## Chapter 11: GDP Forecasting

### 1. India Ratings raises FY25 GDP growth forecast to 7.1% from 6.5%

- India Ratings and Research revised upward the country's GDP growth estimate for FY25 to 7.1 per cent from 6.5 per cent earlier.
- The projection is marginally higher than the Reserve Bank's estimate of 7 percent.

### 2. Indian economy likely to grow at 6.6% in FY25: Moody's

- Moody's Ratings projected a 6.6% growth rate for the Indian economy in the fiscal year ending March 2025 (FY25).
- The RBI, Asian Development Bank (ADB), and Fitch Ratings each estimate a 7% growth rate for FY25, while S&P Global Ratings and Morgan Stanley predict a 6.8% growth rate.

### 3. UN revises India's 2024 growth forecast to 6.9%

- The United Nations (UN) has revised India's growth projections for 2024 and expects the economy to grow by 6.9% for FY24.
- The report also predicts a growth rate of 6.6% for 2025, which remains unchanged from the previous forecast.
- This expected decrease aligns with the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI's) target range of 2-6%.
- The world economy is now forecast to grow by 2.7% in 2024 and 2.8% in 2025, reflecting better outlooks in the United States, Brazil, India, and Russia.

### 4. Goldman Sachs raises India's GDP growth forecast to 6.7 percent for FY24

- Global investment bank Goldman Sachs has raised India's GDP growth forecast to 6.7 percent for calendar year 2024.
- The latest data released by the bank said, they expect a sustained growth momentum with additional fiscal space on account of a bumper dividend transfer from the RBI.

### 5. RBI projects 7% Real GDP growth in current financial year

- The Reserve Bank of India has projected a 7 percent GDP growth in the current financial year.
- In its annual report, RBI said the real GDP growth for 2024-25 is projected to grow at 7 per cent

with risks evenly balanced.

- ♦ The Indian economy expanded at a robust pace in fiscal 2024, with real GDP growth accelerating to 7.6 percent from 7 percent in previous year.

## Chapter 12: Current Affairs (National)

### 1. UP govt to establish cyber police stations in 57 districts

- ♦ The **Uttar Pradesh government** is to **establish cyber police stations in 57 districts** after the parliamentary polls with each cyber police station having 25 posts for officers and employees.
- ♦ The state government plans to create a total of 1,425 posts in the designated 57 police stations across the state.

### 2. India Reduces Windfall Tax on Petroleum Crude

- ♦ **India** has cut its **windfall tax on petroleum crude to 8,400 Indian rupees (\$100.66) a metric ton from 9,600 rupees with effect from May 1.**
- ♦ The government had on April 16 raised the windfall tax on petroleum crude to 9,600 rupees a metric ton from 6,800 rupees.
- ♦ This tax is levied as the **Special Additional Excise Duty (SAED).**

### 3. Indian Army and Punit Balan Group develop Constitution Park in Pune

- ♦ **Constitution Park, jointly developed by Indian Army and Punit Balan Group,** was inaugurated in **Pune.**
- ♦ The park was inaugurated by GOC-in-C, Southern Command, Lt Gen Ajai Kumar Singh.
- ♦ It delineates our Fundamental Rights and underscores our Fundamental Duties. It's crucial for every citizen to understand their rights and fulfill their duties.

### 4. India's core sector growth slows to 5.2% in March from 7.1% in February

- ♦ The **growth in output of eight key infrastructure industries slowed to 5.2% year-on-year in March** from 7.1% in February on the back of a sequential deterioration recorded by five of its constituents.
- ♦ Output decelerated in sectors like coal (8.7%), crude oil (2%), natural gas (6.3%) and steel (5.5%) during March, according to Ministry of Commerce and Industry data.
- ♦ The eight core industries account for 40.27 per cent weighting of items included in the Index of Industrial Production (IIP) and, thus, have a significant impact on the index.

### 5. REC gets RBI nod to set up subsidiary in GIFT City

- ♦ **State-owned REC Ltd,** under the Ministry of Power and a leading NBFC, has received a '**No Objection Certificate**' (NOC) from the **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** for setting up a subsidiary in Gujarat International Finance Tech-City (GIFT) in Gandhinagar, Gujarat.
- ♦ The proposed subsidiary will engage in a range of financial activities as a finance company within GIFT, including lending, investment, and other financial services.



## 6. Auto Expo set to move back to New Delhi in 2025

- ♦ **The Auto Expo** is set to return to the national capital in 2025, after a decade.
- ♦ India's flagship biennial motor show will be organized next year under the Bharat Mobility umbrella in New Delhi's Pragati Maidan, 10 years after the exhibition was moved to Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh, in 2014.

## 7. Bajaj Auto to launch world's first CNG-powered bike in June

- ♦ **Bajaj Auto** will launch the world's first compressed natural gas (CNG) motorcycle on June 2024.
- ♦ This move marks a significant shift in the industry, providing customers with a cost-effective and eco-friendly alternative to traditional petrol motorcycles.
- ♦ With the new CNG-powered bikes, customers can expect a significant reduction in operational costs, making it an attractive proposition in today's market.

## 8. IAF conducts Bambi Bucket Operation in response to the forest fires in Uttarakhand

- ♦ The **Indian Air Force** had deployed its **Mi17 V5 helicopters** to undertake **Bambi Bucket operations** to douse the forest fires near Nainital, Uttarakhand.
- ♦ These helicopters efficiently transported and released over 4,500 liters of water over the affected areas, a crucial effort made in close coordination with the Uttarakhand government.

## 9. IIT Madras startup Mindgrove launches first India-made microcontroller chip

- ♦ India is finally set to have a made-in-India microcontroller chip powering electronic device.
- ♦ **Mindgrove Technologies**, incubated by **IIT Madras Pravartak Technologies Foundation** and **IIT Madras Incubation Cell**, and supported by **Peak XV Partners**, has launched **Secure IoT, India's debut high-performance SoC (system on chip)**.
- ♦ A system-on-chip (SoC) combines many electronic parts into one chip, like a mini-computer. It goes into the printed circuit board (PCB) and is used in various devices, making them smaller and more efficient.

## 10. Manipur launches "School on Wheels" Initiative for Students

- ♦ **Manipur government** has launched the **"School on Wheels"** initiative aiming to impart education to students sheltered in relief camps in the state following the yearlong ethnic strife in the state.
- ♦ The Manipur government currently runs around 320 relief camps, housing more than 59,000 men, women, and children. Around 18,000 students are currently staying in relief camps.

## 11. Uttarakhand Govt Launches Pirul Lao Paise Pao Campaign

- ♦ **The Uttarakhand government** has launched the **Pirul Lao-Paise Pao campaign** to contain the raging forest fire in the state.
- ♦ Under the Pirul Lao-Paise Pao campaign, the local youth and villagers will collect dry Pirul (Pine tree leaves) in the forest and take them to the designated Pirul collection centre.
- ♦ The Tehsildar in their respective areas will manage the pirul collection centre under the supervision of the Sub-Divisional Magistrate.



## 12. DRDO hands over nine defence tech projects to IIT-Bhubaneswar

- ♦ **Nine projects sanctioned from the electronics and communication systems(ECS) cluster of Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) were handed over to IIT-Bhubaneswar.**
- ♦ Seven more projects are in the process of being sanctioned from ECS with a funding of Rs 18 crore.

## 13. Zomato unveils weather services infrastructure

- ♦ **Zomato CEO Deepinder Goyal has launched India's first crowd-supported weather network with over 650 weather stations,** the largest private setup in India, for real-time local weather data.
- ♦ These weather stations, developed by Zomato, provide localised, real-time information on key weather parameters such as temperature, humidity, windspeed, rainfall, among others can be seen at <http://weatherunion.com>.

## 14. Indian export to 115 countries shows positive growth in 2023-24

- ♦ According to data released by the Union Ministry of Commerce, **India's exports have recorded positive growth in 115 countries out of the total 238 countries/territories** it exported in 2023-24.
- ♦ These 115 export destinations, which account for 46.5 per cent of India's export basket, include the US, UAE, Netherlands, China, UK, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, Bangladesh, Germany and Italy.
- ♦ The top 10 source countries, which constitute 59.3 per cent of India's import basket, include China, USA, Saudi Arabia, Indonesia, Russia, and Switzerland.

## 15. SAIL-Bhilai to set up Chhattisgarh's first 15-Mw floating solar plant

- ♦ **Bhilai Steel Plant (BSP), the Chhattisgarh-based arm of the state-run Steel Authority of India Limited (SAIL), will install the state's first 15-megawatt(MW) floating solar project** in its Maroda-1 reservoir to improve its carbon footprint.
- ♦ The steel major is undertaking various projects to reduce carbon emissions, conserve energy, and promote renewable energy.
- ♦ The solar plant will be set up in Durg district.

## 16. India extends budgetary support of \$50m to Maldives

- ♦ In a goodwill gesture, **India has decided to extend vital budgetary support to the Maldives government** with the rollover of a **USD 50 million Treasury Bill** for another year on the Maldivian government's special request.
- ♦ The State Bank of India has subscribed for one more year to the **USD 50 million Government Treasury Bill**, issued by the Ministry of Finance of Maldives, upon maturity of the previous subscription.

## 17. TCS announces creation of Global AI Center of Excellence in France

- ♦ **Tata Consultancy Services** announced the creation of a **Global Artificial Intelligence (AI) Centre of Excellence in Paris, France** during the Choose France Summit.
- ♦ The TCS AI Centre of Excellence in Paris will leverage TCS' global ecosystem of startups, academia, and research organisations to bring the best of global capabilities to French companies.

## 18. Ramcharitmanas, Panchatantra, and Sahṛdayāloka-Locana enter 'UNESCO's Memory of the World Asia-Pacific Regional Register'

- ♦ **The Ramcharitmanas, Panchatantra and Sahṛdayāloka-Locana** have been included in 'UNESCO's Memory of the World Asia-Pacific Regional Register'.
- ♦ The 'Ramcharitmanas', 'Panchatantra', and 'Šahr.dayaloka-Locana' are such timeless works that have deeply influenced Indian literature and culture, shaping the nation's moral fabric and artistic expressions.
- ♦ The decision to include Ramcharitmanas, Panchatantra and Šahr.dayaloka- Locana was taken at the 10th General Meeting of the Memory of the World Committee for Asia and the Pacific (MOWCAP) held in Ulaanbaatar, capital of Mongolia.

## 19. India overtakes Australia, Japan and Singapore in data centre capacity

- ♦ **India has become the country with the highest data center capacity in the Asia-Pacific region**, surpassing major countries like Australia, Hong Kong SAR, Japan, Singapore, and Korea.

## 20. Sela Tunnel recognized as India's highest tunnel by International Book of Honour

- ♦ **Sela Tunnel**, constructed by BRO India, is **officially recognised as the highest tunnel in the country by the International Book of Honour**, England.
- ♦ The 2.598 Km long tunnel is situated at an altitude of 13000 ft on the Tezpur-Tawang Road.
- ♦ Situated at an altitude of 13,000 feet, the strategically important Šela Tunnel will ensure all-weather connectivity to Tawang in Arunachal Pradesh.

## 21. 'Operation Sadbhavana': Army's support for North Sikkim's communities

- ♦ **The Indian Army's Trishakti Corps under Operation Sadbhavana** provided **essential aid and healthcare to North Sikkim's** Naga and Rangrang villages post-GLOF.
- ♦ Over 150 villagers received medical attention, and youths participated in educational sessions linked to the Agniveer Šcheme for empowerment.

## 22. India registers record export at USD 778 Billion in 2023-24

- ♦ **India registered record exports in financial year 2023-24 at USD 778 billion**, according to the commerce ministry.
- ♦ In the financial year 2022-23, the combined value of exported goods and services stood at UŠD 776.3 billion.
- ♦ In 2023-24, services exports increased from UŠD 325.3 billion to UŠD 341.1 billion, while merchandise exports marginally declined from UŠD 451.1 billion to UŠD 437.1 billion.
- ♦ The other countries in the Top 10 list are the UK, Australia, Šaudi Arabia, the Netherlands, and South Africa.

## 23. Police started Operation 'Maryada' for smooth conduct of Kedarnath Dham Yatra 2024 in Uttarakhand

- ♦ **Police launched Operation 'Maryada'** for the smooth conduct of **Kedarnath Dham Yatra 2024** in Rudrapurayag, Uttarakhand.

- Under Operation Maryada, the police request pilgrims and tourists who consume drugs to maintain decorum in this area. Along with challan, the police is also registering a case against the rioters and drug users.

## 24. Porter becomes India's 3rd Unicorn of 2024

- Homegrown logistics services platform Porter** has become **the third unicorn** (with a valuation of \$1 billion and above) **in India this year**.
- Earlier this year, fintech firm Perfios and Ola's AI venture Krutrim had turned unicorns.
- As per Tracxn, there were 113 unicorns in India as of earlier this month.

## 25. Nayara Energy to invest ₹600 crore in two Ethanol Plants

- Nayara Energy**, a private downstream company, **is planning to invest Rs 600 crore for setting up ethanol manufacturing plants in the country**.
- The move is in line with the government's target of 20% ethanol blending for FY26.
- The company plans to set up two ethanol manufacturing plants, each with a production capacity of 200 kiloliters per day (KLPD), **in Andhra Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh**.

## 26. Sri Sri Ravi Shankar receives first Stamp released

- Indian spiritual guru Sri Sri Ravi Shankar** received the **first stamp released commemorating the completion of 200 years of Indian Origin Tamils in Sri Lanka**.
- Governor of the Eastern Province of Sri Lanka Senthil Thondaman presented the stamp to Sri Sri Ravi Shankar.
- The stamp is a way to attain recognition for the community which has been neglected for decades.

- In the report, minority female student enrollment also witnessed over 42 percent increase, from over 10 lakh in 2014-15 to 15 lakh in 2021-22.
- Female SC enrollment increased by 51 per cent, whereas that of ST students went up by 65.2 per cent.

## 28. Assam unveiled the " DRIMS" platform For Disaster Management

- Assam Government** has **launched the Disaster Reporting and Information Management System (DRIMS) platform** to facilitate efficient disaster reporting and aid distribution in collaboration with UNICEF.
- DRIMS captures critical impact data, expediting relief delivery for damaged crops, livestock losses, and other post-disaster restoration efforts.

## 29. CDS Anil Chauhan attends Exercise Cyber Suraksha 2024

- ♦ **Chief of Defence Staff (CDS) Gen Anil Chauhan** attended 'Exercise Cyber Suraksha – 2024' and underscored the importance of strengthening India's cyber defence capabilities.
- ♦ The comprehensive cyber defence exercise is being conducted by Defence Cyber Agency.

## 30. Kaamya Karthikeyan becomes youngest Indian to summit Mt Everest at 16

- ♦ **Sixteen-year-old Kaamya Karthikeyan** successfully summited **Mt. Everest**, becoming the **youngest Indian mountaineer** to scale the world's highest peak from the Nepal side.
- ♦ The daughter of a naval officer, Kaamya is a class 12 student at Navy Children School, Mumbai.
- ♦ Kaamya and her father Cdr S Karthikeyan successfully summited Mt. Everest (8,849 m).

## 31. L&T Technology Services launches simulation centre for Airbus in Bengaluru

- ♦ **L&T Technology Services** has inaugurated a **simulation centre of excellence (CoE)** for Airbus at its Bengaluru campus.
- ♦ The CoE is designed to provide engineering support for Airbus aircraft structural simulation activities across its business units in France, Germany, the UK, and Spain.

## 32. Karnataka mandates 33% reservation for women in govt contract jobs

- ♦ Aligning with the quota policy applied in permanent government positions, the Karnataka State government has now made it mandatory to provide 33% reservation for women in services and posts that are being outsourced by various government departments and organizations.

## 33. Indian Oil exports premium fuel to Sri Lanka

- ♦ **Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. (IOCL)** exported its **first-ever consignment of 100 octane premium fuel, XP100** to Sri Lanka.
- ♦ The product is tailored for premium high-end vehicles.

- ♦ **Sikkim** has celebrated **Saga Dawa**, a festival that falls annually on the 15th day of the fourth month of the Northern Buddhist Calendar.



- ♦ Šaga Dawa is considered the most sacred Buddhist festival, commemorating the birth, enlightenment, and Mahaparinirvana (passing away) of Buddha Šhakyamuni.

## 36. World's first 100% biodegradable pen launches in India

- ♦ **Saurabh H Mehta** from New Delhi has introduced the **world's first fully biodegradable pen**, named the NOTE pen (No Offence to Earth).
- ♦ The pen features a recycled paper refill, and non-toxic ink, and comes in options of metal, paper, or bamboo exteriors.

## 37. WB govt plans new AI and ML-focused data centre

- ♦ The **West Bengal state government** will set up a powerful, high-capacity data centre that will allow 2,300 concurrent users to run **artificial intelligence (AI) and machine learning (ML) applications**.

## 38. Cyclone Remal bring heavy rains in part of WB and Bangladesh

- ♦ The **Indian Meteorological Department (IMD)** has issued a **warning** that a low depression in **Bay Bengal has developed into a severe cyclonic storm Remal**.
- ♦ Cyclone Remal is the first cyclone of the season to develop in the Bay of Bengal region. The name Remal has been given by Oman which means sand in Arabic.

## 39. Jyoti Ratre becomes India's oldest woman to Conquer Mount Everest

- ♦ **Jyoti Ratre**, an entrepreneur and fitness enthusiast from Madhya Pradesh, has etched her **name in history by becoming the oldest Indian woman to conquer Mount Everest**.
- ♦ Ratre's remarkable achievement was realized as part of a 15-member expedition team organized by 8K Expeditions, led by the renowned Bolivian climber David Hugo Ayaviri Quispe.

## 40. First Hydrogen plant of GAIL inaugurated in Vijaipur, MP

- ♦ The **government of India-owned GAIL (India) Limited's** first green hydrogen plant has **become operational at Vijaipur in Madhya Pradesh**.
- ♦ This marks the entry of India's largest natural gas transmission and distribution company in the green fuel business.
- ♦ The 10-megawatt proton exchange membrane electrolyser for the green-hydrogen producing unit at the Vijaipur complex has been imported from Canada.

## 41. Telangana government enforces Statewide ban on gutka and pan masala

- ♦ The **Telangana government** has issued a **one-year ban** on the **manufacture, storage, distribution, transportation and sale of gutka and pan masala** containing tobacco and nicotine throughout the State, effective immediately.
- ♦ The restriction has been imposed in light of a legitimate concern for public well-being. As indicated by the order from the Food Safety Commissioner, the restriction will be upheld under Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006.



## 42. Fischer Medical Ventures makes India's first indigenous MRI system

- ◆ **Chennai-headquartered Fischer Medical Ventures (FMVL)** has **manufactured its magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) systems** domestically, claiming to be the first company in the country to achieve this.
- ◆ The company is developing its MRI systems at a production facility in the Andhra Pradesh MedTech Zone (AMTZ) in Visakhapatnam.

## 43. Reliance Industries to begin construction on India's first multimodal logistics park near Chennai

- ◆ Conceptualised 12 years ago, **India's first Multimodal Logistics Park at Mappedu near Chennai** will see the limelight as **Reliance Industries** starts construction in June.
- ◆ In 2022, the company beat Adani Group to win the bid for the Rs 1,424 crore project on 184.27 acres of land in Tiruvallur district.

## 44. Indian mountaineer Satyadeep Gupta becomes first person to scale Mt. Everest and Mt. Lhotse twice in one season

- ◆ Indian mountaineer **Satyadeep Gupta** has scripted history by **becoming the first person to scale Mt. Everest and Mt. Lhotse twice in one season.**
- ◆ He also set another record by being the first Indian to traverse from Mt. Everest to Mt. Lhotse in 11 hours and 15 minutes.
- ◆ Gupta conquered the 8,516 metre-high Mt. Lhotse, followed by towering 8,849 metre-high Mt. Everest.
- ◆ This historic achievement marks the first Double Dual Ascent of the world's highest and the fourth highest peaks in a single season.
- ◆ Gupta had previously summited Mt Everest on May 21 and Mt Lhotse on May 22.

## 45. India offers \$1 million aid to disaster-hit Papua New Guinea

- ◆ The **Government of India** has granted **\$1 million as immediate assistance for Papua New Guinea**, which has been hit by a devastating flood and landslide that has so far killed 2,000 people.
- ◆ As a close friend and partner under the Forum for India-Pacific Islands Cooperation (FIPIC) and as a gesture of solidarity with the friendly people of Papua New Guinea, GoI extends an immediate relief assistance of \$1 million to support relief, rehabilitation and reconstruction efforts.

## 46. Sanjay Kumar inaugurates Summer Fiesta 2024

- ◆ Secretary of Department of School Education and Literacy, **Sanjay Kumar** has inaugurated the month-long **"Summer Fiesta 2024"** at the National Bal Bhavan, New Delhi.
- ◆ Summer Fiesta is a month-long camp comprising over 30 types of different activities for children aged between 5 to 16 years.

## 47. NHAI launches initiative to attract the UAE's investments for India's highway expansion

- ◆ The **National Highways Authority of India (NHAI)** has launched **an initiative to monetize its infrastructure**, seeking investments from the UAE to sustain and enhance India's expanding

national highway network.

- ♦ NHA's delegation is conducting high-level meetings and roadshows in Dubai and Abu Dhabi to attract foreign investment via NHA Infrastructure Investment Trusts (InVITs).

#### 48. Government raises Retirement & Death Gratuity Limits to 25 Lakh

- ♦ **The maximum limit of retirement gratuity and death gratuity** has been revised by the government from 20 lakh to 25 lakh rupees.
- ♦ Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions has issued an official memorandum in this regard.
- ♦ The revised limit will come into effect from 1st January 2024.

#### 49. South Korea launches its First Space Agency

- ♦ **South Korea** plans to make a **Mars landing by 2045** and spend 100 trillion won (\$72.6 billion) until then on space exploration, President Yoon Suk Yeol said at the launch of the country's first space agency.
- ♦ The **Korea Aerospace Administration (KASA)** will lead the country's "space economy," with hundreds of businesses and enterprises working to catapult South Korea into the ranks of the world's top five space powers.
- ♦ The country's first lunar lander is planned for 2032. South Korea plans at least three more space launches by 2027 and has plans to launch military satellites

## Chapter 13: Current Affairs (International)

#### 1. World's deepest blue hole discovered in Mexico

- ♦ **Researchers** have **discovered the world's deepest blue hole located in Mexico's Chetumal Bay, named Taam Ja' Blue Hole (TJBH).**
- ♦ Initially thought to be the second deepest, recent measurements have now recorded it at depths exceeding 420 meters below sea level (mbsl), surpassing all known blue holes to date.

#### 2. India and Oman to jointly undertake research on sharks and rays in Arabian Sea

- ♦ A joint initiative between **India and Oman to boost research and conservation of sharks and rays in the Arabian Sea** will be launched at an upcoming workshop at ICAR-Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI).
- ♦ Experts from both countries will take part in the workshop which is expected to take place shortly, here, which will take up the collaborative research works and capacity building in elasmobranch research.

#### 3. India contributes \$5,00,000 to U.N. Counter-Terrorism Trust Fund

- ♦ **India** has **contributed \$500,000 to the U.N. Counter-Terrorism Trust Fund**, underscoring its unwavering commitment to support multilateral efforts in the global fight against the scourge of terrorism.
- ♦ India's Permanent Representative to the UN Ambassador Ruchira Kamboj handed over to Under Secretary General, UN Office of Counter-Terrorism (UNOCT) Vladimir Voronkov the country's

voluntary financial contribution of half a million dollars towards the U.N. Counter-Terrorism Trust Fund (CTTF).

#### 4. Nepal climber Kami Rita Sherpa climbs Mt Everest for 29th time

- ◆ **Nepali Sherpa climber Kami Rita** has scaled **Everest for the 29th time**, surpassing his own record of 28 ascents.
- ◆ He now holds the record for the most ascents of the world's tallest peak in its 71-year climbing history.
- ◆ Kami Rita Sherpa, also known as 'Everest man,' embarked on the Spring Season Everest expedition from Kathmandu, accompanying a team of approximately 28 climbers. Seven Summit Treks organised the expedition to conquer the world's highest peak.

#### 5. China surpasses US, becomes India's top trading partner with \$118.4 billion business:

##### GTRI

- ◆ **China has emerged as India's largest trading partner in the FY 2023-24** with \$118.4 billion two-way commerce, narrowly edging past the US, according to the data of economic think tank GTRI (Global Trade Research Initiative).
- ◆ The bilateral trade between India and the US stood at \$118.3 billion in 2023-24.
- ◆ According to the report, India's exports to China rose by 8.7 per cent to \$16.67 billion in the last fiscal.
- ◆ The main sectors which recorded healthy growth in exports to that country include iron ore, cotton yarn/fabrics/madeups, handloom, spices, fruits and vegetables, plastic and linoleum.

#### 6. UAE launched 10-year Blue Residency Visa for Environmental Champions

- ◆ **The United Arab Emirates** has launched a **10-year Blue Residency visa** for individuals who have made 'exceptional efforts and contributions to protecting the environment, whether marine or land'.
- ◆ The 10-year Blue Residency Visa aims to attract and retain global leaders in environmental research, activism, and technological solutions.
- ◆ This visa category extends beyond the UAE's borders, welcoming those who champion sustainability initiatives worldwide.

#### 7. Venezuela becomes first country to lose all Glaciers

- ◆ **Venezuela** is the **first country to lose all of its glaciers**, which is a huge change in the environment.
- ◆ New research shows that the Humboldt glacier in the Andes, which used to be very big, has shrunk to less than 2 hectares, which means it is no longer a glacier but an ice field.

#### 8. World's first 6G device launched in Japan

- ◆ **A Japanese consortium** recently **introduced the prototype of the world's first high-speed 6G device**, which is claimed to transfer data at lighting speed.
- ◆ As per reports, the purported device can transmit data at a whopping 100 gigabits per second (Gbps) and can cover more than 300 feet. **The device is 20x faster than the ongoing 5G technology.**

#### 9. World highest competition swimming pool opens in Bhutan

- ◆ **World Aquatics** has announced the **opening of the first-ever competitive swimming pool** at a record **altitude of 2,400 meters** above sea level in Bhutan.

- ♦ The pool is part of the Pools for All Program to promote aquatic sports in the region.

## 10. Pakistan's Sirbaz Khan conquers Mount Everest without Oxygen.

- ♦ A notable mountaineer, **Sirbaz Khan scaled Mount Everest without supplementary oxygen**, making him only the 2nd Pakistani to achieve this feat.
- ♦ Khan aims to be the 1st Pakistani to climb all 14 peaks above 8,000 meters, having already climbed 13, two with oxygen support.

## 11. Spain becomes 99th member of International Solar Alliance

- ♦ **Spain** has become **the 99th member of the International Solar Alliance**.
- ♦ Špain handed over the International Šolar Alliance Instrument of Ratification, during the meeting of Ambassador Jose Mari'a Ridao Domínguez of Špain with the Head of Depository, Joint Šecretary in the External Affairs Ministry AbhishekŠingh in New Delhi.
- ♦ The International Šolar Alliance (IŠA) is a collaborative platform for increased deployment of solar energy technologies as a means for bringing energy access, ensuring energy security, and driving energy transition in its member countries.

## 12. University of Tokyo inaugurates world's highest observatory in Chile

- ♦ **The University of Tokyo** has inaugurated the **Atacama Observatory (TAO)** in **Chile's Antofagasta Region**.
- ♦ It has been built on the summit of Cerro Chajnantor in the Antofagasta Region, at 5,640 meters above sea level.
- ♦ TAO also houses a 6.5-meter optical-infrared telescope.
- ♦ The telescope will focus on understanding the nature of the universe, according to Emol's academic section.

## 13. Norway, Spain, and Ireland to recognize Palestinian state

- ♦ The governments of **Norway, Spain, and Ireland** have announced that they would recognize the Palestinian state.
- ♦ In a swift reaction, the Israeli government condemned the move, while the Palestinians welcomed it.
- ♦ The official recognition by the three nations of an independent Palestinian state will take effect on 28 May 2024.

## 14. WHO launches first-ever investment round for sustainable funding

- ♦ The **World Health Organization (WHO)** has launched its **first investment round to sustainably finance its Health for All mandate**.
- ♦ The move comes as the organization seeks to transform the way it is funded by 2028.

## 15. WHO Organizes 'Walk The Talk' Yoga Session Event

- ♦ For the upcoming occasion of International Yoga Day, **Permanent Mission of India to the United Nations in Geneva and World Health Organization (WHO)** yesterday organised a **'Walk the Talk' Yoga session** event at Place des Nations.
- ♦ Union Health Šecretary Apurva Chandra joined by Director General of WHO Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus and other senior officers of India delegation joined the event and re-energised themselves with yoga asanas.



## 16. Purnima Shrestha conquers Mount Everest thrice in a single season

- ♦ A 32-year-old mountaineer from Gorkha, Nepal, **Purnima Shrestha** has made history as the **first woman in the world to climb Mount Everest three times** in the same season, all in just 13 days.
- ♦ Her exceptional triple ascent beats the previous record of any woman summiteerto climb Everest thrice in a single season.

## Chapter 14: Banking & Financial

### 1. Indian economy likely to grow over 7% in 2024-25: Economic think tank NCAER

- ♦ The **Indian economy could grow more than 7 per cent** during the **current fiscal amid a benign global outlook and expected above-normal monsoon**, according to economic think tank NCAER.
- ♦ In its April 2024 issue of Monthly Economic Review (MER), NCAER said a range of high-frequency indicators reveal the resilience of the domestic economy with the Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) for manufacturing at a 16-year high and UPI, the leading digital payments system, touching the highest volume since its inception in 2016.

### 2. GST revenue collection hits record high of Rs 2.10 lakh cr in April

- ♦ **India's Gross Goods and Services Tax (GST) collections** hit a record high of **Rs 2.10 lakh crore** in April, growing 12.4 per cent on year-on-year basis.
- ♦ GŠT collection in March stood at Rs 1.78 lakh crore. Previously, the highest-ever GŠT collection figure stood at Rs 1.87 lakh crore in April 2023.
- ♦ This is also the first time GŠT collection has crossed the ₹2 trillion mark, since the unified indirect tax regime was rolled out seven years ago.

### 3. UPI transactions dip marginally in April to Rs 19.64 trn

- ♦ **Unified Payment Interface (UPI) transactions** declined in **volume and value in April by 1 per cent and 0.7 per cent**, compared to March 2024.
- ♦ Transactions stood at **Rs 19.64 trillion in value terms**, down from Rs 19.78 trillion in March. There were **13.3 billion transactions in April**, compared to 13.44 billion in March.
- ♦ Y-o-Y, UPI transactions increased by 50 per cent in terms of volume and 40 per cent in value. In February 2024, transactions stood at 12.10 billion and Rs 18.28 trillion, respectively.
- ♦ Immediate Payment Šervice (IMPS) transactions declined by 7 per cent in value and 5 per cent in volume in April compared to March.

### 4. NaBFID expects cumulative loan sanctions to top ₹2-lakh cr in FY25

- ♦ The **Government-owned National Bank for Financing Infrastructure and Development (NaBFID)** expects its **loan sanctions pipeline to swell to about ₹2 lakh crore by March-end 2025** against about ₹1 lakh crore as of March-end 2024.
- ♦ To support loan growth, the development financial institution (DFI) is planning to mop up about ₹53,000 crore this year via bond market, bank and multilateral credit lines.



- ♦ The All India Financial Institution was set up in 2022 under the NABFID Act, 2021, as the principal entity for infrastructure financing in the country.
5. **India global services export to reach \$800 billion by 2030: Goldman Sachs**
- ♦ India's services exports will increase to **\$800 billion by 2030 from \$340 billion in 2023**, making the external sector resilient to supply-side shocks and reducing rupee volatility, Goldman Sachs report.
  - ♦ India's foreign trade policy announced last year targeted \$1 trillion of service exports by 2030.
  - ♦ Services exports (as percentage of gross domestic product or GDP) could reach around 11% of GDP by 2030 (versus 9.7% of GDP in 2023) which amounts to around \$800 billion (compared to around \$340 billion in 2023).
6. **Groww & Worldline join growing club of India's online payment aggregators**
- ♦ Financial services platform **Groww** and digital payment processing company Worldline ePayments have secured RBI licence to operate as online payment aggregators.
  - ♦ With this, the number of firms getting the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) nod to operate as payment aggregators has touched 20 in the first four months of calendar year 2024.
  - ♦ Groww has secured the licence for its UPI payments platform Groww Pay.
7. **RBI imposes monetary penalty on three co-operative banks for rule violations**
- ♦ The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** has imposed **monetary penalty of three co-operative banks for rule violations**.
  - ♦ These banks are Lokmangal Co-operative Bank, The Udgir Urban Co-operative Bank, and The Satara Sahakari Bank.
  - ♦ The central bank imposed Rs 5 lakh penalty on Lokmangal Co-operative Bank, Rs 2 lakh on The Satara Sahakari Bank, and Rs 1 lakh on The Udgir Urban Co-operative Bank.
8. **OECD raises the Indian economy growth rate forecast to 6.6% in 2024-25**
- ♦ The **Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD)** has raised its growth forecast for India by 40 basis points to 6.6 per cent for 2024-25.
  - ♦ In its earlier report, it had projected a growth rate of 6.2 per cent for the Indian economy in 2024-25.
  - ♦ It has also forecasted a growth rate of 6.6 % for 2025-26.
9. **Neobanking startup Fi secures NBFC License from RBI**
- ♦ **Neobanking startup Fi**, backed by investors such as Peak XV and Temasek, has secured a **non-banking finance company (NBFC) licence** from the Reserve Bank of India, enabling it to provide loans from its own books.
  - ♦ With this, Fi has joined the likes of Jupiter, Groww and Cred, all of which got into the lending business either by getting a fresh licence or by acquiring another NBFC.
10. **HDFC Life launched 'No Jhanjhat Life Insurance Fatafat' campaign**
- ♦ **HDFC Life**, a leading insurer in India, has unveiled its **latest campaign, 'No Jhanjhat Life**

## **11. ICICI Bank introduces UPI for NRIs through international mobile numbers**

- ♦ **ICICI Bank** has rolled out a **new facility allowing its non-resident Indian (NRI) customers to make Unified Payments Interface (UPI) transactions in India using their international mobile numbers.**
- ♦ The new facility allows ICICI Bank's NRI customers to use their international mobile numbers registered with their NRE/NRO accounts for UPI payments.
- ♦ This change applies to customers residing in ten countries, including the **USA, UK, UAE, Canada, Singapore, Australia, Hong Kong, Oman, Qatar, and Saudi Arabia.**

## **12. Thomas Cook launches video KYC for forex buyers**

- ♦ **Thomas Cook India** has launched **video KYC for its retail foreign exchange customers for a safe digital transaction.**
- ♦ The company said that the new initiative, 'Ab Forex Ghar Baithe', offers customers a paperless means to buy forex without stepping out of home.

## **13. ICICI Pru Life launches ULIP having fund value-based distributor payouts**

- ♦ **ICICI Prudential Life Insurance** has launched **ICICI Pru Platinum, a Unit Linked Investment Plan (ULIP)** that ties the distributor's commission to their customers' Assets Under Management (AUM).
- ♦ According to the product specifications, customers have unlimited free switches between asset classes without any cost or tax implications.

## **14. IRDAI imposes a fine of Rs 1 crore on IPO-bound Go Digit Insurance**

- ♦ **The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (Irdai)** imposed a **penalty of Rs 1 crore on Go Digit General Insurance** for non-disclosure of a change in the conversion ratio of compulsorily convertible preference shares (CCPS).
- ♦ The company had not furnished the full particulars of the revision to the regulator, violating Section 26 of the Insurance Act.

- ♦ As a result, the bank will be able to onboard customers through the mobile app.

- ♦ **HDFC Bank** has supported social sector startups in India with grants worth **Rs 19.6 crore in FY24, in partnership with Atal Innovation Mission** (under NITI Aayog).
- ♦ In FY 2023-24, 170 social start-ups received funding via 41 incubators, with a total of Rs 19.6 crore in the 'Parivartan Start-up Grants programme.'

- ♦ Zeta estimates that the transaction volume on this scheme will exceed \$1 trillion by 2030 and aims to capture 50% of this market opportunity with its end-to-end solution that can help banks conceive and rapidly launch multi-form credit products.

## 19. Thomas Cook India launches Digital Service TCPay for International Money Transfers

- ♦ **Omnichannel forex services company** Thomas Cook India has launched TCPay, a new digital service that brings ease and efficiency to international money transfers.
- ♦ Traditionally, sending money abroad was considered an arduous process, that involved visits to branches, cumbersome paperwork and limited operating hours.

## 20. Hinduja Group gets IRDAI approval for Reliance Capital acquisition

- ♦ **Hinduja Group's IndusInd International Holdings (IIHL)** has received the long-awaited **Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India's approval for the acquisition of Reliance Capital.**
- ♦ The acquisition will include the takeover of Reliance Capital's insurance arms — wholly-owned subsidiary Reliance General Insurance and 51:49 JV with Nippon Life, Reliance Nippon Life Insurance.
- ♦ The insurance regulator has cleared the transfer of Reliance Capital's 26 per cent stake in Reliance Nippon Life to Aasia Enterprises.

## 21. All Inactive Accounts to be closed on 1 June 2024: PNB

- ♦ **Punjab National Bank (PNB)** has announced that it will close all its **customers' inactive bank accounts on 1 June 2024.**
- ♦ Customers whose accounts have become inactive can activate their accounts by completing their KYC (Know Your Customer) by 31 May 2024.

## 22. Retail Inflation eases to 4.83% in April 2024

- ♦ **Retail inflation** eased marginally to **4.83% in April on an annual basis from 4.85% in March last month**, as per government data released
- ♦ The inflation rate has stayed within the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) tolerance range of 2-6%.
- ♦ The National Statistical Office (NSO) reported that inflation in the food basket rose to 8.7% in April from 8.52% in March.

## 23. HDFC Bank launches virtual credit card 'Pixel'

- ♦ The country's largest private sector lender, **HDFC Bank** has launched **PIXEL**, its first virtual credit card with Visa's network.
- ♦ The card is available in two variants: **PIXEL Play** and **PIXEL Go** and allows users to build their own cards with personalised benefits, offers, etc.

## 24. India's WPI inflation hits 13-month high of 1.26% in April

- ♦ India's wholesale price index-based inflation accelerated to 1.26 per cent in April on an annual basis as against 0.53 per cent in March, at a 13-month high, data from the Commerce Ministry.
- ♦ This spike was due to both food and fuel inflation. In April last year, WPI inflation stood at (-) 0.8 per cent.

## 25. Public sector banks' total profit crosses Rs 1.4 lakh crore in FY24

- ♦ **Public sector banks' cumulative profit crossed ₹1.4 lakh crore** in the financial year ended **March 2024**, recording a growth of 35 per cent over the previous year on a high base of ₹1 lakh crore.
- ♦ The 12 public sector banks (PŠBs) together had earned a net profit of ₹1,04,649 crore in 2022-23.
- ♦ Out of the total profit of ₹141,203 crore earned during the FY24, market leader **State Bank of India (SBI)** alone contributed over **40 per cent** of the total earnings, as per the published numbers on exchanges.
- ♦ ŠBI earned a profit of ₹61,077 crore 22 per cent higher than the previous financial year (₹50,232 crore).

## 26. SBI becomes trading-clearing member of IIBX at GIFT City

- ♦ The **State Bank of India (SBI)** has secured the distinction of being the **first bank to become a trading-cum-clearing (TCM) Member of India International Bullion Exchange** at the GIFT City in Gujarat.
- ♦ This milestone enables ŠBI IBU Gift City to conduct trades on the IIBX platform and settle them on behalf of its clients.
- ♦ RBI guidelines permitted branches of an Indian Bank in GIFT IFŠC to act as a trading member (TM)/trading and clearing member (TCM) of IIBX.

## 27. LIC gets 3-yr extension from Sebi to achieve 10% public shareholding

- ♦ **Life Insurance Corporation (LIC) of India** has been granted a **three-year** extension by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) to achieve a 10 per cent public shareholding.
- ♦ LIC is required to increase its public shareholding to 10 per cent on or before May 16, 2027.

## 28. SBI raises short-term retail fixed deposit rates by up to 75 bps

- ♦ **State of India (SBI)** has increased **interest rates on short-term retail fixed deposits (FDs)** by 25 to 75 basis points (bps).



- ◆ This is the first increase in the fixed deposit rates by the bank since December 2023.
- ◆ The new interest rates are effective from May 15, 2024.
- ◆ This deposit rate hike comes against the backdrop of credit growth outstripping deposit growth.

## 29. Yes Bank launches premium services under 'Yes Grandeur'

- ◆ **Yes Bank** has launched premium banking services under the label '**Yes Grandeur**' targeting elite and rising affluent class to drive business growth.
- ◆ The exclusive banking program, tailored to meet distinctive financial and lifestyle needs, has an eligibility threshold of average monthly balance of ₹5 lakh or a Net Relationship Value (NRV) of ₹20 lakh, with additional consideration given to loan relationships.

## 30. Bank of Maharashtra tops among PSU banks in business growth in FY24

- ◆ State-owned **Bank of Maharashtra** recorded the **highest growth rate last fiscal in terms of total business and deposit mobilisation** among public sector lenders at a time when most banks are facing difficulty in achieving double-digit growth.

## 31. The lender has registered a 15.94 per cent rise in the total business (domestic) in FY24.

- ◆ Followed by the country's largest lender **State Bank of India (SBI)** with 13.12 percent growth, according to published financial numbers of the public sector banks (PSBs).
- ◆ BoM continued to maintain its top spot in terms of growth in deposit mobilisation, with a 15.66 per cent rise in FY24.
- ◆ It was followed by SBI (11.07 per cent), Bank of India (11.05 per cent) and Canara Bank (10.98 per cent).

## 32. NPS assets surge 26% y-o-y to ₹11.94 lakh crore as of May 11: PFRDA

- ◆ Riding on buoyant equity markets, **National Pension System (NPS) assets grew 26 per cent year-on-year to touch ₹11.94 lakh crore**, according to PFRDA data.
- ◆ This overall AUM including that of Atal Pension Yojana (APY) — slightly short of ₹12 lakh-crore milestone mark — was higher than end March 2024 level of ₹11.73 lakh crore.

## 33. RBI approves ₹2.11 lakh crore dividend payout to govt for 2023-24

- ◆ The **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** has **approved a ₹2.11 lakh crore dividend payout** to the **central government for 2023-24**, more than double the amount it paid for the previous 2022-23 financial year.
- ◆ The Board approved the transfer of ₹2,10,874 crore as surplus to the Central Government for the accounting year 2023-24.
- ◆ The dividend payout was ₹87,416 crore for 2022-23.

## 34. SEBI imposes ₹11.90 crore fine on 19 entities for Superior Finlease 'pump and dump'

- ◆ **SEBI** has **slapped penalties totalling ₹11.90 crore on 19 entities** and also barred them from the securities market for up to five years for indulging in a pump-and-dump scheme of shares in the matter of **Superior Finlease Ltd.**
- ◆ The regulator-imposed fines in the range of ₹10 lakh to ₹5 crore on 19 entities, including Rajneesh Kumar, Ashish P Shah and Kirtidan K Gadhave.



## 35. RBI imposes Rs 3.10-lakh penalty on Hero Fincorp for rule violations

- ♦ The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed Rs 3.10 lakh penalty on HeroFincorp Ltd for rule violations.
- ♦ The penalty was imposed for non-compliance with certain provisions of the 'Non-Banking Financial Company - Systemically Important Non-Deposit taking Company and Deposit taking Company (Reserve Bank) Directions, 2016' issued by RBI.

## 36. RBI imposes ₹1-crore penalty on ICICI Bank, ₹91 lakh on YES Bank

- ♦ The Reserve Bank of India has imposed a penalty of ₹1 crore on ICICI Bank for non-compliance with certain directions on 'Loans and Advances – Statutory and Other Restrictions'.
- ♦ The regulator also fined Yes Bank ₹91 lakh, for violation of certain norms on 'Customer Service in Banks', and 'Un-authorised Operation of Internal/Office'.

## 37. Govt to get Rs 3,662 crore from LIC as dividend

- ♦ The Government of India will get Rs 3,662 crore as dividend for being Life Insurance Corporation (LIC) of India's largest shareholder.
- ♦ This comes after the country's largest insurer declared an interim dividend of Rs6 per share.
- ♦ The government owns 96.5 percent stake in the insurer or 6,10,36,22,781 shares.
- ♦ Gross non-performing asset (GNPA) stood at 2.01. percent against 2.56 percent in the year-ago period, LIC said

## 38. HDFC Bank to stop SMS alerts for small UPI payments

- ♦ HDFC Bank will stop sending SMS alerts for UPI transactions up to Rs 100 from June 25.
- ♦ The private lender said that SMS alerts won't be pushed for incoming payments up to Rs 500 from the said date either.
- ♦ UPI transactions require the authorisation of a Personal Identification Number (PIN), a 4-6 digit pass code set by the customers as a security measure to ensure safe and approved transactions. For normal UPI the transaction limit is up to Rs 1 Lakh per transaction.

## 39. RBI imposes Rs 36.38 lakh penalty on HSBC for violating Fema regulations

- ♦ The Reserve Bank has imposed a fine of Rs 36.38 lakh on foreign lender HSBC for Foreign Exchange Management Act (FEMA) violations.
- ♦ The central bank said reporting requirements under the Liberalised Remittance Scheme of FEMA, 1999 were not followed by HSBC.

## 40. Foreign Exchange Management Act (FEMA) 1999

- ♦ The Foreign Exchange Management Act (FEMA) was enacted in 1999 and was implemented on 1 January 2000.
- ♦ It replaced the Foreign Exchange Regulation Act (FERA) 1973.
- ♦ The FEMA Act lays down the rules and regulations regarding foreign exchange transactions. Certain sections of the Foreign Exchange Management Act (FEMA) 1999 empower the RBI regarding transactions and management of foreign exchange in India.

### 1. DRDO successfully test SMART missile system for Indian Navy

- ♦ The **Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO)** has successfully tested the next-generation Supersonic Missile-Assisted Release of Torpedo (SMART) system from Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Island off the coast of Odisha.
- ♦ SMART is a next-generation missile-based light-weight torpedo delivery system designed and developed by DRDO to enhance the anti-submarine warfare capability of the Indian Navy far beyond the conventional range of light weight torpedoes.

### 2. China launches sea trials for next-generation aircraft carrier

- ♦ **China** has launched **sea trials for the Fujian**, its third and most advanced aircraft carrier.
- ♦ The start of tests by the Chinese navy came nearly two years after the aircraft carrier was first unveiled in June 2022.
- ♦ The Fujian, entirely designed and built domestically, is larger and more advanced than the Shandong, commissioned in late 2019, and the Liaoning, which China bought second-hand from Ukraine in 1998.

### 3. India's first indigenous bomber UAV unveiled in Bengaluru

- ♦ **Flying Wedge Defence and Aerospace Technologies** launched **FWD-200B** in Bengaluru, marking India's entry into indigenous UAV manufacturing.
- ♦ The FWD-200B has a payload capacity of 100 kgs and is classified as a MALE Unmanned Combat Aerial Vehicle (medium-altitude, long-endurance).
- ♦ The Unmanned Aerial System (UAS) consists of optical surveillance payloads and is integrated with missile-like weapons for precision air strikes.

### 4. Indian Air Force tests BHISHM state-of-the-art indigenous mobile hospital, for airdrop in Agra

- ♦ **Indian Air Force** has tested **BHISHM Cube**, a state-of-the-art indigenous mobile hospital, for airdrop in Agra.
- ♦ This innovative technology is a great leap forward in providing rapid and comprehensive medical aid during emergencies anywhere.

### 5. France successfully test fired ASMPA Missile

- ♦ The **French General Directorate of Armaments (DGA)** conducted a successful test firing of the **enhanced medium-range air-to-surface strategic missile (ASMPA-R)**.
- ♦ The Air-Sol Medium Range (ASMP/ASMP-A) is an air-launched land-attack supersonic cruise missile that carries a nuclear payload.

## 6. DRDO Successfully Tests RudraM-II Missile

- ♦ The **Defence Research & Development Organisation (DRDO)** has successfully flight-tested the **RudraM-II air-to-surface missile**.
- ♦ The missile was fired from a **Šu-30 MK-I aircraft** of the **Indian Air Force (IAF)** off the coast of **Odisha**.
- ♦ The missile's performance was validated through data captured by various range tracking instruments, including **electro-optical systems, radar, and telemetry stations** set up by the **Integrated Test Range in Chandipur** and on an on-boardship.

- ♦ **India's Velavan Senthilkumar** won his **eighth Professional Squash Association (PSA) Tour title** yesterday by winning the **Batch Open**, a **PŠA Challenger event**, at the **Societe Sportive du Jeu de Paume in Paris**.
- ♦ **World No. 58 Šenthilkumar**, the top seed, beat **Frenchman Melvil Šcianimanico** 11-6, 11-9, 11-6 to clinch the title.

### 2. Rohit Sharma to lead Indian team for the 2024 T20 Cricket World Cup

- ♦ The five-member **Šenior Men's Cricket Šelection Committee**, headed by **Ajit Agarkar**, announced the 15-member **Indian squad** for the **2024 ICC men's T20 cricket World Cup**.
- ♦ **The 9th ICC Men's T 20 Cricket World Cup** will be held from **1-29 June 2024**.
- ♦ It is being **co-hosted by the West Indies and the United States of America**.
- ♦ **India** has been placed in **group A** along with **Pakistan, Canada, the United States and Ireland**.

### 3. India to host BWF World Junior Badminton Championships 2025

- ♦ **India** will host the **BWF World Junior Championships 2025** at the **National Centre of Excellence in Guwahati**.
- ♦ The 2025 edition in **India** will mark the return of the **BWF Junior World Championships** to the country for the first time since **2008** when **Pune** hosted the event.
- ♦ The 2026 edition of the **BWF Thomas and Uber Cup Finals**, meanwhile, will head to the **Danish city of Horsens**.

#### 4. ICC Imposes 5-Year Ban on West Indies Cricketer Devon Thomas

- ♦ The **International Cricket Council (ICC)** has imposed a five-year period of ineligibility from all cricket on **West Indies player Devon Thomas** after he accepted breaching seven counts of the anti-corruption codes of Sri Lanka Cricket (SLC), the Emirates Cricket Board (ECB) and the Caribbean Premier League (CPL)
- ♦ Thomas admitted to seven charges, including those related to match-fixing.

#### 5. Amul to sponsor USA's cricket team in T20 WC

- ♦ Amul will be the lead arm sponsor for USA's cricket team that will participate in ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2024 which commences on June 1.
- ♦ The opening match of the tournament will be played between USA and Canada in Dallas.

#### 6. Tejaswin Shankar wins men's High Jump event at USATF Festival

- ♦ **India's Tejaswin Shankar** clinched victory in the **men's High Jump event at the USATF Festival in Tucson, Arizona, USA.**
- ♦ The National record holder Tejaswin cleared 2.23 metres in his first attempt to secure the top spot at the World Athletics Continental Tour – Silver event. With this jump, he equaled his season-best effort.
- ♦ Earnie Šears of USA finished second, while Roberto Vilches of Mexico was third. Another Indian athlete, Šarvesh Kushare cleared 2.13m to finish fifth.

#### 7. China wins both Thomas and Uber Cup Badminton titles

- ♦ The **Chinese badminton team** has **won both the men's Thomas Cup 2024 and the women's Uber Cup 2024.**
- ♦ The final of the 2024 BWF Thomas and Uber Cup was played in the Chinese city of Chengdu.
- ♦ Thomas and Uber Cup is held every two years and is organised by the world badminton governing body, the Badminton World Federation (BWF).

#### 8. McLaren's Lando Norris win Miami GP

- ♦ **McLaren's Lando Norris** has won the **first Formula One race of his career** with a shock victory over world champion Max Verstappen in the Miami Grand Prix.
- ♦ Breathing life into an F1 season that risked becoming a one-man story again, Norris, in his 110th race for McLaren, beat Verstappen by more than seven seconds, with Ferrari's Charles Leclerc finishing third.

#### 9. Iga Swiatek, Andrey Rublev wins the Madrid Open Tennis Singles Title

- ♦ World no.1 women's tennis players **Iga Swiatek and Andrey Rublev** won the women's and men's singles titles at the 2024 Madrid Open, respectively.
- ♦ Iga Šwiatek defeated Aryna Šabalenska of Belarus 7-5, 4-6, 7-6 (9/7) to win her first Madrid Open title. Last year, she lost in the final to Aryna Šabalenska.
- ♦ Andrey Rublev of Russia won the singles title of the ATP Madrid Open Masters 1000, beating Felix Auger-Aliassime of Canada 4-6, 7-5, 7-5, to win his second ATP Masters title.

- ♦ Šri Lanka, former champions of the T20 World Cup, will become the third team after Šouth Africa and UŠA to be sponsored by Amul at the showpiece T20 tournament.

## 13. India clinches 5 medals at Asian Open Pickleball Championships

- ♦ **India clinched three gold and two bronze medals at the Asian Open Pickleball Championships in Vietnam.**
- ♦ Šachin Pahwa and Priyanka Chhabra led India to its first gold medal, defeating Ruben Hellberg and Chitlada Hemasee 11-9, 5-11, 11-9, in the mixed doubles intermediate 35+ category final.
- ♦ While in the women's doubles open category, the pair of Isha Lakhani and Pei Chuan Kao bagged the gold medal with a dominating 15-7, 15-3 win against Dang Kim Ngan and Tyak K.

## 14. Bajrang Punia suspended by Wrestling Authorities

- ♦ **Wrestling's world governing body (UWW) has suspended Bajrang Punia till the end of this year** following NADA's decision to hand him a provisional suspension for refusing to undergo a dope test.
- ♦ However, despite being well aware of NADA's order, the Šports Authority of India (ŠAI) sanctioned close to Rs 9 lakh for his training abroad.

## 15. New Zealand's Colin Munro announces retirement from International Cricket

- ♦ **New Zealand left-handed batter Colin Munro announced his retirement from international cricket** after a career spanning 123 matches for the Blackcaps across all formats.
- ♦ The 37-year-old has featured in 65 T20Is, 57 ODIs and a single Test for New Zealand, with his last appearance coming in their T20I home series against India back in 2020.

## 16. Neeraj Chopra finishes 2nd with 88.36m throw in Doha Diamond League

- ♦ **Neeraj Chopra finished second with a best throw of 88.36m throw** while India's Kishore Jena's best was 76.31m in Doha Diamond League.
- ♦ Jakub Vadlejch of the Czech Republic, who finished first with a best effort of 88.38.
- ♦ while Anderson Peters claimed the third spot.
- ♦ Meanwhile, India's Kishore Jena, who claimed the silver medal at the Asian Games last year with a personal best of 87.54m, endured a disappointing Diamond League debut, finishing ninth with a best throw of 76.31m.

## 17. Japan defeated Pakistan to win the 30th Sultan Azlan Shah Trophy

- ♦ **Japan has won its maiden Sultan Azlan Shah Hockey trophy** by defeating Pakistan 4-1 in the penalty shoot-out in the final.
- ♦ The final was played at the Azlan Šah Štadium in Ipoh, Malaysia.
- ♦ Japan won the trophy, with Pakistan in second place. Malaysia was in third place, followed by New Zealand, Šouth Korea, and Canada in last place.

## 18. Rathika, Senthil to lead India in 22nd Asian Squash Championship

- ♦ **Velavan Senthilkumar will lead the Indian men's team while Rathika Seelan will lead the women's team.**
- ♦ The Indian team is highly optimistic after its spectacular performance in the 19th Hangzhou Asian Games. India won five medals—two gold, one silver, and two bronze at the Hangzhou Asian games.

## 19. Indian Gymnast Srishti Khandagale wins Silver at Asian Championships

- ♦ **India's Srishti Khandagale scripted history by becoming the first ever Indian to win a medal at the Asian Trampoline Gymnastics Championships.**
- ♦ She clinched the silver medal in Women's Individual Age group category at the 6th Asian Trampoline Gymnastics Championship held in Hong Kong, China.
- ♦ Kazakhstan's Dolgoplova secured the gold medal, while Hong Kong's Š Hungwon the bronze.

## 20. ITF Tournament Junior 30 inaugurated in Lucknow

- ♦ **International Tennis Federation, ITF tournament Junior 30** was inaugurated in **Lucknow**.
- ♦ Uttar Pradesh ADG Traffic B.D Paulson graced the event as a chief guest.

## 21. 6 Indian Wrestlers Qualify for Paris Olympics

- ♦ At Paris Olympics 2024, **India will have six wrestlers in its contingent with five quotas coming through women.**
- ♦ Aman Šehrawat and Nisha Dahiya took India's number of quotas to six at the World Olympic Wrestling Qualifiers in Istanbul, Turkey.
- ♦ Earlier, Vinesh Phogat in the 50kg category, Antim Panghal in 53kg, Anshu Malik in 57kg and Reetika Hooda in 76kg category had already qualified for Paris Games at different qualifying events.
- ♦ Tamil Nadu's P Shyaamnikhil became India's 85th chess Grandmaster (GM).
- ♦ The 31-year-old chess prodigy, who started his career at the age of eight, finally secured his third and final GM norms at the 2024 Dubai Police Masters Chess Tournament. R Vaishali was the 84th Indian Chess Grandmaster.

## 22. Abha Khatua Sets National Record Winning Gold In Women's Shot Put

- ♦ **India Captain Sunil Chhetri** will be **retiring from international football** after the FIFA World Cup 2026 qualifier against Kuwait on June 6.
- ♦ The 39-year-old striker has been capped 145 times by India, scoring 94 goals in a career spanning 20 years.

## 25. Neeraj Chopra wins Gold in Federation Cup with throw of 82.27 metres

- ♦ In men's javelin throw, **Olympic champion Neeraj Chopra** won the **gold medal in Federation Cup 2024 in Bhubaneswar**.
- ♦ The 26-year-old superstar struggled in the initial rounds of competition as he was second after three rounds.
- ♦ He took the lead in the fourth round **with an effort of 82.27m. Animesh Kujur won Gold at 200m sprint event in Federation Cup**
- ♦ 20-year-old, Animesh Kujur bagged 200m gold at the Federation Cup in Bhubaneswar, Odisha.
- ♦ Kujur has scorched the track by clocking an impressive 20.62 seconds to win the 200 metres gold.
- ♦ The second-best time ever by an Indian after Amalan Borgohain's national record of 20.52 seconds.

## 26. Manipur wins Senior Women's NFC for Rajmata Jijabai Trophy for 22nd time

- ♦ **Manipur defeated Haryana 2-0** in the final of the **28th Senior Women's National Football Championship for Rajmata Jijabai Trophy**, to clinch their 22nd title at the Kishore Bharati Krirangan, in Kolkata.

## 27. Nandini dairy to sponsor for Scotland for T20 World Cup

- ♦ **Scotland cricket team** has unveiled its **new ICC T20 World Cup jersey with Karnataka Milk Federation's (KMF) Nandini logo**.
- ♦ The Nandini logo is featured in the leading arm of the jersey in both English and Kannada. The jersey was launched in Edinburgh by members of the playing squad.

## 28. Nishad Kumar, Preethi Pal win medals at World Para Athletics Championships

- ♦ **Nishad Kumar and Preethi Pal** have clinched **silver and bronze at the World Para Athletics Championships** in Kobe, Japan.
- ♦ Kumar, a Paralympic silver medalist, secures India's first medal with a 1.99m high jump in the T47 category, finishing second.

## 29. Brazil to host FIFA Women's World Cup 2027

- ♦ **Brazil was declared the host of the 2027 Women's World Cup** at the FIFA Congress.
- ♦ Brazil beating the joint bid of Belgium, Netherlands and Germany to become the first South American country to hold the tournament.

## 30. Satwiksairaj & Chirag Shetty win Men's Doubles Title at Thailand Open 2024

- ♦ **Star Indian pair of Satwiksairaj Rankireddy and Chirag Shetty** secured the **men's doubles title at the Thailand Open Super 500** badminton tournament with a straight-game win over Chen Bo Yang and Liu Yi of China in Bangkok.
- ♦ In the form of their lives, Šatwik and Chirag, the world number three pair prevailed 21-15, 21-15 over Liu and Chen, ranked 29th, for their ninth BWF world tour title.

## 31. Max Verstappen won Emilia Romagna GP

- ♦ **Red Bull's Max Verstappen** clinched the **Emilia Romagna Grand Prix** as McLaren's Lando Norris finished second.
- ♦ It was the 59th career win for the three-time Formula 1 world champion who kept Norris at bay despite struggling with his car.

## 32. Nikhat Zareen and Minakshi clinch Gold Medals at Elorda Cup

- ♦ In Boxing, Two-time world champions **Nikhat Zareen and Minakshi** won **two gold medals for India in the 3rd Elorda Cup 2024**.
- ♦ The Indian contingent finished the Elorda Cup with 12 medals—2 gold, 2 silver, and 8 bronze. The 3rd Elorda Cup was held in Kazakhstan's capital city of Astana.
- ♦ Nikhat in the women's 52 kg category, triumphed over Zhazira Urakbayeva of Kazakhstan with a 5-0 victory, while Minakshi defeated another Uzbekistan boxer Rahmonova Šaidahon, 4-1 in the women's 48 kg event.
- ♦ Anamika in 50 kg lost in the final to the reigning world and Asian champion China's Wu Yu 1-4. To settle for a silver medal.

## 33. Alexander Zverev and Iga Swiatek win Singles Title of Italian open

- ♦ **German's Alexander Zverev** defeated the **first-time Masters finalist Nicolas Pietrangeli of Chile** in straight sets 6-4, 7-5 to win the **2024 Men's Single of Italian Open Masters 1000 title**.
- ♦ This was also Zverev's second Italian Open title. In 2017, he won the Italian Open by defeating Novak Djokovic. It was also his first master's title.

- ♦ **Twenty-year old Deepthi Jeevanji** smashed the **world record in the women's 400m T20** and grabbed her first gold at the World Para Athletics Championships at Kobe in Japan.
- ♦ Deepthi clocked 55.07 seconds, breaking American Breanna Clark's earlier world record of 55.12 seconds, which she had set during last year's edition of the championships in Paris.



## 35. Ekta Bhanu secures Gold Medal in Women's F51 Club Throw Competition at World Para Athletic Championship

- ♦ India's Ekta Bhanu has secured a gold medal with a season's best throw of 20.12 metres in the women's F51 club throw competition at the World ParaAthletic Championships at Kobe in Japan.

## 36. Germany midfielder Toni Kroos to retire after Euro 2024

- ♦ The Real Madrid and Germany midfielder Toni Kroos has announced he will retire after this summer's European Championship.
- ♦ The 34-year-old is to hang up his boots after a trophy-laden decade at the Bernabeu.

## 37. 2nd stage of Archery World Cup 2024 begins in Korea

- ♦ The second stage of the Archery World Cup 2024 begins at Yecheon in Korea.
- ♦ India has sent the same 16-member team that took part in the first stage in Shanghai, China last month.
- ♦ The Indian contingent emerged as the champion team in the first stage, with a total of eight medals, including five gold medals, two silver, and one bronze.
- ♦ This was India's highest medal tally at any single edition of an archery World Cup.
- ♦ Stage three of the prestigious tournament will be held in Antalya, Turkey, while the final stage will be held in Tlaxcala, Mexico.

## 38. Sachin Khilari clinches gold medal in shot put at World Para Athletics Championship

- ♦ In Para Athletics, India's Sachin Sarjerao Khilari clinched the gold medal in the men's shot put at the World Para Athletics Championship in Kobe, Japan.
- ♦ He also set a new Asian record with a throw of 16.30 metres in the F46 category, to defend his title at the world championships.

## Chapter 20: Science & Technology

### 1. China to launch Chang'e-6 Lunar probe mission

- ♦ China is set to launch the **Chang'e-6 lunar probe on a round trip to the Moon**.
- ♦ It aims to gather soil and rock samples from the far side of the Moon, a region that has remained permanently hidden from Earth's view.
- ♦ This will be the first-ever attempt to retrieve lunar samples from the far side, providing valuable insights into the early evolution of the Moon and the inner solar system.
- ♦ This mission will also involve the first-ever ascent from the Moon's far side during its return journey to Earth.

### 2. Oldest evidence of Earth's magnetic field found in Greenland rocks

- ♦ Geologists from MIT and Oxford University discovered the **oldest evidence of Earth's magnetic field in 3.7-billion-year-old rocks from Greenland's Isua Supracrustal Belt**.
- ♦ Researchers determined them to be approximately 3.7 billion years old, showing remnants of a magnetic field with a strength of at least 15 microtesla, comparable to today's magnetic field.

### 3. NASA plans to develop first railway systems on moon

- ♦ NASA has unveiled its ambitious plan to construct the **first lunar railway system**, known as **FLOAT (Flexible Levitation on a Track)**, designed to revolutionize payload transport on the Moon.
- ♦ The long-lasting robotic transport system which will play a major role in the daily operations of a sustainable lunar base envisioned for the 2030s.
- ♦ This lunar railway system is part of NASA's Moon to Mars initiative and mission concepts such as the Robotic Lunar Surface Operations 2 (RLSO2).

### 4. NASA Launches Small Climate Satellite to Study Earth's Poles

- ♦ NASA has successfully launched the **first of two climate satellites into orbit**, designed to study heat emissions at Earth's poles.
- ♦ The satellite, part of the PREFIRE (Polar Radiant Energy in the Far-Infrared Experiment) mission, was carried by Rocket Lab's Electron rocket from the company's Launch Complex 1 in Mahia, New Zealand.

### 5. Agnikul launches Agnibaan with India's first 3D-printed rocket engine

- ♦ India's private space industry, **Agnikul Cosmos** successfully launched its **SORTeD mission**, a single-stage launch vehicle demonstration powered by a semi-cryogenic 3D-printed engine.
- ♦ The mission, which lasted approximately two minutes, marked a major achievement for the



company and the country in the development of indigenous space technology.
