### 1. Uttarakhand CM inaugurates 10-day Uttarakhand Mahotsav in UP

- The 10-day Uttarakhand Mahotsav began at Pt Govind Ballabh Pant ParvatiyaSanskritik Upvan at Gomti Bank near Khatu Shyam mandir, Lucknow.
- Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami was the chief guest on theoccasion.
- On the first day of the ten-day Uttarakhand Mahotsav, several groups of well- dressed men and women adorned with the traditional costumes and jewellery of Uttarakhand thronged the venue.

#### 2. PM Modi launched 'Mera Yuva Bharat (MY Bharat)'

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched the 'Mera Yuva Bharat (MY Bharat)' platform for the youth
  of the country at Kartavya Path on National Unity Day.
- In a momentous decision on October 11, 2023, the Union Cabinet, chaired by PMModi, gave its approval for the establishment of an autonomous body known as "Mera Yuva Bharat (MY Bharat)."

### 4. Kozhikode and Gwalior declared Creative Cities of Literature and Music by UNESCO

- On World Cities Day, Kozhikode in Kerala and Gwalior in Madhya Pradesh became a part of the prestigious UNESCO Creative Cities Network, adding to thelist of 55 new cities.
- Kozhikode, the venue of choice for the Kerala Literature Festival and several book festivals, was named
  the 'City of Literature' by the UNESCO Creative CitiesNetwork (UCCN), making it the first such city in
  India.
- Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh, was declared the "City of Music" by UNESCO. This is afitting honor for the
  city that produced the legendary musician Tansen and where the Scindia Gharana has preserved and
  propagated music for centuries.

#### 5. NITI Aayog held Workshop on India-AU Collaboration

- The National Medical Commission (NMC), the regulatory body for medical education and medical professionals, is all set to launch its "one nation, oneregistration platform" for doctors across the country.
- Objective To eliminate duplication, red tape and allow the public to accessinformation on any physician working in India.
- The commission had earlier this year issued a gazette notification titled "Registration of Medical Practitioners and Licence to Practice Medicine Regulations, 2023" announcing the move.

### 7. ECI designed in-house software for election management through ENCORE

- The Election Commission of India has designed in-house software for completeCandidate and election management through 'ENCORE' which stands for Enabling Communications on Real-time Environment.
- This provides a seamless facility for Returning Officers to process candidate nominations, affidavits,
   Voter turnout, counting, results, and data management.
- The ENCORE counting application is an end-to-end application for returning officers to digitize the votes polled, tabulate the round-wise data, and then takeout various statutory reports of counting.

### 8. Rajnath Singh inaugurates 'India Manufacturing Show' in Bengaluru

- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh has inaugurated the three-day 'IndiaManufacturing Show' in Bengaluru.
- The show has been jointly organised by Laghu Udhyog Bharti and the IMS

### 13. NITI Aayog organized Workshop on "Goa Roadmap for Tourism"

- Under this scheme, about 80 crore poor people across the country are being given 5 kg of free food grains every month. This scheme was ending in Decemberthis year.
- PM Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana was launched in April 2020.



### 15. L&T to construct greenfield airport in Andhra's Bhogapuram

- Larsen and Toubro (L&T) Construction have secured a large order to construct the Greenfield Bhogapuram International Airport project in Andhra Pradesh.
- The project cost is estimated to be in the Rs 2,500-5,000 crore range.
- The project will initially be developed to handle 6 MPA (million passengers perannum) capacity to be further enhanced to the capacity of 12 MPA.
- The key development works include cut & fill works, terminal works with airportsystems, ATC tower, airfield development works (south runway 3,800 m length, apron, taxiways, airfield ground lighting, fuel hydrant works and other facilities), landside facilities (roads, landscapes, etc.), utilities & other support facilities.

### 16. Delhi banks on IIT Kanpur's artificial rain to tackle pollution crisis

- In light of the escalating air pollution dilemmas in Delhi-NCR, the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Kanpur has brought forth a novel solution.
- With a mission to alleviate the deteriorating air quality, the renowned institute has reportedly designed an approach using 'artificial rain' to cleanse the atmosphere of dust and major pollutants.
- The institute has been relentlessly working on artificial rain for more than fiveyears and successfully executed a test in July.

### 17. Jal Diwali - "Water for Women, Women for Water Campaign" launched

- The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has unveiled a progressive initiative" Women for Water, Water for Women Campaign".
- Under its flagship scheme Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban
   Transformation, in partnership with the Ministry's National Urban LivelihoodMission and Odisha Urban
   Academy is the knowledge partner.
- This campaign celebrates "Jal Diwali" and commences from, 7th November, 2023. It will continue till 9th November, 2023.

#### 18. Uttar Pradesh state govt to conduct Cow Census

- The Uttar Pradesh government has ordered a cow census across the state in three categories, which
  includes determining the number of destitute animals with cattle rearers, abandoned cows on the
  streets, and Kanha Upvans.
- U.P. CM also ordered implementing of geo-tagging. In the first phase, these cowswill be counted. In the
  next phase, a plan will be formulated and implemented to ensure they are provided with suitable
  accommodation.
- The figures related to the number of cattle are believed to have changed since the 20th Livestock Census was conducted in 2019 by the Central government. The next census is due in 2024.
- Presently, 11. 85 lakh cows are protected in 6,889 destitute cattle breeding sites, while over 1.85 lakh cows have been handed over to gau sevaks under
   Mukhyamantri Sahbhagita Yojana' for cow protection, according to UP govt.

### 19. 8th edition of 'Vizag Navy Marathon' held in Visakhapatnam

- The eighth edition of the 'Vizag Navy Marathon' has been organized in Visakhapatnam city.
- Around 12,000 people took part in the Marathon organized by the Eastern NavalCommand (ENC) at RK Beach Road in the city.
- The marathon was flagged off by Vice Adm Rajesh Pendharkar, Flag OfficerCommanding in Chief, ENC with more than 500 participants.



• The half-marathon was flagged off by Vice Admiral G Srinivasan, DGNP Vizag, with more than 1,600 runners, and the 10-km run, with more than 2,700 runners, was flagged off by Dr Ravishankar Commissioner of Police.

#### 20. IIT Madras established first international campus in Zanzibar

- The Indian Institute of Technology Madras became the first Indian Institute of Technology to set up an international campus, by launching a campus in Zanzibar Tanzania.
- India and the East African nation had recently signed a MoU.
- The Zanzibar Campus, IIT Madras, will be on Zanzibar Island, off the East Africanmainland and part of the Tanzanian Republic.
- In the first batch at IITM Zanzibar, students from Zanzibar, mainland Tanzania, Nepal, and India have been admitted, with 40 per cent of the students being women.
- Classes for the first Academic Year (2023-24) commenced in October 2023.

#### 21. Adani Green crosses 8.4 GW mark, and becomes India's largest RE company

- Adani Green Energy Ltd (AGEL) has become India's largest green energycompany as it reached the 8.4 gigawatt (GW) installed capacity mark.
- Company executives told this paper that AGEL commissioned a 0.15 GW solar power park in Rajasthan, which helped it surpass the 5 GW capacity for solar and 8.4 GW overall.
- Among its peers, ReNew is closest with 8.3 GW, followed by Tata Power and
  Greenko Energies with close to 4 GW capacity each. State-owned NTPC has a 3.2GW green energy
  capacity.

### 22. Mundra becomes India's first port to handle 16.1 million tonnes of Cargo

- Adani Group's flagship Mundra Port has set another record by handling 16.1 million tonnes of cargo in October, the highest-ever volume by any port in India.
- It is the largest port in the country with 102 MMT of cargo handled so far this year with a good 9 percent year-on-year growth. The port crossed the 100 MMTmark in 210 days, surpassing the record of 231 days last year.
- Mundra witnessed double-digit growth on a YoY basis for containers liquids andgas.
- Further, it achieved another milestone of handling 4.2 million twenty-foot equivalents (TEUs) of containers in just 203 days, a feat achieved in 225 days in the previous financial year.

### 23. Government launches 'Bharat Atta' Initiative for affordable wheat flour

- The Central government has launched a new wheat flour scheme called 'BharatAtta' at a subsidized price of Rs 27.50 per kg.
- The scheme is aimed at providing affordable wheat flour to the poor and vulnerable sections of the society.
- Bharat Atta is a fortified wheat flour that is made with a blend of wheat, rice, andpulses. It is a good source of protein, iron, and other essential nutrients.
- The scheme will be implemented through the Public Distribution System (PDS), ensuring easy access to affordable wheat flour for the target population.

#### 24. 10th Kalinga Literary Festival to be held in Bhubaneswar

• The 10th edition of the Kalinga Literary Festival (KLF) with the theme 'Legendsof Ancient Bharat and Beyond: Inspiring Lived Experience in the 21st Century', will be kick-started from February 9 in Bhubaneswa, Odisha



• Over 300 esteemed speakers, including poets, musicians, artists, and performersare all set to grace the festival, which will take place till February 11.

### 25. THDC India inks pact to develop renewable energy projects in Karnataka

- THDC India Ltd is planning to set up 3,270 megawatts of clean energy projects, including pumped storage and floating solar, in Karnataka.
- In this regard, the Uttarakhand-based company signed two Memorandum of Understanding with Karnataka Power Corporation Limited (KPCL) and Karnataka Renewable Energy Development Limited (KREDL) in Bengaluru.
- These collaborative efforts encompass the development of a diverse range of projects, spanning ground-mounted, floating solar projects, and hybrid projects including pumped storage projects (PSPs) with a cumulative capacity of around 3,270 MW.

### 26. Uttarakhand to become first state to adopt the Uniform Civil Code

- Uttarakhand is set to become the first state in the country to implement the Uniform Civil Code.
- A committee formed under the leadership of Justice (retired) Ranjana Desai would submit a report to Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami in the next coupleof days.
- The UCC is a proposal to formulate and implement personal laws that will apply uniformly to all citizens regardless of their religion, gender, or sexual orientation.
- Objective To strengthen the social fabric, promote gender equality, and helpfight economic, social, and religious inequalities.

### 27. Ayodhya sets Guinness Record by lighting 22 Lakh Diyas

- Uttar Pradesh has set a new Guinness world record by lighting over 22 lakhDiyas (lamps) in Ayodhya.
- Ayodhya began the Deepotav festival with the formation of the Yogi Adityanath government in 2017. The government lit up around 51,000 diyas in 2017, and then 4.10 lakh Diyas in 2019.
- The number then every year goes up with over 9 lakh diyas illuminated in 2021.

### 28. Meghalaya launches 'Food Security' campaign to achieve zero hunger

- The Union Minister for Power and New & Renewable Energy, R. K. Singh hasinaugurated a Power Pavilion set up by the Ministry of Power in India International Trade Fair 2023 at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi.
- The pavilion aims to present the key initiatives in the power sector before the domestic and international industry and to also improve public awareness and participation in the schemes and policies of the government.

### 30. Shital Mahajan became first woman to Skydive from Mt Everest

• Indian skydiver Shital Mahajan has jumped off a helicopter from a height of21,500 ft in front of the world's highest peak Mt Everest.



- She became the first woman to do so. Mahajan landed at Kalapatthar peak at analtitude 17,444 feet.
- Mahajan is a well-known Indian skydiver who holds several skydiving records and is the recipient of the fourth highest civilian award, the Padma Shri in 2001.

### 31. PM Modi launched PVTG Development Mission and Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched the Pradhan Mantri Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTG) Development Mission, a 24,000 crore rupees scheme on the occasion of the third Janjaatiya Gauray Diwas from Khunti districtin Jharkhand.
- The mission will benefit 75 PVTGs in 18 states and UTs, living in 22,544 villagesin 220 districts having a population of around 28 lakhs.

- According to the legislation, named the Bihar Reservation Amendment Bill, quotafor Extremely Backward Class (EBC) will be raised from the existing 18% to 25%; for Backward Class (BC) from 12% to 18%; for Scheduled Caste (SC) from16% to 20%; and for



Scheduled Tribe (ST), the quota will be doubled, from 1% to 2%. The existing 3% reservation for BC women has been scrapped.

- 56. 54th International film festival of India held in Goa between 20th November to 28th November 2023.
  - The **54th International Film Festival of India (IFFI) wrapped up in Goa**. The closing ceremony took place at the **Dr Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Indoor Stadium in Bambolim, Goa**.
  - Many movie stars and important people attended the closing ceremony. The final closing film of this year's IFFI was 'Featherweight', directed by Robert Kolodny from the United States.
- 57. Cabinet grants approval to PM janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan( PM JANMAN)
  - Prime Mr Shri Narendra Modi the chairperson of union cabinet has approved Pradhan Mantri Janjati
     Aadivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan(PM JANMAN) with theapprox outlay of Rs.24,104 crore. This Abhiyan
     was announced on Janjatiya Gaurav Diwas from Khunti.
  - It will help in enhancing the basic facilities like sanitation, cleanliness, safedrinking water , health and nutrition, improving education , telecom and read connectivity, and sustainable livelihood opportunities.
- 58. Center government is going to spend 11.80 lakh crore in next five years under PMGKY.
  - Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, the chairperson of the union cabinet, on Wednesday has approved that the eligible citizens under the public distribution scheme will get free grains by the Central Government for another 5 years.
  - Prime Minister Narendra Modi himself mentioned the center's intention to extend the PM Garib
     Kalyan Yojana, during his election release earlier thismonth.
- 59. Centrally Sponsored Scheme for Fast Track Special Courts gets extension till 31st March 2026.
  - The Union Cabinet approved to keep the Fast Track Special Courts going from April 1, 2023, to March 31, 2026. This will cost Rs 1952.23 crore, with Rs1207.24 crore from the central government and Rs 744.99 crore from the state government. The central government's part will be covered by the Nirbhaya Fund.
- 60. Cabinet grants approval to the Central Sector Scheme to provide drones to Women selfhelp groups.
  - To grant drones to women self groups a central center scheme has been approved by the union government with an outlay of Rs.1261 crore.
  - This decision was taken by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi under the meeting of the union cabinet.

    The plan wants to provide 15,000 chosengroups of women drones from 2023 to 2026.
  - These drones will be used to rent out services to farmers for farming needs, according to an official statement.
- 61. MoWCD has launched the Anganwadi Protocol for Divyang Children.
  - Smt. Smriti Zubin Irani, Union Minister for Women and Child Developmentand Minority Affairs has launched the Anganwadi Protocol for Divyang Children at a national outreach Programme organized on 28th November, 2023at Vigyan Bhawan.
  - She mentioned that the Divyang protocol will help each district administration insupporting the special education and nutrition needs.
  - They will give **Swavlamban Cards to empower divyang children** and theirfamilies.

### **Chapter 13: Current Affairs (International)**

#### 1. Thailand announces Visa-Free Entry for Indians to boost tourism

- In an effort to attract more tourists as the high season approaches, Thailand has announced the temporary removal of visa requirements for travellers from Indiaand Taiwan starting from 10th November 2023 and continuing until 10th May 2024.
- This decision follows a previous move in September to eliminate visa requirements for Chinese tourists, who were a significant source of visitors before the pandemic, accounting for 11 million out of the record 39 millionarrivals in 2019.
- As per the announcement, travelers from India and Taiwan can enjoy a maximum stay of 30 days in Thailand without the need for a visa.

#### 2. 'Al' named Collins Word of the Year for 2023

- The abbreviation of Artificial Intelligence (AI) has been named the Collins Wordof the Year for 2023.
- Lexicographers at Collins Dictionary said use of the term had "accelerated" and that it had become the dominant conversation of 2023.
- We know that AI has been a big focus this year in the way that it has developed and has quickly become
  as ubiquitous and embedded in our lives as email, streaming or any other once futuristic, now everyday
  technology," Collinsmanaging director Alex Beecroft said.

### 3. India and Sri Lanka re-launched ETCA negotiations

- India and Sri Lanka held the 12th round of negotiations on the Economic and Technology Cooperation Agreement in Colombo, Sri Lanka.
- The delegations from both sides delved into a spectrum of critical areas, including Trade in Goods, Technical Barriers to Trade, and Trade in Services.
- Both sides acknowledged the potential in India and Sri Lanka trade partnership and possibilities for enhanced economic relations.

#### 4. Chile becomes 95th member of International Solar Alliance

- Chile has become the 95th member of the International Solar Alliance ISA.
- Chile handed over the Instrument of ISA ratification during the meeting of Ambassador Juan Angulo of Chile with Joint Secretary (Economic Diplomacy) in Ministry of External Affairs Abhishek Singh in New
- The ISA is an alliance co-founded by India and France, focusing on the large-scaledeployment of solar energy as a sustainable intervention to counter climate change. It emphasizes energy access, security, and transition throughcollaborative efforts among its member nations.

#### 5. Mika becomes world's first robot CEO

- In the era where many workers are worrying about artificial intelligence (AI)replacing their jobs, one company has announced that it is hiring the first humanoid robot chief executive officer (CEO).
- Dictador, a spirit brand based in Colombia's Cartagena, has gone viral forappointing Mika, who is manifested as a robot.
- Mika is a research project between Hanson Robotics and Dictador. It has been customised to represent company value. Hanson Robotics also created Sophia, the popular humanoid robot.

### 6. Japan gets a new Island after an undersea volcano eruption

- The world's newest island has been formed off the coast of the Japanese island of Iwo Jima in the Pacific Ocean following an undersea volcanic eruption around 1,200 km south of Tokyo.
- The newly created island has not been named yet. However, as far as its measurement goes, it is approximately around 100 m in diameter, and tookshape through phreatomagmatic eruptions. These eruptions are actually triggered when magma reacts with seawater, thereby resulting in explosive



releases of ash and steam.

### 7. IMF executive board approved a 50% quota increase

- The executive board has approved a proposal to make a 50% increase in thequota allocated to members in proportion to their current quotas.
- The proposal has come after the guidance from the IMF Committee at the 2023annual meetings.
- Presently, India has a quota of Special Drawing Rights (SDR) of 13,114.4 million. This means India has a share of 2.75%.

### 8. "800"- biopic of Sri Lankan cricketer Muttiah Muralitharan released

- "800", the biopic of Sri Lankan cricket legend Muttiah Muralitharan, will have its digital premiere on JioCinema on December 2.
- The Tamil film, starring "Slumdog Millionaire" actor Madhurr Mittal in the role of the spinner, was released in theatres on October 6.
- Written and directed by MS Sripathy, the film is titled "800" after the record number of wickets Muralitharan took in Test cricket. It is produced by MovieTrain Motion Pictures.

#### 9. New Zealand launches interactive map for biodiversity restoration

- New Zealand launched a new interactive map to restore a minimum of 15 percent local biodiversity within every catchment in the next nearly 100 years.
- The interactive map from Eco-index includes information on the type of habitatthat existed there historically and targets for restoring 15 per cent of biodiversity in each area.
- The free, open access-resourced tool will help community groups, businesses, government and land managers to set restoration priorities for areas where localbiodiversity is most at risk, said Eco-index, a program aiming at tackling the challenge of biodiversity decline in New Zealand.

### 10. WHO launches commission to foster social cohesion and lone lines?

- The World Health Organization has announced a new Commission on Social Connection, to address loneliness as a pressing health threat, promote social connection as a priority and accelerate the scaling up of solutions in countries of all incomes.
- The Commission will consider how connection enhances the well-being of ourcommunities and helps foster economic progress and social development.

### 11. ASEAN-India Millet Festival 2023 Kicks Off In South Jakarta, Indonesia

- The Indian Mission to ASEAN in collaboration with Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare is
  organizing the ASEAN-India Millet Festival 2023, inIndonesia from 22nd November to 26th November
  2023. The inaugural session of the festival took place in the Kota Kasablanka Mall, a prominent
  shopping destination in South Jakarta, Indonesia.
- A Millet-centric exhibition is being held as part of the festival featuring participation from Millet-based FPOs, start-ups and Indian chefs.

### 12. Geert Wilders New PM of Dutch

- Geert Wilders, leader of the Freedom Party (PVV), secured a landmark win in therecent Dutch elections, signaling a growing shift towards far-right ideologies in Europe.
- Wilders, known for his anti-immigration stance and admiration for leaders likeDonald Trump and Viktor Orban, is eyeing the position of the Netherlands' nextprime minister.

#### 13. ILO's needed concern for the workers and laborers across the world: Report

- Deaths due to work related factors are increasing so **ILO(International labororganization)** calls a report for the countries that they should concern and strengthen their power related to this serious issue.
- Around the world about 64% of workers' deaths are caused by work related toaccidents, disease, exposure to fumes, gasses(4.5 lakh deaths) according to the report released by the International Labour Organisation (ILO) and most of the deaths are reported from the Asia Pacific region.
- The report also recommended five categories of " fundamental principles and rights at work" they are

- Safe environment

### **Chapter 14: Banking & Financial**

### 1. GST collections surge to ₹1.72 lakh in October

- The government has collected Rs 1, 72,003 crore in October through GST.
- This is the second-highest monthly collection after the Rs 1.87 lakh crore netted in April 2023.
- Gross GST revenue for October is 13 percent higher compared to the samemonth last year.
- During the month, revenue from domestic transactions (including import of services) is also 13 percent higher than the revenue from these sources during the same month last year. The average gross monthly GST collection in FY 2023-24 now stands at Rs 1.66 lakh crore, which is 11 percent higher compared to the previous financial year.
- October's GST revenues included Central GST (CGST) of ₹30,062 crore, State GST of ₹38,171 crore, and Integrated GST (IGST) of ₹91,315 crore.
- The government settled ₹42,873 crore to CGST and ₹36,614 crore to SGST from IGST, resulting in a total revenue of ₹72,934 crore for CGST and ₹74,785 crore for SGST in October 2023 after regular settlements.

### 2. RBI launches two key surveys for monetary policy inputs

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has announced the introduction of two crucialsurveys, namely the 'Inflation Expectations Survey of Households' and the 'Consumer Confidence Surveynetary'. Inflation Expectations Survey of Households
- The 'Inflation Expectations Survey of Households' is designed to capture subjective assessments on price movements and inflation.
- It will gather data based on individual consumption baskets in 19 cities, including Ahmedabad, Bengaluru, Bhopal, Bhubaneswar, Chandigarh, Chennai, Delhi, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Jaipur, Jammu, Kolkata, Lucknow, Mumbai, Nagpur, Patna, Raipur, Ranchi, and Thiruvananthapuram.

### 3. Consumer Confidence Surveynetary

- The 'Consumer Confidence Survey' will seek qualitative feedback from households, focusing on their sentiments concerning the general economic situation, employment prospects, price levels, household income, and spendingpatterns.
- This survey, conducted regularly in the same 19 cities mentioned earlier, aims togauge public sentiment on various economic factors.

### 4. Nirmala Sitharaman inaugurated SBI's branch in Trincomalee

- Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman has inaugurated the State Bank of India'sbranch in Trincomalee, Sri Lanka.
- Governor of Eastern Province of Sri Lanka Senthil Thondaman, High
   Commissioner of India to Sri Lanka Gopal Baglay, and SBI Chairman DineshKhara graced the event.
- Recognizing SBI's 159-year-long presence, Mrs. Sitharaman praised its commitment to growth at home



and abroad, especially during the Sri Lankaneconomic crisis.

### 5. Reliance Retail to acquire Arvind Fashions' Beauty Retail Business

- Reliance Retail Ventures (RRVL) is buying Arvind Beauty Brands Retail, a subsidiary of Arvind Fashions that runs the Sephora India business for ₹99 crore.
- Reliance Retail has entered into the fast-growing beauty business with Tira, anomnichannel beauty retail platform.
- This acquisition follows earlier reports in local media suggesting that Sephoraand Reliance Retail had terminated discussions regarding a potential retail partnership in the Indian market.

### 6. HSBC India launches e-bank guarantee services for MSMEs

- Private sector lender HSBC India has launched electronic bank guarantee services for its MSMEs and corporate clients in association with National E-Governance Services Ltd (NeSL) to replace the conventional time-intensivepaper-based bank guarantee.
- The move is aimed to digitize trade and ease the guarantee issuance process digitally with the introduction of e-stamping and e-signing. With the new solution, the applicant will be able to instantly view a bank guarantee on the NeSL portal.

#### 7. SBI authorized to issue & encash Electoral Bonds through 29 branches

- The Government of India has authorized the State Bank of India, in the 29th Phase of sale, to issue and encash Electoral Bonds through its 29 AuthorizedBranches with effect from 6th to 20th of this month.
- The Electoral Bonds shall be valid for 15 calendar days from the date of issue and no payment shall be made to any payee Political Party if the Electoral Bond is deposited after expiry of the validity period.
- The Electoral Bond deposited by an eligible Political Party in its account shall be credited on the same day.

### 8. RBI imposes penalties on Punjab National Bank, Federal Bank

- Reserve Bank of India has imposed monetary penalties on Punjab National Bank, Federal Bank, Kosamattam Finance, and Mercedes-Benz Financial Services India for rule violations.
- The central bank has imposed a penalty of Rs 72 lakh on Punjab National Bank, Rs 30 lakh on Federal Bank, Rs 13.38 lakh on Kosamattam Finance, and Rs 10 lakh on Mercedes-Benz Financial Services.
- Punjab National Bank received the penalty due to several violations, including levying SMS charges on
  certain accounts despite maintaining invalid mobile numbers in the Core Banking Solution (CBS), not
  strictly adhering to the interestrates as per the pre-disclosed schedule in several term deposit accounts,
  and failing to specify the interest reset date in MCLR-linked loans.
- Federal Bank was penalized for issuing demand drafts, each valued at rupees fifty thousand and above, without including the name of the purchaser on theface of the drafts.
- Kosamattam Finance was penalized for not maintaining a Loan-to-Value (LTV)ratio of 75 percent in certain loan accounts during the fiscal year 2021-22.
- Mercedes-Benz Financial Services India received a penalty for failing to conductongoing due diligence of
  its customers and for not updating the Know Your Customer (KYC) information of its high-risk customers
  as of March 31, 2021.

### 9. IndiaFirst Life becomes First Life Insurance Company to Obtain GIFT

- India First Life Insurance has received the registration to undertake life insurance business in the Gujarat International Finance Tec (GIFT) City-International Financial Services Centre (IFSC).
- The registration will enable India First Life to expand its reach globally. Theorganization is all geared to embark on the journey, once the necessary formalities are in place.

### 10. Nirmala Sitharaman launches 12 GST Seva Kendras in Vapi, Gujarat

- Union Minister for Finance and Corporate Affairs, Nirmala Sitharaman has inaugurated 12 Goods and Services Tax (GST) Seva Kendras in Vapi, Gujarat.
- It showcasing the government's commitment to enhancing the Ease of DoingBusiness in the country.
- Additionally, she recognized and rewarded the participants of the "Mera Bill Mera Adhikaar" (MBMA) scheme, which promotes the culture of generating billsduring sales and



purchase transactions.

### 11. ICICI Bank receives RBI's nod to make Securities a wholly-owned subsidiary

- ICICI Bank has received a green signal from the Reserve Bank to make I-ProcessServices (India) Private Ltd a wholly-owned subsidiary of the lender.
- The board of the bank had, at its meeting held on February 17-18, 2023, approved a proposal for making I-Process Services (India) Private Limited (iProcess) a wholly-owned subsidiary of the bank, subject to receipt of requisiteregulatory and statutory approval.
- Started in 2005, I-Process Services (India) Private Ltd was set up to providestaffing solutions services for some of India's top financial institutions.

### 12. India's WPI records 7th consecutive month of deflation in October

- India's wholesale inflation continued to decline for the seventh consecutivemonth in October 2023.
- According to data released by the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, thewholesale price index (WPI) recorded a 0.52 percent decline in October compared to the same period last year.
- Wholesale inflation recorded a contraction of 0.26 percent in September.
- The negative rate of inflation in October 2023 is primarily due to fall in prices of chemicals and chemical products, electricity, textiles, basic metals, food products, paper and paper products, etc. as compared to the corresponding month of the previous year.
- Data showed that retail inflation, based on Consumer Price Index (CPI), eased to
   4.87 percent in October compared to 5.02 percent in September this year.

### 13. Over 18.88 lakh new workers enrolled under ESI scheme in September

- Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) has added 18.88 lakh new workers under the ESI Scheme in September, as per the latest payroll data.
- Around 22,544 new establishments were registered and brought under the social security umbrella of the ESIC in September, thereby ensuring more coverage.
- Data revealed that more jobs have been generated for the youth as of the 18.88 lakh employees added during the month, 9.06 lakh employees up to the age group of 25 constitute the registrations which is 47.98 percent of the total employees.

### 14. RBI Imposes ₹90.92 Lakh Monetary Penalty on Axis Bank

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has taken stringent action against Axis BankLtd, imposing a monetary penalty of ₹90.92 lakh.
- The penalty, issued through an order dated November 2, 2023, is a consequence of Axis Bank's non-compliance with specific directives outlined by the RBI.
- The directives in question pertain to the Reserve Bank of India (Know Your Customer (KYC)) Directions, 2016, Loans and Advances – Statutory and Other Restrictions, Guidelines on Managing Risks and Code of Conduct in Outsourcingof Financial Services by banks, and Code of Conduct for Opening and Operating Current Accounts.

### 15. Federal Bank introduces UPI lite for small-value digital payments

- Federal Bank has launched UPI Lite to power small-value digital transactions inIndia.
- NPCI introduced UPI Lite a simplified version of the Unified Payments Interface system to cater to the growing demand for faster and more efficient small-valuepayments.
- Benefits of UPI Lite for customers include reduction in transaction time, a ready-to-access bank statement, higher payment success rate and enhanced security.
- UPI lite account can be created within the existing UPI app without downloading new app.

#### 16. SEBI unveiled Investor Risk Reduction Access platform

- Chairperson of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), Madhabi PuriBuch has launched the Investor Risk Reduction Access (IRRA) platform at the Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE).
- Risk Mitigation in financial markets is an evergreen subject and constant efforts are made by regulators to address risks of various kinds.



### 17. RBI extends payments infrastructure scheme by 2 years till Dec 2025

- RBI has extended the **Payments Infrastructure Development Fund (PIDF)** scheme by another two years till **December 31, 2025.** It will now include beneficiaries of the **PM Vishwakarma** scheme.
- "The decision to expand the targeted beneficiaries under the PIDF scheme willprovide a fillip to the Reserve Bank's efforts towards promoting digital transactions at the grassroots level.
- About The PIDF Scheme was operationalised in January 2021 for three years to incentivise the
  deployment of payment acceptance infrastructure such as physical Point of Sale (PoS), Quick Response
  (QR) codes in tier-3 to tier-6 centres, the north-eastern states and Union Territories of Jammu &
  Kashmirand Ladakh.

### 18. RBI Imposes Fine Of ₹10.34 Crore On BoB, Citibank, And IOB

- The Reserve Bank of India, on 24 November, took stringent measures against Citibank, Bank of Baroda, and Indian Overseas Bank, imposing penaltiestotaling ₹10.34 crore.
- Indian Overseas Bank bore the brunt of a ₹1 crore penalty for non- compliance with specific directions issued by the RBI on 'loans and advances –statutory and other restrictions.'
- Citibank, a major player in the banking sector, faced a hefty penalty of ₹5 crore for failing to comply with various directives.

### 19. RBI added 19 more to its unauthorized forex trading platforms

- RBI has recently updated the unauthorized forex trading list 'alert list' by adding 19 more unauthorized forex trading platforms.
- After adding 19 more entities, now there are 75 numbers of unauthorized forex trading platforms in the list provided by RBI.
- This Alert list contains those trading platforms which are unauthorized under the Foreign exchange management act 1999 and Electronic trading platforms RBI directions 2018.

### 20. SBI MF is going to buy a 9.9% stake in Karur Vysya Bank.

- SBI Mutual Fund got permission from the RBI to buy up to a 9.99% share in Karur Vysya Bank Ltd.
- The approval was given based on SBI Mutual Fund's request to the Reserve Bankof India. The bank mentioned in a filing that the approval will be canceled if SBI MF doesn't acquire a significant share within a year from the date of the letter.
- SBI Mutual Fund can't own more than 9.99% of the bank's shares altogether. If their ownership goes below 5%, they need approval from the RBI to increase itto 5% for more of the shares.

### 1. Minuteman III missile test-launched by US Air Force

- The U.S. Air Force had blown up a Minuteman III missile over the Pacific Oceanafter an anomaly was detected following its launch from Vandenberg Space Force Base in California.
- The nuclear-capable Minuteman III, made by Boeing, is key to the U.S. military's strategic arsenal. The missile has a range of 6,000-plus miles (9,660-plus km) and can travel at a speed of about 15,000 miles per hour (24,000 kph).
- About 400 of the missiles are located at Air Force bases in Wyoming, Montana, and North Dakota.

### 2. Russia seals deal to supply Igla anti-aircraft missiles to India

- Russia has signed a contract to supply Igla-S hand-held anti-aircraft missiles tolndia and allow production of the Igla there under licence.
- The Igla-S is a man-portable air defence system (MANPADS) that can be fired by an individual or crew to bring down an enemy aircraft.
- India is the world's largest arms importer and Russia remains its largest supplier despite the damage to the reputation of its army and weaponry from the war in Ukraine.

### 3. IAF to organize air show at Ambala Air Force Station

- Indian Air Force will organize an air show on 23-24 November at Air ForceStation in Ambala Cantonment.
- During the air show, Surya Kiran and Akashganga teams will showcase theirskills in the sky alongside the aircrafts of the Indian Air Force.
- Ambala Cantonment is a cantonment town in Ambala district in the state of Haryana, India. It is 200 km north of Delhi and 55 km southwest of Chandigarh.

### 4. France test-fires long-range ballistic missile 'M51.3'

- France has successfully test-fired an M51.3 long-range ballistic missile, boostingthe credibility of France's nuclear deterrence capabilities.
- The missile, which did not carry a nuclear weapon, was fired from the Frencharmy's Biscarosse missile testing site in southwest France and landed in the North Atlantic, "hundreds of kilometres from any coastline.
- The M51.3 missile is an upgraded version of the M51, a three-stage sea-land strategic ballistic missile designed to be launched from French Navy submarines.
- The new M51.3 missile, which is expected to enter service around 2025, is developed by aerospace firm ArianeGroup, a joint venture between Arbus (AIR.PA) and French defence group Safran (SAF.PA)

### 5. Indian Navy deploys IN<mark>S Sumedha in M</mark>ozambique to boost interoperability

- Under the ongoing extended operational deployment to Africa, the Indian navalship Sumedha reached Maputo, Mozambique on November 21.
- Aims-"The port call is aimed at strengthening long-standing diplomatic relations, reinforce maritime
  co-operation and boost interoperability between both the navies. Professional interactions, crossdeck visits, planning conferences and joint EEZ surveillance from November 23-25, 2023 are
  scheduled during the visit."

### 6. Indigenous tank Zorawar will begin trials soon.

- Tackling with the mighty Chinese front India will begin trials of the Zorawarlight tank developed by DRDO and Larsen and Toubro.
- First the testing will be done in the desert sector before taking them to highaltitudes of Ladakh.

### 1. Saudi Arabia to host FIFA World Cup 2034

- Saudi Arabia was the only football association to present a bid to host the 2034 FIFA World Cup before the deadline closed, soccer's global governing body FIFAconfirmed.
- FIFA had invited bids from Asia and Oceania for the tournament and SaudiArabia announced it would bid only minutes after the announcement.
- Australia said, it would not be presenting a bid to host the tournament, leavingSaudi Arabia as the only candidate.



### 2. David Willey to retire from international cricket after World Cup 2023

- England all-rounder David Willey has announced that he will retire frominternational cricket at the end of the ODI World Cup 2023.
- The 33-year-old made his debut for England in 2015 and since then he hasearned 70 ODI caps and 43 in T20Is.
- He amassed 627 runs in the 50-over format and scalped 94 wickets at an average of 30.3 and an economy of 5.57.

### 3. Zahid Hussain clinches Silver at Asian Shooting Championship

- Zahid Hussain secured the silver medal at the prestigious Asian ShootingChampionship 2023 held in South Korea.
- He would be representing his nation on the international stage at the ParisOlympics.
- India shooter Manu Bhaker secured her Paris 2024 Olympics quota after shefinished fifth in the women's 25m pistol final.

#### 4. Statue of Sachin Tendulkar unveiled at Mumbai's Wankhede Stadium

- Legendary cricketer Sachin Tendulkar has unveiled his life-size statue at theWankhede Stadium in Mumbai, where India won the 2011 edition of the ICCWorld Cup.
- The statue was made by Pramod Kamble, who is a painter-sculptor from Ahmednagar district of Maharashtra.
- The statue captures Sachin Tendulkar in the dynamic act of executing a cricket stroke. The legendary cricketer used this shot frequently to smash over 34,000runs in both Test and One Day International (ODI) matches.

### 5. Aishwaryatap Singh Tomar wins Gold in Asian Shooting Championship

- Aishwary Pratap Singh Tomar won the gold medal in the men's 50m rifle 3 positions individual
  event and helped India grab a team silver at the Asian Shooting Championship in Changwon,
  South Korea.
- The 22-year-old Tomar shot 463.5 in the final to win the gold. China's Tian

  Jiaming took the silver with a score of 462.7. Another Chinese, Du Linshu pickedup the bronze with 450.3.
- He won the bronze medal at the 2019 Asian Shooting Championships andsecured a quota place for India at the 2020 Summer Olympics.
- The Indian trio of Tomar, Swapnil Kusale and Akhil Sheoran won the team silverwith a total score of 1764, behind China (1777).

### 6. New York City wins first US National Gatka Championship

- The city of New York has been declared the winner of the US National Gatka Championship, the first-ever American national championship of the popularSikh martial arts.
- Held at a Gurdwara in Queens, New York, over the weekend, the popular Sikh martial arts
  championship was attended by more than 100 players in differentage groups from various parts of
  the country.
- The championship saw the Kansas Gatka Association securing the runner-upposition, while the NJ Gatka Association achieved third place.

### 7. Indian Navy Sailing Championship 2023 begins in Mumbai

- The Indian Navy's most awaited and largest sailing regatta, the Indian NavySailing Championship, started in Mumbai.
- The Championship will hold from 05 Nov to 09 Nov 23.
- The Indian Naval Watermanship Training Centre (INWTC), Mumbai, one of the finest sailing facilities in the country, is geared up to host more than 100 pan- Navy participants who will test their sailing skills in five



different classes of boatsin three different formats of racing.

• INSC is an annual event conducted under the aegis of the Indian Naval Sailing Association (INSA) based at Naval Headquarters to encourage the participation for naval personnel in competitive sailing.

#### 8. Sunil Narine announces retirement from international cricket

- Mystery spinner Sunil Narine has announced his retirement from international cricket.
- The 35-year-old played 6 Tests, 65 ODIs, and 51 T20Is and was part of the T20World Cup-winning West Indies side in 2012.
- The T20 globetrotter last played for the senior national team in 2019 in T20Icricket. His last Test was in 2013 while he had not played an ODI after 2016.
- Sunil Narine also announced he would retiring from the domestic 50-over competition at the end of the ongoing Super 50 Cup in which he is representing Trinidad and Tobago.

### 9. Angelo Mathews becomes 1st to be 'timed out' in international cricket

- Sri Lanka's Angelo Mathews was controversially given "timed out" in a World Cup clash against Bangladesh, becoming the first man to suffer the dismissal inthe 146-year history of international cricket.
- The former captain took more than two minutes to take strike and oppositionskipper Shakib Al Hasan appealed, which was upheld by the on-field umpire.
- Mathews came into bat after the fall of Sadeera Samarawickrama in the 25<sup>th</sup> over but was unable to secure his helmet strap tightly enough, an action whichdelayed the resumption of play.
- According to the laws of cricket, after the fall of a wicket or the retirement of abatsman, the incoming
  player must be ready to receive the ball within two minutes.
- Bangladesh-Sri Lanka ODI World Cup match was held at the Arun Jaitley Stadiumin New Delhi.

### 10. Bangladesh to host 24th Asian Archery Championships in 2025

- Bangladesh will host the 24th Asian Archery Championships in 2025 after winning by 14-10 votes in the bid at the World Archery Asia Congress held in Bangkok, Thailand.
- A total of twenty-four member countries of the Asian continent participated in the congress.
- Bangladesh and China applied for bids as host countries for the 24th AsianArchery Championship.

#### 11. India beat Japan 4-0 to win Women's Asian Champions Trophy Hockey Cup

- India beat Japan 4-0 to win the Jharkhand Women's Asian Champions Trophy, with goals from Sangita Kumari, Neha Goyal, Lalremsiami, and Vandana Katariya.
- India won their maiden Asian Champions Trophy title in 2016 in Singapore, while Japan bagged the crown twice, in 2013 and 2021.
- Asian Games champions China beat South Korea to secure third place.

### 12. Virat Kohli equals Sachin's record of highest number of ODI centuries

- India batter Virat Kohli has equalled Sachin Tendulkar's record for mostcenturies in One-Day Internationals—49.
- Overall, Kohli has now scored 79 international hundreds—one in T20Is and 29 inTests.
- Virat touched the milestone in 277 innings as against Tendulkar's 452 innings.

### 13. Deepika Kumari secured 2 Gold at National Games 2023

- Former world No. 1 archer Deepika Kumari clinched two gold and a silver medal, while Asian Championships gold medal-winning shooter Aishwary Pratap Singh Tomar bagged the top spot in 50m rifle 3-positions event at the National Games.
- Deepika, representing Jharkhand, began her medal rush with a gold in the women's individual category, and later paired with Mrinal Chauhan to secure thetop podium finish in the mixed team category.
- She also helped Jharkhand win silver in the women's team event, where it lost to Haryana in the shootout.



#### 14. Max Verstappen wins Brazilian Grand Prix 2023

- Three-time champion Max Verstappen led from the start and won the Brazilian Grand Prix 2023.
- Sergio Perez of Red Bull finished in fourth place, distancing himself from Mercedes' Lewis Hamilton in one of the few competitions left this season -- aposition for runner-up.
- Perez nearly took the podium position from third-place Fernando Alonso of Aston Martin, but the Spaniard saw the checkered flag 0.053 seconds before the Mexican.

### 15. Meg Lanning retires from international cricket

- Australian Women's captain Meg Lanning has announced her retirement from international cricket. Meg Lanning quit international cricket after winning sevenWorld Cup titles during a 241-match career.
- The 31-year-old also led Australia to a Commonwealth Games gold medal last year and is the country's leading run-getter across formats with 8352 runs in241 games.
- Lanning, with two ICC Women's Cricket World Cup wins and five ICC Women's T20 World Cup victories to her name, retires from cricket at 31. She has scored over 8,000 runs in all formats for her nation.
- Lanning won her first ICC trophy at the T20 World Cup in Sri Lanka in 2012, which was soon succeeded by a victory in the 50-over World Cup in India thefollowing year, 2013

### 16. Maharashtra secured top spot in 37th National Games 2023

- Maharashtra secured the first position in the National Games 2023 and bagged 228 medals including 80 gold.
- In 228 medals 80 gold, 69 silvers, and 79 bronze win the Raja Bhalindra Singh Trophy, which is given to the team that wins most number of gold medals at the National Games.
- Maharashtra last topped the National Games medals table back in 1994.
- Athletes from 28 states, eight Union Territories, and Services Sports Control Board (SSCB) competed at the 37th National Games, which was held from October 26 to November 9. Goa hosted the event for the first time in its history.
- Services, who topped the previous four editions of the National Games, finished second with 66 gold, 27 silver, and 33 bronze medals. Haryana were third in the standings with 62 gold, 54 silver and 73 bronze.
- Services Sport Control Board also continued its second position in medal tallywith a total of 117 medals including 59 Gold medals.
- Haryana stands at third position with a total of 161 medals including 53 goldmedals.
- Over 10,000 athletes around 3,000 more than the 2022 edition in Gujarat -competed for medals across 43 sports, which included traditional Olympic disciplines as well as indigenous sports like mallakhamb, kho kho and kabaddi,amongst others.

- Top-ranked Novak Djokovic won a record-extending seventh title at the ParisMasters with a 6-4, 6-3 win over Grigor Dimitrov in the final.
- Djokovic, who had been pushed to three sets in his three previous matches, enjoyed a comfortable afternoon under the roof of the Palais Omnisports.
- The 36-year-old surpassed his own record as the tournament's oldest champion, notching his 40th Masters 1000 title and extending his winning streak to 18 matches.

#### 2. Rachin Ravindra & Hayley Matthews won ICC Player of Month award

- New Zealand's Rachin Ravindra claimed the ICC Men's Player of the Monthaward for October 2023
- Ravindra, the 23-year-old Blackcaps batter, claimed his first Men's Player of the showcasing exceptional form in the World Cup 2023 group stages.
- Ravindra beat India's speedster Jasprit Bumrah and South Africa opener Quintonde Kock for the prestigious accolade after a scorching start to the 2023 World Cup, claiming his award.
- His remarkable 406 runs at an average of 81.20 included a superb 123 not outagainst England and a blazing 116 against Australia.
- While West Indies captain Hayley Matthews bags ICC Women's Player of the Month award for October 2023.

### 3. ICC suspends Sri Lanka Cricket's membership with immediate effect

- Sri Lanka Cricket's (SLC) membership of the International Cricket Council (ICC)has been suspended with immediate effect for government interference.
- Sri Lanka's Ministry of Sport dismissed SLC's board and replaced it with an interim committee following the country's poor performance at this year's WorldCup but the sacking was stayed by Sri Lanka's Court of Appeal.
- ICC said that the SLC had breached its obligations as a member, in particular therequirement to manage its affairs autonomously and without government interference.

### 4. Canada won its first Billie Jean King Cup

- Leylah Fernandez and Marina Stakusic won their singles matches as Canada beatItaly 2-0 to claim its first-ever Billie Jean King Cup.
- Stakusic ranked 258th in the world, put Canada ahead by defeating No. 43 Martina Trevisan 7-5, 6-3 for the biggest win of her career, then Fernandez sealed the victory by beating Jasmine Paolini 6-2, 6-3 at La Cartuja Stadium.
- Canada, captained by Heidi El Tabakh, became the 13th nation to win the Billie Jean King cup and the second consecutive new champion after Switzerland wonin Glasgow 12 months ago.
- The Canada men's team is the current Davis Cup champion.

### 5. Virender Sehwag, Diana Edulji & Aravind D'Silva enter ICC's Hall of Fame

- Three cricketing greats and standout performers in the history of the game Former Indian legendary opener Virender Sehwag, former Indian Women Test skipper Diana Edulji, and Sri Lanka's iconic star Aravinda de Silva are the latestinductees to be added to the ICC Cricket Hall of Fame.
- The International Cricket Council (ICC) has announced the name of the threelegends of cricket as the latest inductees of the ICC Cricket Hall of Fame.



- Sehwag had dynamism a destructive opener of the modern era holds a recordthat is still hard to match, the first Indian with a Triple century. Sehwag has infact scored two Triple Hundreds
- During his illustrious career, Sehwag scored 23 Test centuries, the fifth most byan India men's
  player, and claimed a record of the highest score by an Indian player ever, 319 which was against
  South Africa in Chennai in 2008. Overall,
  - Sehwag has 8,586 runs to his name at an average of 49.34 in 104 appearances.

#### 6. India finished Asian Archery Championships in Bangkok with seven medals

- India ended its campaign at the Asian Archery Championships in Bangkok withseven medals comprising three gold, a silver, and three bronze.
- In the Women's team final, Jyothi Surekha Vennam, Parneet Kaur, and Aditi Gopichand Swami defeated Chinese Taipei in a thrilling contest to win the yellowmetal.
- Kaur also won gold in the women's individual event after beating compatriotVennam in the final.
- India won their second gold medal of the day after Swami and Priyansh beatThailand in the final of the Mixed Team event.

### 7. Gurkeerat Singh Mann announced retirement from international cricket

- Gurkeerat Singh Mann, who played three ODIs on the 2016 tour of Australia, hasannounced his retirement from international and Indian cricket
- Besides batting in the middle-order for India, the 33-year-old also bowled 10overs of off-spin in the ODI series against Australia.
- He first attracted attention on the domestic circuit in 2011 when his fiery battinghelped Punjab win the CK Nayudu Trophy.
- He was also in brilliant form during the Ranji Trophy in 2015-16, when heslammed a double century.

### 8. Rohit Sharma Now First Batsman To Hit 50 Sixes In World Cup

- Rohit Sharma created a unique record at the semi-final game against NewZealand.
- Rohit Sharma became the first batsman in the World Cup to hit 50 or more sixes and breaking Chris Gayle's record of hitting 49 sixes.

### 9. Virat Kohli breaks Sachin Tendulkar's record for most centuries in an ODI

- Virat Kohli becomes first batter in the world to score 50 ODI centuries, breaksiconic Sachin Tendulkar's record of 49 centuries.
- Virat Kohli breaks the long-standing record of compatriot Sachin Tendulkar forthe most ODI hundreds of all-time.
- Kohli took just 279 innings to become the first cricketer to score 50 centuries. Tendulkar, his idol, had scored 49 hundreds in 452 innings.
- Virat Kohli has also goes past Sachin Tendulkar's record for most runs in a single World Cup. He has gone past 673 runs which Tendulkar made in the 2003 WorldCup.

### 10. Mohammed Shami becomes 1st India bowler to pick up 50 wickets in ODI World Cup

- Mohammed Shami has become the fastest bowler to pick up 50 wickets in theODI World Cup.
- The Indian pacer accomplished the milestone in his 17th innings, breaking therecord of Australian speedster Mitchell Starc, who had set the record earlier inthe 2023 edition in his 19th innings.
- Shami also became the first Indian to pick up 50 wickets in the ODI World Cup. He is also the seventh after Glenn McGrath, Muttiah Muralitharan, Starc, Lasith Malinga, Wasim Akram and Trent Boult to reach the 50-wicket landmark in thehistory of the mega event.



### 11. Virat Kohli earns the "Player of the Tournament" title in the Cricket World Cup 2023

- Indian star batter Virat Kohli has been awarded with the "player of the tournament" title in the ICC World Cup 2023 for his exemplary performance.

- The Indian National Space Promotion and Authorisation Centre (IN-SPACe), under the Department of Space, the government of India, has approved AligarhMuslim University's (AMU) proposal for the development of the varsity's first satellite, to be named after its founder Sir Syed Ahmad Khan.
- The satellite is tentatively scheduled to be launched in 6 months.
- The SS AMU SAT is a nanosatellite project which began in November 2021 underAMU Robo Club.
- A 3U CubeSat is a standardized and relatively small satellite used for various purposes, including research, technology demonstration, and earth observation.
