Chapter 11: GDP Forecasting

- 1. Morgan Stanley projects India's GDP growth for FY25 to 6.5%
 - Morgan Stanley Research projects India's GDP growth for FY25 to moderate to 6.5%, down from the 6.9% projected for FY24.
 - Despite this moderation, the report maintains a constructive outlook on the Indian economy, citing improvements in domestic demand and macro stability.
- 2. India's GDP to grow at around 6.75-6.8% in FY25: BoB
 - The Bank of Baroda (BoB) has projected India's gross domestic product (GDP) to grow at around 6.75



to 6.8 per cent in FY25 and 6.8 per cent for the current financial year.

• The IMF has projected the Indian economy to grow at 6.7 per cent for the current fiscal, upgrading the estimates by 40 basis points from its previous forecast in Oct 2023.

Chapter 12: Current Affairs (National)

1. India home to 718 snow leopards: SPAI report

- India is home to around 718 snow leopards, according to the first-ever population estimation exercise conducted by the Snow Leopard Population Assessment in India (SPAI) Programme.
- The highest number of snow leopards were recorded in Ladakh (477), followed by Uttarakhand (124), Himachal Pradesh (51), Arunachal Pradesh (36), Sikkim (21), and Jammu and Kashmir (9).

2. Punjab CM Flagged Off Sadak Suraksha Force

- The Chief Minister of Punjab, Bhagwant Mann has launched a new initiative called the 'Sadak Suraksha Force' to improve traffic movement and reduce road accidents in the state.
- The force aims to protect people and streamline traffic movements in the state.
- The 'Sadak Suraksha Force' will comprise 144 vehicles and 5,000 employees who will be deployed every 30 kilometers on the roads to ensure the safety of the people.

3. Toyota keeps crown as world's top-selling automaker in 2023

- Toyota Motor sold a record 11.2 million vehicles in 2023, taking the crown as the world's top-selling automaker for a fourth straight year.
- Second-ranked German rival Volkswagen Group earlier this month reported a 12% rise in deliveries last year to 9.2 million cars, marking a post-pandemic recovery as supply chain bottlenecks eased.

4. Five more Indian wetlands added to Ramsar list



- India has added five more wetlands to the List of Wetlands of International Importance, or the Ramsar List, taking the number of such sites in the country to 80.
- The announcement of adding five more sites, three in Karnataka and two in Tamil Nadu, to the list was made by Federal Minister of Environment, Forest and Climate Change Bhupender Yadav.
- Three of these sites, Ankasamudra Bird Conservation Reserve, Aghanashini Estuary and Magadi Kere Conservation Reserve are located in Karnataka whereas two, Karaivetti Bird Sanctuary and Longwood Shola Reserve Forest are in Tamilnadu.

5. Dharmendra Pradhan launches MoE - AICTE Investor Network

- Union Minister Shri Dharmendra Pradhan has launched 'Ministry of Education AICTE Investor Network' in New Delhi.
- This initiative will be a ground-breaking beginning that will bring students, faculty, investors and the market on one platform to strengthen the culture of innovation.
- The network aims to provide crucial financial support, mentoring, and strategic guidance to early-stage student or faculty-led startups.

6. BHU gets automated DNA extractor machine

- North India's first human DNA bank is being set up at Banaras Hindu University (BHU).
- The Automated DNA Extractor Machine has been installed in the Gnyaneshwar Lab of the Zoology Department of BHU.
- These machines are completely indigenous to Make in India. It has been made in such a way that the minimum plastic is used in it, so that there is no harm to the environment.

7. Annual Mass Drug Administration Campaign to Eradicate Filariasis by UP

- The Uttar Pradesh government will launch the annual Mass Drug Administration (MDA) campaign to eradicate filariasis diseases from February 5 to 15.
- The campaign, to be carried out as part of a mission to eradicate filariasis from the state, will be conducted in 17 districts of the state.
- The central government aims to eliminate filariasis from the country by 2027.

8. 40,000 rail bogies to be converted to Vande Bharat standards

- In a move to modernize the Indian Railways, the Centre has announced an ambitious programme to upgrade 40,000 standard rail coaches to Vande Bharat standards.
- This initiative, announced by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman in while presenting the interim budget for fiscal year 2024-25 (FY25), aims to elevate the safety, convenience, and comfort of rail travel while also providing a boost to private sector railway manufacturers through new refurbishment contracts.

9. PM SVANIDHI provided credit assistance to 78 lakh street vendors

- Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman has announced that PM SVANIDHI, a flagship initiative focusing on street vendors, has extended credit assistance to 78 lakh street vendors across the country.
- 2.3 lakh vendors have availed loans for the third time under this initiative.

10. Record Rs 6.21 lakh crore allocation to Defence in Interim Budget 2024-25

• In the current geopolitical scenario and with the twin objective of promoting self-reliance and



exports, the Defence Budget has touched Rs 6,21,540.85 crore in the Financial Year 2024-25.

- This comes out to be 13.04% of the total Union Budget. The Ministry of Defence (MoD) continues to receive the highest allocation among the Ministries.
- The budgetary allocation to Defence for FY 24-25 is higher by approx. one lakh crore (18.35%) over the allocation for the FY 2022-23 and 4.72% more than allocation of FY 23-24.

11. Govt to focus on vaccination against cervical cancer

- Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman has announced the government's plans to focus on vaccination against cervical cancer for girls aged 9 to 14 as part of her Interim Budget 2024.
- The FM also announced multiple other health-related schemes in her speech, including extending Ayushman Bharat cover to all Asha workers and Anganwadi workers and helpers.

19. RBI Imposes Major Restrictions on Paytm Payments Bank

- In exercise of its powers under section 35A of the Banking Regulation Act, RBI has directed that no further deposits and credit transactions or top-ups shall be allowed in any customer accounts, prepaid instruments, wallets, and FASTags after the 29th of February, other than any interest, cashbacks, or refunds which may be credited anytime

20. GST collections rise 10% to ₹1.72 lakh crore in January

- The gross GST revenue collected in the month of January 2024 is ₹1,72,129 crore, which shows a 10.4% Year-o-Year (Y-o-Y) growth over the revenue of ₹155,922 crore collected in January 2023.
- Notably, this is the second-highest monthly collection ever and marks the third month in this financial year with a collection of ₹1.70 lakh crore or more.

21. Saudi Arabia, UAE, Ethiopia, Iran, Egypt confirmed they are joining BRICS

- The BRICS group, a key platform for emerging markets and developing countries, has officially welcomed five new members: Egypt, Iran, Saudi Arabia, the United Arab Emirates, and Ethiopia.
- The five countries were extended invitations along with Argentina at a summit in August in Johannesburg to join the bloc comprising Brazil, Russia, China, India and South Africa.

22. Government allocates 3.4% of GDP for Capital Expenditure Boost

- The government proposes to increase capital expenditure outlay by 11.1 per cent to Rs 11.11 lakh crore in 2024-25, amounting to 3.4 percent of the GDP, Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman in her interim Budget.
- The central government will focus especially on five eastern states Bihar, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, and West Bengal.



23. Govt revised the fiscal deficit estimates at 5.8% in FY24

- Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman has revised the estimate of the fiscal deficit for FY24 to 5.8 per cent while presenting the Interim Budget 2024-25.
- The Revised Estimate of the fiscal deficit is 5.8 percent of GDP, improving on the Budget Estimate, notwithstanding moderation in the nominal growth estimates.
- The government is committed to reducing the fiscal deficit below 4.5 per cent by 2025-26, adding that the fiscal deficit in 2024-25 is estimated to be 5.1 per cent of GDP.

24. 97.50% of Rs 2,000 Notes Returned to System: RBI

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has announced nearly 97.5 per cent of the Rs 2,000 bank notes have been returned to the banking system, and only about Rs 8,897 crore worth of the withdrawn notes are still with the public.
- On May 19, 2023 the RBI announced the withdrawal of Rs 2,000 denomination bank notes from circulation.
- The total value of Rs 2,000 banknotes in circulation, which was Rs 3.56 lakh crore at the close of business on May 19, 2023.

25. ESAF Small Finance Bank and Edelweiss Insurance partner to offer Life Insurance

- ESAF Small Finance Bank has partnered with a bancassurance collaboration with Edelweiss Tokio Life Insurance.

26. UPI transactions reach a record Rs 18.41 trillion in January: NPCI

- Unified payments interface (UPI) has started 2024 on a strong note, with transaction spends staying over the ₹18-lakh crore mark and touching a new record high.
- Transactions worth ₹18.41-lakh crore were processed during January, nearly 1 per cent higher than the previous record of ₹18.23-lakh crore in December 2023.
- The value of transactions was 42 per cent higher on year, as per data by the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI). The number of transactions on the UPI network remained flat on month at 1,202 crore for January. In the year, the volume of transactions was 52 per cent higher.

27. Government Boosts Sovereign Gold Bond Issuance to 3,500 Crore in FY 25

- The Indian government has decided to substantially increase the issuance of Sovereign Gold Bonds (SGB) for the upcoming fiscal year.
- The allocation for SGBs has been more than doubled, rising from ₹1,500 crore in the financial year ending March 31, 2023, to a significant ₹3,500 crore for the fiscal year 2024-25.

28. Digital payments rise 10.94 pc annually at September-end 2023: RBI

- Digital payments across the country registered a growth of 10.94 per cent in a year through March 2023, as per RBI's index that measures the adoption of online transactions.
- RBI's Digital Payments Index (RBI-DPI) stood at 418.77 at end-September 2023 compared to 377.46 in September 2022 and 395.57 in March 2023.
- The index comprises five broad parameters that enable the measurement of the depth and penetration of digital payments in the country over different periods.
- These parameters are Payment Enablers (weight 25 per cent); Payment Infrastructure Demand-side



factors (10 per cent); Payment Infrastructure - Supply-side factors (15 percent); Payment Performance (45 per cent); and Consumer Centricity (5 percent).

29. SBI's Q3FY24 net profit drops 35.5% due to one-time provisions

- State Bank of India (SBI) has reported a drop in net profit for the first time in 12 quarters, with its third quarter (Q3FY24) standalone net profit declining 35.5 per cent year-on-year (yoy) to ₹9,164 crore
- As it absorbed one-time provisions relating to increase in pension liabilities and dearness relief neutralization.

- Max Financial Services has received approval from Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority
 of India (IRDAI) for capital infusion of Rs 1,612 crore by Axis Bank into the company's material
 subsidiary, Max Life Insurance.
- As part of the deal, Max Life will issue nearly 14, 25, 79,161 equity shares to Axis Bank for an aggregate investment of above-mentioned amount.

41. India's Retail inflation is at 3-mth low to 5.1% in January

- India's retail inflation eased to a three-month low of 5.1% in January from 5.7% a month earlier, with food price rise cooling a bit to 8.3% compared with 9.5% in December 2023.
- The number has remained within the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) tolerance band of 2-6 per cent.
- Inflation rate in rural and urban areas stood at 5.34 per cent, 4.92 per cent, down from 5.93 per cent and 5.46 per cent seen in the same month a year ago.

Chapter 16: Defence News

1. SARVATRA: A Multispan Mobile Bridging System Developed by DRDO

- SARVATRA, a Multispan Mobile Bridging System designed and developed by Armament and Combat Engineering Systems (ACE) of Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) under the Ministry of Defence.
- SARVATRA assists the Army in constructing bridges over flowing water, ensuring robust connectivity between two areas during natural disasters.

2. Indian Navy Declares 2024 As 'Year of Naval Civilians'

- Indian Navy has declared 2024 as 'Year of Naval Civilians' to improve administration, efficiency and well-being of Naval Civilians by addressing all facets of Civilian HR Management in a time bound manner.
- Major focus areas towards maximizing administrative efficiency, digital initiatives, generic and specific training programmes and welfare activities have been identified for implementation in 2024.

3. US State Department approves 31 armed drones to India

- The US State Department has given the go-ahead for the possible sale of 31 armed MQ-9B SkyGuardian drones, related missiles, and equipment to India for nearly \$4 billion.
- This comes after years of discussions between the two nations about such a deal.

4. IIT Madras to create India's first 155mm smart ammunition

- Indian Institute of Technology Madras (IIT Madras) has partnered with Munitions India Limited (a
 Defence Public Sector Enterprise) to develop India's first indigenously-designed 155 Smart
 Ammunition to achieve indigenization in the defence sector.
- The objective is to increase the accuracy of the 155 mm shell within a Circular Error Probable (CEP) of 10 m. At present, ammunition developed in India has a CEP of 500 m. Another goal is to increase the lethality at the terminal impact point.

5. Navy Chief Inaugurates New Defence System 'Precision Approach Radar'

- Chief of Naval Staff (CNS) Admiral R. Hari Kumar has inaugurated a Precision Approach Radar (PAR) at INS Utkrosh in Andaman and Nicobar Islands, which will enable "highly accurate horizontal and vertical guidance to land an aircraft safely in low visibility conditions, such as heavy rain and fog".
- He also inaugurated the IUHDSS (Integrated Underwater Harbour Defence and Surveillance System) at Naval Jetty, Port Blair.



6. Defence Ministry Signs Rs 2,269 Crore Contract with BEL

- The Ministry of Defence has signed a contract with Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL) for the procurement of 11 Shakti Electronic Warfare Systems for the Indian Navy.
- The contract is worth 2,269 Crore Rupees.

7. MoD signs contract with AWEIL for 463 Stabilised Remote-Control Guns for Indian Navy & Indian Coast Guard

- The Ministry of Defence has signed a contract with Advanced Weapon Equipment India Ltd (AWEIL),
 Kanpur for the manufacturing & supply of a total of 463 indigenously manufactured 12.7 mm
 Stabilised Remote-Control Guns (SRCG) for the Indian Navy & Indian Coast Guard at a total cost of Rs.
 1752.13 crores.
- The SRCG will enhance the capability of Navy and Coast Guard to accurately engage small targets that pose a threat to ships in an asymmetric environment, both by day and night.

8. North Korea launched new surface-to-sea missiles

- North Korea test-launched the new surface-to-sea missiles, "Padasuri-6".
- The missile hit a target after launch over waters in the East Sea for around 1400 seconds, or 23 minutes and 20 seconds.
- The missile seems to be designed to counter the naval capabilities of South Korea and the United States, such as U.S. aircraft carriers.

9. Aeronautical Development Agency Signs MoU with Indian Air Force

- Aeronautical Development Agency (ADA) has signed an MoU with the Indian Air Force (IAF) for integration of futuristic Weapons and Sensors for LCA Tejas aircraft.
- This will facilitate the IAF to independently carry out sensors, weapon integration and flight testing to enhance the operational capability of Tejas-LCA fighter.

- The first ever men's FIH Hockey5s World Cup came to a thrilling conclusion with the Netherlands overcoming Malaysia to lift the trophy.

2. Abhinav Bindra selected as torchbearer for the 2024 Paris Olympics

- Abhinav Bindra, India's first individual gold medalist at the Olympic Games, has been selected as a torchbearer for the upcoming 2024 Paris Olympic Games.
- He will be part of the Olympic torch relay to be held from April 16 to July 26.
- Bindra, a member of the Athletes Commission of the International Olympic Committee (IOC), clinched the gold medal in the men's 10m air rifle event at the Beijing Olympic Games in 2008.

3. Khelo India Winter Games 2024 mascot, snow leopard 'Sheen-e She' (Shan) reveals

- The mascot and logo of Khelo India Winter Games were launched. The first part of the Winter Games, a mouth-watering event for winter sports athletes, will be held in the Union Territory of Ladakh for the first time from February 2-6. The second portion is scheduled in Gulmarg, Jammu & Kashmir from February 21-25.
- In keeping with the tradition and biodiversity of the region, the mascot of the Khelo India Winter Games 2024 is a snow leopard. It has been named 'Sheen-e She' or Shan in Ladakh region.

4. SCA Stadium Renamed in Honor of Niranjan Shah

- The Saurashtra Cricket Association (SCA) stadium in Rajkot has been re-named as the Niranjan Shah Stadium.
- This change comes as a tribute to the former first-class cricketer and senior cricket administrator,
 Niranjan Shah, marking his immense contributions to the sport and the region.

5. Shamar Joseph and Amy Hunter awarded ICC Players of The Month for Jan 2024

- The International Cricket Council (ICC) has announced the winners of the ICC Men's and Women's Player of the Month for January 2024.
- West Indies' Shamar Joseph has become the first West Indian to win the Men's ICC Player of the Month award for his heroics in the Australia Test series.

6. Anurag Thakur hands over Chess Olympiad Torch to Hungary

- Union Minister for Youth Affairs and Sports, Anurag Singh Thakur handed over the Chess Olympiad Torch to Budapest, Hungary.
- Hungary to host the 45th edition of the Chess Olympiad.
- The transfer of the torch took place at the Major Dhyan Chand National Stadium in New Delhi.

7. Indian hammer thrower Rachna Kumari banned for 12 years for doping

- The Athletics Integrity Unit (AIU) has suspended hammer thrower Rachna Kumari for 12 years for a second anti-doping rule violation.
- Rachna returned positive results for multiple anabolic androgenic steroids in samples collected out of competition at Patiala on September 24 and on November 1 at the National Games last year.

8. R Ashwin joins elite 500 test wicket club

• Indian off-spinner Ravichandran Ashwin has claimed his 500th Test wicket in the first innings of the



third Test match against England at the Niranjan Shah Stadium in Rajkot.

• The 37-year-old achieved this monumental feat in his 98th Test Match. Ashwin dismissed Zak Crawley on the second day to join Anil Kumble as the second Indian to take 500 wickets in Test history.

9. ICC bans UK cricketer Rizwan Javed for over 17.5 years for Match-Fixing

- A UK club cricketer, Rizwan Javed received a 17.5 years ban from all cricket due to his participation in match-fixing attempts during the 2021 Abu Dhabi T10 League.
- Authorities enforce the ban on September 19, 2023, as Javed failed to address charges related to his involvement in the league.

10. India women clinch Badminton Asia Team Championships title

- India women's badminton team scripted history in Selangor Malaysia as they won the Badminton Asia Team Championships crown, beating Thailand 3-2 in a hard-fought final.
- This is the first time India have won the prestigious continental team championship title in the history of the sport.

11. MS Dhoni Named Captain of IPL's Greatest All-Time Team

- Chennai Super Kings (CSK) skipper MS Dhoni was picked as the captain to lead the all-time greatest
 IPL side.
- The 15-member squad was selected by a panel of experts, including former legends Wasim Akram, Dale Steyn, Matthew Hayden, and Tom Moody, along with 70 other journalists.

12. Manoj Tiwary announces retirement from all forms of cricket

- India and Bengal batter Manoj Tiwary has announced retirement from all forms of cricket.
- Tiwary played 148 First-Class matches and gathered 10,195 runs at an average of 47.86, with a career-best 303 not out and 30 centuries. He scored 5,581 runs in List-A matches and 3,436 runs in T20s.

13. Eight year-old Ashwath becomes youngest chess player to beat grandmaster

- Eight-year-old Ashwath Kaushik has become the youngest player to defeat a grandmaster after trouncing Jacek Stopa during the Burgdorfer Stadthaus Open in Switzerland.
- The Indian-born Singapore resident learnt to play the game at the age of four and became a World Under-Eight Rapid Champion in 2022.

14. Pakistan's Babar Azam becomes quickest to 10,000 runs in T20s

- Pakistan's Babar Azam has become the fastest batter to notch 10,000 runs in T20 cricket.
- Babar achieved this feat during a Pakistan Super League (PSL) 2024 match between Peshawar Zalmi and Karachi Kings played at the Gaddafi Stadium in Lahore.

15. Indian Squash player Abhay Singh wins Goodfellow Classic squash

- Indian Squash player Abhay Singh clinched the Goodfellow Classic PSA Challenger Tour Title in Toronto, Canada.
- In the finals, he defeated Elliott Morris Devred of Wales by 3-0.
- With this win, the Asian Games Gold medalist has won his eighth PSA World Tour title.

16. India bags nine gold medals at Archery Asia Cup 2024 in Baghdad

- India finished the Archery Asia Cup 2024 with 14 medals, including nine gold, four silver and one bronze medal in Baghdad, Iraq.
- In the women's individual recurve category, three-time Olympian Deepika Kumari won the gold medal



by defeating compatriot Simranjeet Kaur 6-2. Meanwhile, in an all-Indian final, Dhiraj Bommadevara beat Tarundeep Rai 7-3 to win the men's recurve archery title.

17. Namibia's Jan Nicol Loftie-Eaton smashes fastest T20I Hundred

- Namibia's Jan Nicol Loftie-Eaton scripted history by scoring the fastest century in T20 International (T20I) history during a bilateral match against Nepal.
- Achieving this monumental feat off just 33 balls, Loftie-Eaton shattered the previous record held by Nepal's Kushal Malla, who had set the benchmark at 34 balls against Mongolia during the Asian Games in 2023.
- New Zealand's Neil Wagner retires from international cricket
- New Zealand fast bowler Neil Wagner has decided to bring the curtain down on his illustrious 64-Test career for the Black Caps, formally announcing his retirement from international cricket.

1. Russian cosmonaut sets world record for time spent in space

- The 59-year-old has now spent more than 878 days and 12 hours in space, surpassing fellow Russian Gennady Padalka, who set the previous record of 878 days, 11 hours, 29 minutes, and 48 seconds in 2015.

2. IIT Kanpur develops India's first hypervelocity expansion tunnel test facility

- The Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur (IITK) has achieved a major milestone by successfully establishing and testing India's first hypervelocity expansion tunnel test facility.
- With this technical facility developed by IIT Kanpur, hypersonic cruise missiles can be prepared for precise targeting.

3. ISRO launched INSAT-3DS Satellite from Sriharikota

- Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has successfully launched meteorological satellite INSAT-3DS with the GSLV-F14/INSAT-3DS mission from SDSC-SHAR, Sriharikota.
- This will help in enhancing the weather forecast.
- This was ISRO's second success in the current calendar after the launch of XPoSAT from Sriharikota on January 1 in PSLV's 60th flight

4. NASA, Japan to launch world's 1st wooden satellite soon

- Japan and the US are planning to launch the world's first wooden satellite, the LingnoSat, into space in 2024.
- This unusual spacecraft is made up of Magnolia wood which, during the experiments, was found to be particularly stable and resistant to cracking

5. PM Modi announced India's own Space Station by 2035

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has declared India's plan to establish its own space station by 2035. This initiative aims to facilitate advanced exploration of the universe.
- Among other feats, India now aims for setting up 'Bharatiya Antariksha Station' by 2035 and sending the first Indian to the Moon by 2040.
