
- 12 citizens have been successfully rescued to the Caribbean nation DominicanRepublic and further thanked its government for their support.

> What's happening in Haiti?

- The Caribbean nation of Haiti has been plagued by widespread gang violence forover two years since the July 2021 assassination of President Jovenel Moise.
- In the power vacuum that followed the assassination, the country's de facto leader, Prime Minister Ariel Henry, assumed power, with the support of severalnations.

63. Bharat Biotech star<mark>ts clinical trials of Tuberculosis vaccine</mark> MTBVAC in India

- Bharat Biotech International Ltd started clinical trials of the Tuberculosisvaccine MTBVAC on adults in India.
- This is the first vaccine against Tuberculosis derived from a human source by theSpanish biopharmaceutical company, Biofabri.
- The trials are carried out by Bharat Biotech in close collaboration with Biofabri.

64. Government allocated Rs 6200 cr to boost RRB

- The union government has allocated Rs 6212.03 crore to regional rural banksunder the recapitalization scheme.
- Under the scheme, recapitalization support is provided to RRBs to maintain theminimum prescribed capital-to-risk (Weighted) Assets ratio of nine per cent.
- The performance of RRBs has improved significantly, with a consolidated CRAR (Capital to Riskweighted Assets Ratio) at an all-time high of 13.83 per cent as ofDecember 31, 2023.

65. World's largest copper manufacturing plant owned by Adani Group

- Billionaire Gautam Adani-led group has started of the first phase of the world's largest singlelocation copper manufacturing plant at Mundra in Gujarat, whichwill help cut India's dependence on imports and aid energy transition.
- The 1st phase of the facility will produce 0.5 million tonnes a year of refinedcopper.
- India joins China and other nations that are rapidly expanding production of copper.
- India's per capita copper consumption is around 0.6 kg and the global average is kg.

Chapter 13: Current Affairs (International)

1. Nicaragua becomes first Spanish-Speaking nation to recognize IPS

- Nicaragua has become the first Spanish-speaking nation to officially recognize the Indian Pharmacopoeia (IP) or Indian Pharma standards.
- This development follows the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on Pharmacopoeia Cooperation between the Governments of India andNicaragua.
- The move is expected to foster stronger ties between the two nations in the areasof healthcare, encouraging the exchange of expertise and resources for improved medical standards.
- The Indian Pharmacopoeia (IP), compiled by the Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission (IPC) under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare in India, servesas the official compendium of standards for drugs.
- The legal significance of the IP within India, enshrined in the Second Schedule of the Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940, necessitates adherence to its standards for all imported, manufactured, and distributed drugs within the country.

2. France become first country to enshrine abortion rights in its constitution

- France has become the first country in the world to enshrine abortion rights inits constitution.
- French lawmakers from both houses of the Parliament, in a special session, voted780 to 72 in favor of the move to amend the Constitution.
- The amendment states that there is a guaranteed freedom to abortion in France.
- France has a long history of supporting abortion rights. The voluntary ending of pregnancy became legal in France in 1975 with a law named after Simone Veil, the health minister who supported it.



3. Panama becomes 97th member of International Solar Alliance

- Panama has officially become the 97th member of the International SolarAlliance (ISA).
- This milestone was announced by Randhir Jaiswal, the spokesperson for the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA).
- Moreover, on March 5, Malta became the 119th country to join the InternationalSolar Alliance.
- The International Solar Alliance (ISA) is an action-oriented, member-driven, collaborative platform for increased deployment of solar energy technologies as a means for bringing energy access, ensuring energy security, and driving energytransition in its member countries.

4. Sweden officially becomes 32nd member of NATO

- Sweden has officially become the 32nd member of NATO after it completed theaccession process in Washington.
- The handover of documents took place at a ceremony two years after Sweden applied to join the military alliance following the full-scale war between Russiaand Ukraine in February 2022.
- The foundations of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) were officiallylaid down on 4 April 1949 with the signing of the North Atlantic Treaty, more popularly known as the Washington Treaty.

5. New Zealand bans disposable E-Cigarettes and Vapes

- The New Zealand government will ban the sale of disposable e-cigarettes, increase fines on retailers that sell to those younger than 18 years old and betterregulate retailers.
- The New Zealand government has received significant criticism for rolling back a world-first law banning tobacco sales for future generations.
- It is committed to reducing smoking but is just taking a different approach, including further regulations around vaping.

6. Saudi Arabia to participate in Miss Universe event in historic first

- Saudi Arabia officially joined the Miss Universe pageant with Rumy Alqahtani asthe Islamic country's first-ever representative.
- This is another step for Saudi Arabia, which has been shedding its conservative loak under Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman Al Saud.
- Rumy Alqahtani, a 27-year-old model, would be the first participant from thecountry in the international beauty pageant.
- Last year, Miss Nicaragua Sheynnis Palacios was crowned Miss Universe 2023.

Chapter 14: Banking & Financial

1. RBI cancels licence of Rajasthan-based Sumerpur Mercantile Urban Coop Bank

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has cancelled the licence of Sumerpur Mercantile Urban Cooperative Bank, Pali (Rajasthan), as the lender does nothave adequate capital and earning prospects.
- The Registrar of Cooperative Societies, Rajasthan, has also been requested toissue an order for



winding up the bank and appoint a liquidator.

- On liquidation, every depositor will be entitled to receive deposit insurance claim amount of his/her deposits up to Rs 5 lakh from Deposit Insurance andCredit Guarantee Corporation (DICGC).
- As per the data submitted by the bank, 99.13 per cent of the depositors areentitled to receive full amount of their deposits from DICGC.

2. GST Collections Jump 12.5% YoY to Rs 1.68 Lakh Crore in Feb 2024

- Gross Goods and Services Tax (GST) revenue collected for February 2024 is ₹1,68,337 crore, marking a robust 12.5% increase compared to that in the samemonth in 2023.
- This growth was driven by a 13.9% rise in GST from domestic transactions and 8.5% increase in GST from import of goods.
- GST revenue net of refunds for February 2024 is ₹1.51 lakh crore which is agrowth of 13.6% over that for the same period last year.
- Breakdown of February 2024 Collections- Central Goods and Services Tax (CGST)- ₹31,785 crore State Goods and Services Tax (SGST)- ₹39,615 crore Integrated Goods and Services Tax (IGST)-₹84,098 crore, including ₹38,593crore collected on imported goods Cess- ₹12,839 crore, including ₹984 crore collected on imported goods

3. FIU imposes 5.49 crore fine on Paytm Payments Bank

- Financial Intelligence Unit India (FIU-IND) has hit Paytm Payments Bank Ltdwith a hefty penalty of Rs 5,49,00,000 for alleged violations of anti-money laundering rules under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA).
- The penalty pertains to issues within a business segment that was discontinued two years ago.
- The bank was accused of violating rules outlined in the PMLA and its associated regulations, as well as guidelines issued by the Director FIU-IND.
- The investigation was prompted by specific information provided by law enforcement agencies regarding certain entities believed to be involved in illicitactivities, including online gambling.

4. Flipkart unveils its UPI handle to boost India's digital evolution

- Flipkart has launched its UPI (Unified Payments Interface) handle to enhance digital payment offerings to all users, including the e-commerce major's over 500million customers, and boost India's digital evolution.
- Powered by Axis Bank, Flipkart UPI will initially be available for Android users.

- It facilitates the registered users to search unclaimed deposits/accounts acrossmultiple banks in one place in a centralised manner.
- All unclaimed deposits/accounts that are part of the Depositor Education and Awareness (DEA)
 Fund of RBI can be searched in the UDGAM portal.

8. Kotak Life introduces Non-Linked Par Product Kotak G.A.I.N

- Private sector life insurer Kotak Life Insurance has launched a non-linked participating product Kotak G.A.I.N which offers long-term saving or income.
- The minimum annual premium payable to avail the product is Rs 50,000.

- The number has remained within the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) toleranceband of 2-6 per cent.
- On a sequential basis, the inflation rate increased to 0.16 per cent against acontraction of (-)0.11 per cent in the previous month.



- The rural inflation rate remained unchanged at 5.34 per cent, meanwhile, theurban inflation rate declined to 4.78 per cent from 4.92 per cent in January.
- The food inflation for February stood at 8.66 per cent versus 8.30 per centrecorded in January.

15. Kotak Mahindra Bank sells 2% stake in KFin Tech

- Kotak Mahindra Bank has sold a 2% stake in KFin Technologies through theopen market for Rs 208 crore.
- The private sector lender sold 3,470,000 shares of KFin Technologies at Rs 600.28 a share, bulk deals data on the BSE showed.
- As of December end, Kotak Mahindra Bank held a 9.80% stake in KFinTechnologies.
- Kotak Mahindra Bank invested Rs 310 crore in KFin Technologies in September2021.

16. RBI bars Federal Bank, South Indian Bank from issuing co-branded credit cards

- Following the directions by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), private sector lenders Federal Bank and South Indian Bank stopped issuing co-branded creditcards to new customers on account of regulatory deficiencies.
- South Indian Bank said that it will not onboard new customers on their co- branded credit cards until it is fully compliant with directions under RBI MasterDirection on Credit Card and Debit Card issuance.
- However, the lender added that it will continue to service the existing customerswho hold cobranded credit cards.
- South Indian Bank has one co-branded credit card in partnership with State Bankof India (SBI), which is available in two variants SimplySAVE and Platinum.

17. Total of 22,217 electoral bonds purchased: SBI to SC

- The State Bank of India (SBI) has told the Supreme Court that a total of 22,217 electoral bonds were purchased by political parties between April 1, 2019 and February 15 this year, out of which 22,030 were redeemed.
- In a compliance affidavit filed in the apex court, the SBI said as per the court's direction, it has made available the details of electoral bonds to the Election Commission of India before the close of business hours on March 12.
- A total number of 22,217 bonds were purchased during the period April 1, 2019till February 15, 2024.
- The affidavit said between April 1, 2019 to April 11, 2019, a total of 3,346electoral bonds were purchased and 1,609 redeemed.

18. Private banks' share in deposits rises to 34%

- The share of private sector banks in total deposits has risen significantly, reaching 34% as of December 2023, up from 25% at the end of the financial year2017-18.
- This growth has been driven by aggressive interest rate offerings and improvedcustomer relationship management strategies adopted by private banks.
- The share of public sector banks in the space has declined to 59% from 66% atthe



end of the financial year 2017-18, according to the Reserve Bank of India data.

• The ability of private banks to swiftly raise interest rates on fixed deposits hashelped them increase their share in total deposits.

19. RBI imposes ₹1.40 cr monetary penalty on Bank of India

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed a penalty of Rs 1.4 crore on Bankof India for noncompliance with certain regulatory norms.
- It has also imposed a penalty of Rs 29.55 lakh on private sector lender BandhanBank for noncompliance with certain directions.
- The penalty on Bank of India has been imposed for non-compliance with the RBI's directions related to 'interest rate on deposits', 'customer service in banks', 'interest rate on advances', and contravention of provisions of Credit InformationCompanies Rules 2006.

20. India's WPI inflation eases to four-month low of 0.20 per cent in Feb

- Data released by the Ministry of Commerce & Industry showed that India's wholesale price inflation eased further to a four-month low of 0.20 per cent inFebruary on an annual basis, as against 0.27 per cent in January.
- The sequential WPI rate for February grew 0.07 per cent against a contraction of(-)0.33 per cent in the month before.
- Inflation for food articles stood at 6.95 per cent in February. For the primary articles segment, the inflation rate in February surged to 4.49 per cent from 3.84per cent in the preceding month.

21. Axis Bank to support Tata Memorial-supported National Cancer Grid

- A national tumour biobank and cancer teleconsultation network are among theprojects that will be supported by a ₹100 crore contribution towards the National Cancer Grid (NCG), from Axis Bank.
- As part of the five-year partnership, Axis Bank will support NCG, a network of 300-plus cancer centres across the country, coordinated by the Tata MemorialHospital (TMH), under the Tata Memorial Centre.
- The aim is to improve cancer care and research, in terms of access and digital adoption on formalising a Memorandum of Understanding with Tata Memorial.

22. FinMin notifies Rs 90 coin to commemorate 90 years of RBI

- The Finance Ministry has notified the issuance of a special commemorative coinof Rs 90 denomination to mark the completion of 90 years of the RBI.
- One side of the coin shall bear the RBI's logo in the centre, with RBI@90inscribed below.
- This will be a silver coin with 99.99% silver purity, weighing about 40 grams
- The face of the coin shall bear the Lion Capital of Ashoka Pillar in the centre with "Satyamev Jayate" inscribed in the Devnagari script below it.



23. RBI imposes ₹1.31 cr. penalty on Tamilnad Mercantile Bank

- The Reserve Bank of India has imposed penalties on DCB Bank and Tamilnad Mercantile Bank for non-compliance with certain directions related to 'interest rate on advances'.
- A monetary penalty of Rs 63.6 lakh has been imposed on DCB Bank.
- A penalty of Rs 1.31 crore has been imposed on Tamilnad Mercantile Bank for non-compliance with certain directions issued by it on 'Interest Rate on Advances' and 'Central Repository of Information on Large Credits (CRILC) -Revision in Reporting.

24. Gross Direct Tax collections for FY 2023-24 register a growth of 18.74%

- The provisional figures of Direct Tax collections for the Financial Year 2023-24(as on 17.03.2024) show that Net collections are at Rs. 18,90,259 crore, compared to Rs. 15,76,776 crore in the corresponding period of the precedingFinancial Year (i.e. FY 2022-23), representing an increase of 19.88%.
- The Net Direct Tax collection of Rs. 18,90,259 crore (as on 17.03.2024) includes Corporation Tax (CIT) at Rs. 9,14,469 crore (net of refund) and Personal IncomeTax (PIT) including Securities Transaction Tax (STT) at Rs. 9,72,224 crore (net of refund).

25. LIC world's stronge<mark>st insurance bra</mark>nd: Brand Finance Insurance

- Insurance behemoth Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) has emerged asthe strongest insurance brand globally, according to a report Brand Finance Insurance 100 2024.
- The report said that LIC's brand value remains steady at USD 9.8 billion, accompanied by a brand strength index score of 88.3 and an associated AAAbrand strength rating.
- Following LIC, the rankings highlight Cathay Life Insurance as the second strongest brand, experiencing a 9 per cent increase in brand value to USD 4.9billion, closely followed by NRMA Insurance, which saw an 82 per cent rise inbrand value to USD 1.3 billion.

26. Innoviti Payments, Concerto Software get RBI payment aggregator licences

- Offline point-of-sales deploying company Innoviti Payments and payment gateway Vegaah, which is run by Concerto Software and Systems, have secured the online payment aggregator (PA) licence from the Reserve Bank of India, joining the likes of MSwipe, Razorpay, Cashfree, and Zomato.
- CCAvenue, which is run by listed fintech company Infibeam Avenues, also received its PA licence from the RBI earlier this month.
- As PAs, these companies are authorized to settle ecommerce transactions. The licence also brings these payment companies directly within the purview of RBIregulations.
- Bengaluru-based Innoviti has around 2,500 online merchants who are using itsonline payment system named 'Innoviti Link'.

27. RBI imposes Rs 59.90 lakh fine on Nashik's Janalaxmi Cooperative Bank

- The Reserve Bank has imposed a penalty of Rs 59.90 lakh on Nashik-basedJanalaxmi Cooperative Bank for non-compliance with regulations.
- The bank had failed to constitute a board of management within the extended timeline granted by



RBI, sanctioned credit facilities to its nominal members in excess of the prescribed limit, and, opened/renewed term deposits at interestrates higher than those offered by the State Bank of India for the same tenor.

• The central bank also imposed a penalty of Rs 28.30 lakh on Solapur Janata Sahakari Bank for appointing a member on its board of management who did notsatisfy the 'fit and proper' criteria and failure to reconstitute the panel within thespecified time and contravention of Supervisory Action Framework by the lenderby sanctioning fresh loans carrying risk weights of more than 100 per cent in FY22.

28. Government to borrow ₹7.5-lakh crore in April-Sept

- The government will borrow ₹7.5-lakh crore between April 1 and September 30.
- The interim Budget has set a target of ₹14.13-lakh crore of gross borrowing during FY25 to bridge the deficit between expenditure and Income.
- This means 53 per cent of the yearly target is to be borrowed during the first halfof the current fiscal, which is lower than the previous years' number of 60 per cent or more.

29. SEBI cancels investment banking licence of Karvy Investor Services

- Capital markets regulator SEBI has cancelled the registration of Karvy InvestorServices Ltd. (KISL) as a merchant banker for breach of eligibility criteria.
- The order came after the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) conducted an inspection of Karvy Investor Services during March 15-17, 2023 and in the onsite inspection, the regulator found that the merchant banker wasnot functioning or operational both at the registered as well as in the correspondence address.
- In April 2023, SEBI barred Karvy Investor Services from taking new clients forallegedly violating regulatory norms.
- It had found that KISL neither had any physical infrastructure nor any employee working for it.

30. Bank of India to raise Rs 10,000 cr via infrastructure bonds

- Bank of India (BoI)'s board has given approval to raise Rs 10,000 crore throughlong-term infra bonds to fund infrastructure projects.
- The fund would be raised in 2024-25, Bol said in a regulatory filing.
- Recently, many banks including SBI have issued infrastructure bonds to secure funds that are solely dedicated to advancing various infrastructure developmentprojects.
- These bonds help in building roads, bridges, airports, power plants, and telecommunications networks etc and addressing the infrastructure deficit of thecountry.

31. Axis Bank launches Digital US Dollar Fixed Deposits for NRIs at GIFT City

- Axis Bank has launched the digital US dollar Fixed Deposits (FD) tailored for Non-Resident Indian (NRI) customers at the IFSC Banking Unit (IBU) situated inGIFT City, Gujarat.
- The US Dollar fixed deposit scheme offers a diverse array of investment tenuresranging from seven days to an extensive ten years.
- Additionally, customers retain the flexibility to request partial or full prematureclosure of their FD through the Axis Bank mobile application, enhancing their control and convenience over their



investments.

- With this introduction, Axis Bank becomes the first bank to offer a digital journeyfor GIFT City Deposits.
- Income Tax department has levied a penalty of Rs 564.44 crore on Bank of India, the public sector lender.
- The bank has received the order under Section 270A of the Income Tax Act, 1961from the Income Tax Department, Assessment Unit pertaining to AY2018-19, wherein the penalty of Rs 564.44 crore has been imposed on various disallowances made.

Chapter 16: Defence News

1. DRDO conducts successful flight test of VSHORADS missile

- Defence Research and Development Organization (DRDO) conducted a successful flight test of a Very Short-Range Air Defence System (VSHORADS) missile from a ground-based portable launcher off the coast of Odisha from theIntegrated Test Range in Chandipur.
- The test was carried out against high-speed unmanned aerial targets underdifferent interception scenarios.
- The VSHORADS is propelled by a dual thrust solid motor and would be used forneutralising low altitude aerial threats at short ranges.
- The VSHORADS is a Man Portable Air Defence System (MANPAD) indigenouslydeveloped by Research Centre Imarat (RCI) in collaboration with other DRDO laboratories and other industry partners.

2. Iran launches 'Pars 1' satellite into orbit from Russia

- Russia has launched an Iranian-made research satellite into orbit amid risingtensions with the West.
- The Pars 1 remote sensing and imaging satellite was launched by a Russian Soyuz rocket from the



Vostochny Cosmodrome and will scan Iran's topographyfrom an orbit of 310 miles (500km).

- The launch of Pars 1 follows the August 2022 deployment of Iran's Khayyamsatellite, also facilitated by Russia.
- This pattern of collaboration indicates a strengthening of scientific and technological ties between Iran and Russia, amidst broader geopolitical tensions.

3. Navy commissions strategically important base INS Jatayu in Lakshadweep Islands

- The Indian Navy has commissioned its new base "INS Jatayu" at Minicoy Island, Lakshadweep It will bolster its operational capabilities within the strategically important Lakshadweep islands.
- Jatayu has been commissioned under the command of Commandant Vrat Baghel.
- The crest of the INS Jatayu -depicting a bird signifying Jatayu, a character in theHindu epic Ramayana -- was hoisted after the unveiling of the commissioning plaque.

4. CCS gives nod to 5th generation aircraft project worth ₹15,000 crore

- The Cabinet Committee on Security (CCS) has approved the project for the design and development of India's fifth-generation fighter jet, Advanced MediumCombat Aircraft (AMCA), to be undertaken by the Defence Research and Development Organization (DRDO).
- The AMCA is envisaged as a 25-tonne twin-engine stealth aircraft with aninternal weapons bay and Diverterless Supersonic Intake which has beendeveloped in India for the first time.
- It is intended to have an internal carriage of 1,500 kg of payload and 5,500 kg of external payload with 6,500 kg of internal fuel.
- The development of AMCA is planned to be carried out in two phases, an MK1 with the General Electric F414 engine and an Mk2 with a more powerful engineplanned to be co-developed in partnership with Saran of France for which discussions are underway.

5. DRDO successfully conducts Mission Divyastra

- Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has conducted firstsuccessful flight test of indigenously developed Agni-5 missile with Multiple Independently Targetable Re-Entry Vehicle (MIRV) technology.
- The flight test named Mission Divyastra was carried out from Dr APJ AbdulKalam Island in Odisha.
- Various Telemetry and radar stations tracked and monitored multiple re-entryvehicles. The Mission accomplished the designed parameters.
- Missiles equipped with MIRV technology can aim multiple targets that can be located hundreds of kilometres apart. Agni-5, which can carry nuclear warheadsand hit targets more than 5,000 km away, is aimed mainly at thwarting the challenge from China.
- The Agni 1 to 4 missiles have ranges from 700 km to 3,500 km and have alreadybeen deployed.

6. UK tests a laser weapon that can hit a coin from a kilometer

- The UK's Ministry of Defence (MoD) has conducted successful tests of its first-ever laser weapon, named "DragonFire".
- The high-powered laser is designed to target and neutralize drones, offering apotentially low-cost alternative to traditional missiles.



- The DragonFire laser weapon is expected to significantly reduce the reliance onexpensive ammunition, offering a cost-effective solution for air defense.
- 7. Army raises helicopter unit at Jodhpur to induct Apache attack choppers
 - The Indian Army has raised its first squadron of Apache attack helicopters inRajasthan's Jodhpur with the aim of supporting ground operations near the Pakistan border.
 - Developed by the US aviation giant Boeing, Apache choppers are known as the tanks in the air'.
 - They are advanced multi-mission helicopters with the latest technology and havecome to be known the best attack helicopters in the world.

8. Guyana to acquire 2 HAL-Made Dornier 228 Aircraft from India

- The Indian defence industry is making forays in the Caribbean with the Guyana Defence Force (GDF) planning to soon acquire two new aircraft from New Delhiwith a \$23.27 million loan from Export-Import Bank of India.
- An agreement in this regard was signed between Guyanese Finance Minister andDeputy GM of EXIM Bank.
- Guyana, which has a substantial Indian diaspora, plans to purchase two HAL(Dornier) 228 planes
 from Hindustan Aeronautics Limited.

9. LCA Tejas MK-1A completes maiden flight in Bengaluru

- The Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) has successfully completed the firstflight of indigenous light combat aircraft (LCA) Tejas Mark 1A fighter jet in Bengaluru.
- The aircraft was airborne for 15 minutes during its first flight.
- The fighter aircraft is likely to be deployed at Nal airbase in Rajasthan's Bikanernear the Pakistan border where it can take care of the western adversary.
- LCA Mk-1A is an advanced variant of the LCA Mk-1, and it has advanced electronic radar, superior warfare capabilities, and improved maintenancefeatures.

1. Paul Pogba banned for four years for doping

- France and Juventus midfielder Paul Pogba has been banned for four years for adoping.
- Pogba was provisionally suspended by Italy's national anti-doping (NADO Italia)tribunal in September after testing positive for testosterone — a banned substance.
- The test, performed after Juve's 3-0 Serie A season-opening victory at Udinese onAug. 20, detected testosterone, a hormone that increases athletes' endurance.
- The 30-year-old was an unused substitute in that game.

2. Pro Kabaddi League Season 10, Puneri Paltan Clinches Maiden Title

- Puneri Paltan won the Pro Kabaddi League trophy for the first time as theydefeated the Haryana Steelers in the final at the GMC Balayogi Stadium in Hyderabad.
- The Paltan took an early lead with Ankit opening the scoring for the Steelers and Rahul Sethpal keeping the game interesting with his dynamic offensive moves.

3. B Sai Praneeth announces retirement from international badminton

- Indian shuttler B Sai Praneeth has announced his retirement from internationalbadminton.
- The 31-year-old battled nagging injuries since the Olympic Games in Tokyo and decided to hang his boots due to that.
- In his 24-year-long career, he won a World Championships bronze medal and represented India at the Tokyo 2020 Olympics.



4. Shahbaz Nadeem retires from international and India's domestic cricket

- Spinner Shahbaz Nadeem has retired from all forms of international cricket.
- Now, he wants to play in T20 leagues worldwide.
- Nadeem took 542 wickets in his first-class career and played two Tests for India.
- His Test debut was in 2019 when he was 30 years old.
- The Jharkhand spinnerwas called in place of Kuldeep Yadav. During the Ranchi Test against South Africa, Shahbaz took 2 wickets for 22 in the first innings and 2 wickets for 18 in the second innings.

5. Sunrisers Hyderabad appoint Pat Cummins as captain for IPL 2024

- Sunrisers Hyderabad (SRH) has announced star Australian cricketer Pat Cummins as their new captain for the Indian Premier League (IPL) season 2024.
- Cummins, who won the ICC World Test Championship and ICC Cricket WorldCup with Aussies last year as a captain, replaces South African batter Aiden Markram as the franchise's captain.
- Cummins was brought by SRH for Rs 20.5 crores in the IPL auctions held lastyear, making him the second-most expensive player in history.

6. Umpire Marais Erasmus set to retire

- Veteran South Africa umpire Marais Erasmus has announced his retirement from the ICC Elite Panel of Umpires.
- His illustrious career spanning over two decades will culminate with his finalofficiating duty during the second Test between New Zealand and Australia.
- The Christchurch Test will be Erasmus' 82nd men's Test match as umpire, putting him 10th on the list of umpires to officiate in most Test matches.
- Erasmus also officiated 124 men's ODIs, 43 men's T20 matches, and 18 women'sT20 matches. In 131 international games, he has also served as the TV umpire.
- Erasmus was the on-field umpire in 25 ICC Men's Cricket World Cup matches, 33ICC Men's T20 World Cup matches, 18 ICC Women's T20 World Cup matches andsix ICC Champions Trophy games. He stood in seven finals of ICC tournaments.

7. James Anderson becomes first pacer to pick 700 Test wickets

- England great James Anderson has become first-ever fast bowler to pick up 700Test wickets in 187 matches.
- The 41-year-old got to the major landmark when he dismissed Kuldeep Yadav onDay 3 of the fifth and final Test against hosts India at the HPCA Stadium in Dharamsala.
- The legendary fast bowler became only the third man after Sri Lanka's MuttiahMuralitharan (800) in 133 mathes and leg-spinner Shane Warne (708) in 145 matches to achieve the feat.
- Anderson's longevity is a thing of marvel in international cricket as the fast bowler made his debut in 2003 and continues to be one of the leading bowlers in the Test format of the game.

8. Satwik-Chirag win French Open doubles title

• The pair of Satwiksairaj Rankireddy and Chirag Shetty clinched its secondFrench Open men's doubles badminton title.



- The Indian top seed registered a straight games victory over Chinese Taipei's LeeJhe-Huei and Yang Po-Hsuan in the final.
- Satwik-Chirag, who earlier won the title in 2022, clinched a 21-11, 21-17 win tobag the second final at the tournament.
- 9. Indian sailor Vishnu Saravanan clinches gold medal at Europa Cup
 - Indian sailor Vishnu Saravanan won the gold medal at the Europa Cup 2024 in the ILCA 7 category in Mallorca, Spain.
 - The event was organized by Reial Club Nautic Port de Pollenca. Saravanantopped the 91-boat race with 17 net points.
 - Australia's Lawson McAullay won the bronze with 22 net points at the event.
 - The ILCA7 is a category within the ILCA -International Laser Class Associationsailing class.

10. Rachin Ravindra becomes youngest cricketer to win Sir Richard Hadlee Medal

- New Zealand's top order batter Rachin Ravindra has become the youngestrecipient of the Sir Richard Hadlee Medal after being named the country's outstanding male cricketer of the year.
- Meanwhile, Amelia Kerr became the year's top female cricketer after winning theDebbie Hockley medal for the second time in a row.
- Kane Williamson received the ANZ Test Player of the Year Award and won theRedpath Cup for men's first-class batting.
- Ravindra, 24, is the youngest winner of the award in its history, following a season in which he has established himself as a key member of New Zealand'sred and white teams.

11. Max Verstappen triumphs at Saudi Arabian Grand Prix

- Red Bull's Max Verstappen clinched victory at the Saudi Arabian Grand Prix, starting from pole position.
- It marked Red Bull's second consecutive one-two finish in the 2024 Formula Oneseason.
- It was the first time Verstappen, winner of a record 19 of 22 races last year, haswon the first two races of a season.
- Sergio Perez (Red Bull) finished at second and Charles Leclerc finished third forFerrari.
- The victory was a ninth in a row for Verstappen, dating back to Japan lastSeptember, and the 56th of the 26-year-old Dutch driver's career.
- It was also his 100th career podium while Red Bull's 115th win lifted them aheadof Williams in fourth place on the all-time list.

12. Mumbai Wins Ranji Trophy 2024 after beating Vidarbha
