#### **Chapter 12: Current Affairs (National)**

#### 1. Itanagar Woman Police Station Achieves ISO 9001:2015 Certification

- The Woman Police Station in Itanagar, under Capital Police, has achieved ISO9001:2015 certification.
- This certification is globally recognized for establishing and maintaining a high-quality management system. It signifies the station's commitment to effectivelyhandling crimes against women and children.
- The certification process involved a rigorous evaluation of the station sprocedures, policies, and practices.

#### 2. Rajasthan CM launches Mukhya Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi

- Chief Minister of Rajasthan Bhajan Lal Sharma has launched the state
- government's Mukhya Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi at the Krishi Upaj Mandi inTonk.
- The chief minister released Rs 650 crore as the first installment to around 65 lakh farmers of the state.
- The eligible farmers of the state will receive the benefits under the state schemealong with the Rs 6000 per year paid by the central government under the PM- KISAN scheme.

#### 3. Bhupender Yadav launches portal documenting Indian fauna

- According to the Union minister of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Bhupender Yadav, India has become the first country in the world to prepare achecklist of its entire fauna population. -covering 104,561 species. This makes India the global leader in biodiversity documentation and conservations.
- The minister also inaugurated the 2nd Animal Taxonomy Summit-2024organized by Zoological Survey of India at Kolkata.



### 4. Telangana registers first FIR under New Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita at Charminar PoliceStation

- In Telangana, the first FIR under the new Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, (BNS)which replaces the Indian Penal Code (IPC) from July 1, has been registered at the Charminar police station in Hyderabad.
- An FIR under Section 281 of the BNS and sections 80(a) and 177 of the MV Actwas registered by the Charminar police at 1 a.m. after they were found riding with improper number plates.

#### 5. Andhra Pradesh launches NTR Bharosa Pension

- Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu has launched the NTRBharosa pension scheme in the state.
- The Telugu Desam Party (TDP) led government, which was sworn in on 12 June2024, was fulfilling one of its election promises.
- Under the NTR Bharosa pension scheme, the pension for old-aged people,
- widows, weavers, toddy tappers, fishermen, single women, traditional cobblers, transgenders and artists has been increased from Rs 3,000 to Rs 4,000 per month.
- Pension for the disabled and multi-deformity leprosy patients has beenincreased from Rs 3,000 to Rs 6,000 per month.

#### 6. IAF chief inaugurates newly established weapon systems school

- Indian Air Force Chief Air Chief Marshal V.R. Chaudhari has inaugurated the Weapon Systems School (WSS) at Air Force Station Begumpet, Hyderabad.
- The new branch will have four streams;
  - 1. Flying stream to operate the weapons and systems in airborne platforms like the Sukhoi-30 MKI and C-130J
  - 2. Remote stream to operate remotely piloted aircraft
  - Mission commanders and operators for Surface to Air and Surface-to-Surface weapon systems
  - 4. Intelligence stream for handling space-based intelligence and imagery.

#### 7. Maharashtra CM extends Mukhyamantri Majhi Ladki Bahin Yojana age limit to 65 Years

- Chief Minister of Maharashtra Eknath Shinde has raised the upper age limit to 65 years for the "Mukhyamantri Majhi Ladki Bahin" scheme, under which women will get Rs 1,500 per month.
- The state government had set the upper age limit at 61 for benefits to be available to women under the scheme.

#### 8. Smart Cities Mission extended till March 2025

• The Centre has extended the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) under the Union UrbanDevelopment Ministry till March 31, 2025.



- Under the SCM, launched in June 2015, 100 cities were chosen through acompetition to be developed as smart cities.
- The mission envisions developing areas within selected cities in the country asmodel areas based on an area development plan, which is expected to have a rub-off effect on other parts of the city and nearby cities and towns.

#### 9. Annual defence production hits record high of approx. Rs 1.27 lakh crore in FY24

- Ministry of Defence has achieved the highest-ever growth in indigenous defence production in value terms during Financial Year (FY) 2023-24.
- As per the data received from all Defence Public Sector undertakings (DPSUs), other PSUs manufacturing defence items and private companies, the value of defence production in the country has gone up to a record-high figure i.e., Rs
- 1,26,887 crores, reflecting a growth of 16.7% over the defence production in F24.
- Of the total value of production (VoP) in 2023-24, about 79.2% has been contributed by DPSUs/other PSUs and 20.8% by the private sector.

#### 10. India to host 5G, 6G and Emerging Technologies Hackathon in September

- India will host the 5G, 6G, and Emerging Technologies Hackathon in Septemberthis year alongside the 'WTSA24 (World Telecommunication Standardization Assembly) Outreach Sessions'.
- The initiative aims to bring together innovators, industry leaders, and academicsto explore the frontiers of next-generation telecom technologies. The hackathon will serve as a hub for cutting-edge innovation in telecommunications.

- The Ministry of Railways announced the upgrade of IRCTC from 'Schedule B' to'Schedule A' Category, Central Public Sector Enterprises.

#### 28. BJP govt renames Biju Patnaik Sports Award to Odisha Rajya Krida Samman

- The newly elected BJP government has renamed Biju Patnaik Sports Award asOdisha Rajya Krida Samman'.
- Odisha Sports and Youth Services Department issued guidelines for the RajyaKrida Samman' which will be awarded in eight categories annually, subject to availability of suitable candidates. The cash rewards remain unchanged.
- According to the guidelines, the lifetime achievement award for promoting sports will carry a cash prize of Rs 3 lakh, while Rs 2 lakh will be awarded foroutstanding performance in sports, and Rs 1 lakh for excellence in coaching.

#### 29. G. Kishan Reddy launches Mineral Exploration Hackathon and National DMF Portal inHyderabad

- Union Minister of Coal and Mines, G. Kishan Reddy has launched Mineral Exploration Hackathon focused on Innovative Mineral Hunt Techniques in Hyderabad.
- This Hackathon aims to promote use of emerging technologies like Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Machine Learning (ML) for geophysical data, integration of multiple mineral exploration data sets such as baseline data, available exploration data, etc., to identify new Mineral targets, particularly for deepseated/concealed ore bodies.



#### 30. "Rajiv Gandhi Civils Abhayahastam" launched by Telangana CM

- Telangana Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy has launched a unique programme toprovide financial assistance to the Civil Services aspirants from Telangana, underwhich the candidates who qualify for the Mains exams will be provided with ₹1 lakh for preparation.
- Named "Rajiv Gandhi Civils Abhayahastam", the scheme will be helpful to about 400 candidates from Telangana region who qualify for the Mains every year.

#### 31. MP tops in PM SVANidhi Scheme as Best Performing State

- Madhya Pradesh has secured the first place under the 'Best Performing State'category in the Prime Minister SVANidhi scheme.
- The micro-credit scheme for urban street vendors, which provides collateral-freeloans up to Rs 50,000, was launched by the Narendra Modi government in COVID-19 outbreak.
- Assam has been ranked second in the 'Best Performing States- Innovation and Best Practices Award' category.

#### 32. EESL to launch retail shops to distribute energy-efficient products

- State-owned Energy Efficiency Services Ltd (EESL) will introduce retail franchisee shops called 'Urja Dakshta Dukan' which will offer affordable energy-efficient products like LED lights, ACs, and fans to consumers.
- EESL, at present, distributes products through retail tie-ups with powerdistribution utilities to consumers.

#### 33. GC Murmu inaugurates 'International Centre for Audit of Local Governance' in Rajkot

- The Comptroller and Auditor General of India Girish Chandra Murmu International Centre for Audit of Local Governance (iCAL) atRajkot in Gujarat.
- The centre will serve as a think tank for addressing governance issues at thegrassroots level across the nations.

#### 34. Airbus to launch first 'Made in India' H 125 helicopter in 2026

- Airbus and Tata are joining forces to manufacture India's first FAL (FinalAssembly Line) H125 helicopter, which is set to roll out by 2026.
- This partnership aligns with India's Atmanirbhar Bharat initiative and reflects Airbus's commitment to investing in the Indian aerospace market despite regulatory challenges.

#### 35. Jyotiraditya M. Scindia releases 'The Future is Now' as the theme for India Mobile Congress 2024

 The theme of the India Mobile Congress 2024, 'The Future is Now', was unveiled today by Jyotiraditya M. Scindia, Minister for Communications and Development of North Eastern Region.



- The theme signifies how India stands at the heart of the technological evolution IMC 2024 bringing together global leaders visionaries, pioneers, and innovators to collaborate and actively shape the technologies transforming ourworld today, where the future isn't just a concept it's happening.
- The eighth edition of Asia's premier digital technology exhibition, India Mobile Congress (IMC), co-hosted by the Department of Telecommunications (DoT) and Cellular Operators Association of India (COAI) will be held from 15th October at Pragati Maidan in New Delhi this year.

#### 36. PM Modi announces One Million Dollar Grant to UNESCO World Heritage Centre

- Prime Minister Modi announced that India will contribute one million dollars to the UNESCO World Heritage Centre.
- This grant will be used for capacity building, technical assistance and conservation of the world heritage sites.
- The grant will especially be used for thecountries of the Global South.

#### 37. TIDCO gets site clearance from the centre to develop Parandur airport

- The greenfield airport at Parandur near Chennai is closer to becoming a realityas the Tamil Nadu Industrial Development Corporation gets the site clearance from the Centre.
- The Steering Committee on Greenfield Airports has recommended for grant of Site Clearance to Tamil Nadu Industrial Development Corporation (TIDCO) for developing the Greenfield airport at Parandur, Kancheepuram District.

#### 38. Department Of School Education and Literacy to observe Shiksha Saptah

- The Department of School Education and Literacy under the Ministry of Education (MoE) has begun its week-long observance of 'Shiksha Saptah' (Education Week), to mark the fourth anniversary of the National EducationPolicy 2020.
- The event is scheduled from July 22 to July 28 with the first day being observed as the Teaching-Learning Material (TLM) Day.

# 39. Atal Innovation Mission and WIPO sign a Letter of Intent towards building joint innovation programs in global south

- A high-level delegation from World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO)comprising of Mr. Sherif Saadallah, Executive Director, WIPO Academy and Ms. Altaye Tedla, Head WIPO Academy visited NITI Aayog for signing of a Joint Letterof Intent (JLoI) between Atal Innovation Mission (AIM) and WIPO.
- The JLoI is aimed at building programs for Innovation, Entrepreneurship &Intellectual Property (IP) for countries in the Global South.



#### 40. NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Ltd. to set up Green Charcoal plant in Haryana

- NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Limited (NVVNL) will set up two green charcoal plants in Gurugram and Faridabad, Haryana. These plants will convert municipalwaste into charcoal or green coal.
- The MoU was signed in the presence of Union Power Minister Manohar Lal, Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini and Minister of State for Urban Local Bodies Subhash Sudha.
- NTPC Vidyut Vyapar Nigam Limited, a subsidiary of National Thermal Power Corporation Limited, will set up this plant under the Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan.

#### 41. Nepal, Sri Lanka, Seychelles get more funds under Budget allocation for MEA

- India-funded projects in the neighbourhood received the bulk of the allocation for the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) under the Union Budget presented by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman.
- Nepal secured an allocation of ₹700 crore, which is a jump of ₹150 crore from previous year's allocation of ₹550 crore.

#### 42. With ₹2.65 lakh crore outlay, Railways to prioritise safety

- The Ministry of Railways has received a record allocation of over ₹2.55 lakhcrore in financial year 2024-25, which is a jump of 5.85% from the previousyear's ₹2.41 lakh crore, according to Union Budget documents.
- The total outlay provided for capital expenditure includes ₹2.52 lakh crore fromgeneral revenues,
   ₹200 crore from Nirbhaya Fund, ₹3,000 crore from internal resources and ₹10,000 crore from extra budgetary resources, bringing it up to ₹2.65 lakh crore.

#### 43. Government estimates Rs 50,000 crore from disinvestment, asset monetisation in FY25

- The government has estimated to collect Rs 50,000 crore from disinvestmentand asset monetisation in the current fiscal.
- Besides, the government estimates a total of Rs 56,260 crore dividend from CPSEs (central public sector enterprises), more than Rs 48,000 crore estimated in the interim budget.
- The budget also estimates that dividend from RBI, banks and financial institutions would be Rs 2,32,874 crore in FY25, more than double of interimbudget estimate of Rs 1.02 lakh crore.
- The massive increase in the number is on account of the windfall dividend of Rs 2.11 lakh crore from the RBI.
- The revised estimates for last fiscal have been pegged at Rs 30,000 crore.

#### 44. Khelo India once again gets lion's share in Budget for sports

 Khelo India, which is the government's flagship project to promote sports at thegrassroots level, was once again the biggest beneficiary in the union budget for the sports ministry as it was assigned ₹900 crore from the overall allocation of ₹3,442.32 crore.



- Khelo India's share, announced in the budget presented by Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman in New Delhi, is ₹20 crore more than the revised allocation of ₹880 crore during the previous financial year.
- The budget for the previous cycle was ₹3,396.96 crore for the previous financialyear.
- While Khelo India's actual allocation in 2022-23 stood at ₹596.39 crore, it wasincreased by more than ₹400 crore, to ₹1,000 crores, in the 2023-24 budget, before being revised to ₹880 crore.
- The budget for Sports Authority of India, which apart from maintaining its stadiaacross the country also manages the Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS) to prepare athletes for the global sporting extravaganzas, has also been enhancedfrom ₹795.77 crore to ₹822.60 crore, which is a jump of ₹26.83 crore.
- While NADA's budget has gone up from Rs 21.73 crore last year to ₹22.30 crore,NDTL has got ₹22 crore, up from ₹19.50 last year.

#### 45. Rs 6.22 lakh crore allocated to MoD, highest among Ministries, in Regular Union Budget2024-25

- In the Regular Union Budget of Financial Year (FY) 2024-25, the Ministry of
- Defence (MoD) has been allocated Rs 6,21,940.85 crore (approx. US \$75 Billion), the highest among the Ministries.
- While maintaining the allocation made to MoD during the interim budget, the Government has made an additional allocation to the tune of Rs 400 crore on innovation in defence, through the Acing Development of Innovative
- Technologies with iDEX (ADITI) scheme.
- Through this scheme, MoD is engaging with start-ups/MSMEs and innovators to develop Def-Tech solutions and supply the Indian military with innovative and
- indigenous technological solutions.
- A grant of up to 50% of the Product Development Budget with an enhanced limit (Max) of Rs 25 crore per applicant will be awarded as per extant iDEX guidelines.
- Ensuring better healthcare facilities for veterans- In the regular budget for FY 2024-25, Rs 6,968 crore has been allotted to ECHS which is 28% higher than the PY.
- The budgetary allocation to Border Roads Organisations (BRO) under capital for Budget Estimates (BE) 2024-25 has been made as Rs 6,500 crore, which is 30% higher than the allocation for FY 2023-24.
- The allocation to the Indian Coast Guard (ICG) for this FY 2024-25 is Rs 7,651.80crore, which is 6.31% higher over the allocation of FY 2023-24.
- Total budgetary allocation on account of defence pensions is Rs 1,41,205 crorewhich is 2.17% higher than the allocation made during 2023-24.
- The Government has increased the allocation on innovation in defence throughiDEX from Rs 115 crore during FY 2023-24 to Rs 518 crore in the current fiscalyear, which will boost start-ups/MSMEs/innovators.



- 46. Prime Minister's package worth Rs 2 lakh crore central outlay announced; employment, skilling and other opportunities
  - The finance minister announced the Prime Minister's package of 5 schemes and initiatives.
  - The package aims to facilitate employment, skilling, and other opportunities for
  - 4.1 crore youth over a 5-year period with a central outlay of Rs. 2 lakh crores.
- > Scheme 1:
  - First Timers- This scheme, which is expected to benefit 2.1 crore youth over 2 years, will provide one-month wage to all persons newly entering the workforcein all formal sectors.
  - The eligibility limit will be a salary of Rs. 1 lakh per month. Direct benefit transfer of one-month salary will be up to Rs. 15,000 in 3 installments to first-time employees, as EPFO.
  - Scheme 2:
    - Job Creation in Manufacturing Aiming at substantial hiring of first time
    - employees in manufacturing, this scheme will incentivize additional employment in the sector, thereby is expected to benefit 30 lakh youth entering employment and their employers.
    - The subsidy would have to be refunded by the employer if the employment to the first timer ends within 12 month.

#### > Scheme 3:

- Support to Employers- This employer-focussed scheme will cover all additional employment within a salary of Rs. 1 lakh per month in all sectors.
- New employees under this Part need not be new entrants to EPFO.
- The government will reimburse employers up to Rs. 3,000 per month for 2 years towards their EPFO contribution for each additional employee.
- Scheme 4:
  - The 4th scheme mentioned in the Budget Speech under the Prime Minister's package is a new centrally sponsored scheme, for skilling in collaboration with State governments and Industry.
  - The scheme, with a total outlay of Rs. 60,000 crore, aims at skilling 20 lakh youthover 5 years.

#### 47. Government exempts Customs Duty on Cancer Medicines to Enhance Drug Affordability

- Government has exempted customs duty on Cancer medicines to improve the affordability of these drugs.
- Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman announced the exemption of three additional cancer medicines from customs duty in the proposed Union Budget 2024-25 in Parliament.
- These medicine are Trastuzumab Deruxtecan for Breast Cancer, Osimertinib for Lung Cancer and Durvalumab for Lung Cancer and Biliary Tract Cancer.
- Union Health Ministry said, 27 lakh cancer patients in the country will benefit from this decision.
- Finance Minister also revised the custom duty rates on X-ray tubes and flat panel detectors. These revised rates are expected to positively impact the X-raymachine industry by enhancing component availability at lower costs.

### 48. Indigenously developed Automatic Train Protection (ATP) system Kavach deployed on1465 Route km

- Indigenously developed Automatic Train Protection (ATP) system Kavach deployed on 1465 Route km and 144 locomotives on South Central Railway.
- Kavach is an indigenously developed Automatic Train Protection (ATP) system and a highly technology-intensive system, which requires safety certification of the highest order.
- Kavach aids the loco pilot in train running within specified speed limits by automatic application of brakes in case Loco Pilot fails to do so and also helps thetrain safely run during inclement weather.
- Kavach has been certified for highest level of Safety Integrity Level -SIL4 by Independent Safety Assessor and reduces the probability of train collisions inblock sections.

49. Union Budget 2024-25: Govt announces Venture Fund of Rs 1,000 Crore to Expand Space Economy

- Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman has announced a Rs 1,000 crore venturecapital fund to give a push to the space economy in the Union Budget 2024-25.
- With our continued emphasis on expanding the space economy, by 5 times in thenext 10 years, a venture capital fund of Rs 1,000 crore will be set up.
- This is the government's vision is to increase India's share in the global commercial space economy to 10% by 2030.

#### 58. EAM Jaishankar unveils commemorative postage stamp of Ram Lalla in Laos

- External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar, during his three-day visit to visit to Laos, unveiled a commemorative postage stamp showcasing the Ram Lalla idol from Ayodhya.
- The set of stamps is the first dedicated to Lord Ram.
- Two stamps were launched, one representing Lord Buddha from Luang Prabang, the ancient capital of Laos, while the other is an image of the Ram Lalla statue

### **Chapter 13: Current Affairs (International)**

#### 1. India becomes world's 3rd largest Domestic Aviation Market

- India has become the world's third-largest domestic aviation market after the U.S. and China.
- According to data compiled by aviation analytics firm Official Airline Guide (OAG), India is now third in the aviation market after airlines such as IndiGo and Air India have expanded their fleet size to cater to the surge in air passengers.
- India's domestic airline capacity doubled in the last 10 years from 7.9 millionseats in April 2014 to 15.5 million in April 2024.
- India has replaced Brazil, which now stands at the fourth place with 9.7 millionairline seats followed by Indonesia in fifth rank with 9.2 million.

#### 2. Japan introduces new 3D Holographic Banknotes

- Japan will start issuing new banknotes on the 3rd of July. It is the world's first use of cutting-edge holography that makes the portraits of historic figures appear to rotate in 3D.
- This new technology will allow visually impaired people to feel and discernwhich banknote they are holding.
- Tactile marks for the visually impaired will also make them recognizable to touch. By the end of March next year, nearly 7.5 billion new banknotes will have been printed. Existing banknotes will remain valid after the introduction of thenew banknotes.

#### 3. Colombo Security Conclave welcomes Bangladesh as Fifth Member

- A regional security grouping, Colombo Security Conclave (CSC) welcomed Bangladesh as its fifth member at the 8th Deputy National Security Adviser(DNSA) level meeting hosted virtually by Mauritius.
- The CSC includes India, Sri Lanka, Mauritius, and the Maldives, with Seychelles participating as an Observer State.
- The Colombo Security Conclave was established in 2020, when India, Sri Lankaand the Maldives agreed to expand the scope of their trilateral meeting on maritime cooperation.



#### 4. WHO launched MeDevIS Platform for Medical Device Information

- The World Health Organization (WHO) has launched MeDevIS, an online platform that provides users with access to information on medical devices.
- The platform is designed to support decision-making on the selection, procurement, and use of medical devices for the prevention, diagnosis, andtreatment of diseases and health conditions.
- MeDevIS includes 2301 types of medical devices used in various health areas, including reproductive, maternal, newborn and child health, noncommunicablediseases such as cancer, cardiovascular diseases, diabetes, and infectious diseases such as COVID-19.

#### 5. S. Jaishankar inaugurates India's First Overseas Jan Aushadi Kendra in Mauritius

- External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar has inaugurated India's first overseas Jan Aushadi Kendra in Mauritius. He was joined by Mauritius Prime Minister PravindKumar Jugnauth during the inauguration.
- The India-Mauritius health partnership project will supply cost-effective, made-in-India medicines to augment public healthcare and enhance well-being.
- Earlier, Dr. Jaishankar inaugurated the Mediclinic project at Grand Bois in Mauritius with Indian grant assistance.

#### 6. Belarus introduce<mark>s 90-Day Visa-Free Regime for 35 European Countries</mark>

- Belarus has announced a new visa-free regime allowing citizens from 35European countries to stay in the country for up to 90 days per year.
- Under the new policy, citizens of the 35 listed nations which include Germany, Britain and France - will be able to enter Belarus without a visa and stay for up to 90 days per year.
- Currently, travellers from those countries can only remain in Belarus for 30 days and must fly in via Minsk airport

#### 7. China makes world's first high-speed carbon fiber train

- China has shown off a revolutionary passenger train made of only carbon fiber.
- This is a big step forward in high-speed rail technology.
- According to Interesting Engineering, the country has unveiled the first carbon fiber-only passenger train in history. The world looks to China's vast high-speedrail network, which currently covers around 28,000 miles.
- This advanced train can reach a top speed of 87 mph. It is expected to consume7% less energy than a typical steel train, according to Qingdao Sifang.



### **Chapter 14: Banking & Financial**

#### 1. RBI announces SAARC Currency Swap Framework for 2024-27

- The Reserve Bank of India has put in place a revised framework on currency swap arrangements for countries within the South Asian Association of RegionalCooperation (SAARC) grouping for the time period 2024 to 2027.
- Under the Framework for 2024-27, a separate INR Swap Window has been introduced with various concessions for swap support in Indian Rupee.
- The total corpus of the Rupee support is ₹250 billion (Rs 25,000 crore).

#### 4. GST collection hits ₹1.74 lakh crore in June 2024

- The gross goods and services tax (GST) collection for June 2024 stood at Rs 1.74 trillion, marking 7.7 per cent year-on-year (Y-o-Y) growth.
- This Y-o-Y growth is notably less than the 12.4 per cent and 10 per cent increases recorded in April and May, respectively. Month-on-month figures, too,were flat.
- In May this year, the gross GST collection amounted to Rs 1.73 trillion, while April witnessed a record-high GST collection of Rs 2.1 trillion.
- The June revenuebrought the financial year-to-date total to Rs 5.57 trillion.

#### 5. SEBI raised Basic Demat Account Limit to Rs 10 Lakhs

#### 20. SBI introduces online loan facility against MF units via internet banking and YONO App

- State Bank of India has introduced an online loan facility against mutual fund(MF) units through its internet banking (INB) and YONO App.
- This digital solution allows consumers to apply for loans from the comfort of their own homes, with a completely paperless and digital process that is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

#### 21. Jio Financial Services gets RBI nod to become core investment company

- Jio Financial Services has received the nod from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI)to convert into a Core Investment Company (CIC) from a Non-Banking FinancialCompany (NBFC).
- According to the Reserve Bank of India, a CIC is a specialised NBFC with anminimum asset size of Rs 100 crore.
- Jio Financial Services is the demerged entity of energy-to-telecom conglomerate Reliance Industries Ltd (RIL).

#### 22. Retail inflation hits 4-month high of 5.08% in June

- Retail inflation, measured by the Consumer Price Index (CPI), accelerated to a four-month high of 5.08 per cent in June 2024, driven by a spike in food inflation of 9.36 per cent due to rising prices of vegetables and pulses.
- This June 2024 reading is also higher than the 4.87 per cent recorded in the samemonth last year.
- In May 2024, CPI inflation hit a 12-month low of 4.75 per cent, despite food inflation remaining high at 8.7 per cent. Retail inflation stood at 4.87 per cent.

#### 23. SBI hikes benchmark MCLR rate

 State Bank of India, the country's largest state-run lender, has hiked its marginalcost of funds-based lending rate (MCLR) across buckets by 5 to 10 basis points with effect from



15 July.

- Most loans to corporates, including SMEs, are priced using MCLR as a benchmark. The revision in MCLR reflects the changes in cost of funds.
- The lender hiked the rate for one-month MCLR by five basis points to 8.35 per cent. For one year, MCLR has been hiked by 10 basis points to 8.85 per cent. For the three-year period, it has been raised by five basis points to 9.0 per cent, according to data uploaded on SBI website.

#### 24. Wholesale Inflation in country rises for 4th consecutive month in June at 3.36 %

- Wholesale inflation in the country rose for the fourth consecutive month in Juneat 3.36 per cent because of the rise in prices of food articles, especially vegetables and manufactured items.
- The wholesale price index (WPI) based inflation was 2.61 per cent in May. It was(-) 4.18 per cent in June 2023.

#### 28. SBI launches Amrit Vrishti 444-Days Term Deposit With 7.25% Interest Rate

- State Bank of India (SBI) has launched a 444-day term deposit scheme, "AmritVrishti", with an interest rate of 7.25 per cent.
- This scheme is available to domestic and non-resident Indian customers and willbe effective July 15, 2024. India's largest bank will offer an additional 0.50 per cent to senior citizens on the scheme.
- "The "Amrit Vrishti" scheme is available for investment until March 31, 2025, providing ample opportunity for retail investors to take advantage of the higher interest rates.



#### 29. IRDAI imposes penalty of Rs 2 crore on Bajaj Finance, Aegon Life Insurance

- The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) has imposed a penalty of Rs 2 crore on Bajaj Finance and Rs 1 crore on Aegon LifeInsurance (now known as Bandhan Life), citing violations of norms.
- The insurance regulator has fined Bajaj Finance Rs 1 crore concerning the reconciliation of commission and professional fees received and reported to theauthority. An additional penalty of Rs 1 crore was imposed concerning the maintenance of records of customer documentation.

#### 30. RBI imposes monetary penalty on Muthoot Finance Limited

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed a monetary penalty of ₹1,90,000 on Muthoot Finance Limited for non-compliance with certain provision of 'KnowYour Customer (KYC) Directions, 2016' issued by RBI.
- This penalty has been imposed in the exercise of powers conferred on RBI under the provisions of clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 58G read with clause (aa) of sub-section (5) of section 58B of the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934.

#### 31. SIDBI to build \$1 b fund for green financing with \$215 m from GCF

- The Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI), which received approval of funding of \$ 215.6 m from the Green Climate Fund, will create a corpus of \$1 billion for 'financing mitigation and adaptation projects' (FMAP) of Medium and Small Enterprises (MSMEs).
- The board of the Green Climate Fund, which is an entity set up by the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), approved a \$200million loan and \$15.6 million grant for capacity building to SIDBI.

### 32. BoB launches Generative Al-powered virtual relationship manager and credit line on UPI

- Bank of Baroda (BoB) has launched a range of digital and technology-led initiatives, including a Generative AI-powered virtual relationship manager (VRM), and credit line on UPI for enhancing payments and banking experience for customers.
- The GenAI-powered VRM, a first-of-its-kind initiative in the Indian banking sector, provides real-time information about the bank's products and services while also capturing customer requirements for specific banking services.

#### 33. IRDAI revises its guidelines on commission on long-term motor insurance

- The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) has revised its guidelines regarding the commission for long-term motor insurancepolicies.
- Under the updated regulation, insurers are now permitted to provide commissions within the expense management framework for long-term policies. For three-year comprehensive motor insurance policies for four-wheelers, the commission cap was originally set at 15% for the first year, 10% for the secondyear, and 5% for the third year.

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has prescribed a Prompt Corrective Action (PCA) framework for relatively weak urban co-operative banks (UCBs), with deposits above ₹100 crore (upper tier category), to nurse them back to health.
- As per the framework, a financially unsound and ill-managed UCB can be brought under PCA if it breaches the risk thresholds of identified indicators pertaining to capital and profitability (net profit).
- Currently, there are around 1,500 UCBs in the country. RBI classifies UCBs asTier-I (deposits up to ₹100 crore); Tier-2 (more than ₹100 crore and up to ₹1,000 crore); Tier-3 (deposits more than ₹1,000 crore and up to ₹10,000 crore); and Tier-4 (above ₹10,000 crore). Tiers 2 to 4 come under the upperTier.

#### 35. ADB Approves Support to Improve Urban Mobility in India

- The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has approved a \$200 million loan to expandmetro rail corridors and improve transport connectivity in Nagpur, India.
- The Nagpur Metro Urban Mobility Project will improve transport connectivity within and to Nagpur's new and growing urban areas. The project will finance the extension of four metro rail corridors in Nagpur.

#### 1. DRDO unveils indigenous light tank Zorawar

- India has unveiled its first indigenously designed and developed light battle tank that will be capable of delivering devastating firepower at high altitude battlefields and operating in all-weather conditions.
- Developed in a record time of under two years in response to Chinese armoured deployments in Eastern Ladakh, the 25-ton tank named 'Zorawar' is the result ofa public-private partnership between DRDO and L&T.
- The project at the L&T production facility in Hazira with the Zorwar carrying out high speed ground tests and showcasing its ability to transverse high incline slopes.

#### 2. Goa Shipyard Launches First Indigenous P1135.6 Frigate 'Triput'

- In a significant achievement for India's naval capabilities and the 'Atmanirbhar Bharat' initiative, Goa Shipyard Ltd (GSL) successfully launched the first indigenous P1135.6 Frigate, named Triput.
- This marks the first time these vessels are being constructed indigenously inIndia.
- Triput is the first of two P1135.6 Class Frigates being built at GSL. The 124- meter-



long ship can reach speeds of 28 knots at a displacement of approximately 3200 tonnes and is equipped with advanced state-of-the-art weaponry and sensors.

#### 3. INS Tabar reaches Saint Petersburg for Russian Navy Day celebrations

- Indian Navy's frontline frigate, INS Tabar arrived at Saint Petersburg toparticipate in the 328th Russian Navy Day celebration.

#### 1. Russia approves schedule for creation of Russian Orbital Station by 2033

- Russia has approved the schedule for the creation of a Russian orbital station by 2033.
- The scientific and energy modules will be launched first in 2027, and three other core modules, namely the universal nodal, gateway, and base modules, will be launched by 2030. and two other target modules are scheduled to be launched by2033.

### 2. China launches new Earth observation satellite

- China sent a new Earth observation satellite into space from the Taiyuan Satellite ٠ Launch Center in north China's Shanxi Province.
- The Gaofen-11 05 satellite was launched by a Long March-4B carrier rocket and entered the planned orbit successfully.
- The satellite will be used in a variety of fields including land surveys, urban planning, road network design, and crop yield estimation. It will also help in land ownership verification and even aid in disaster prevention and mitigation.
- The launch marked the 528th flight mission of the Long March carrier rocket series.
